2023 | Ca' Marcanda Vistamare | Tuscany, Italy

The only white wine produced by the Gaja family in Tuscany is a textural blend of Vermentino, Fiano and Viognier. The generous and slightly marine nose is followed by a remarkable complexity of roundness and herbaceous notes.

2023 | Pieropan Calvarino Soave Classico | Veneto, Italy

Pieropan family's tradition in wine date to 1901, when they purchase the historical Calvarino vineyard. The volcanic soils and the steep slopes produce a rich and mineral driven wine, famous as it was the first Italian white wine labelled as single vineyard.

2023 | Cordero di Montezemolo, Langhe Nebbiolo | Piemonte, Italy

19th generation winemaker Alberto is carrying a long tradition of mastering Nebbiolo. The varietal is known for its refined tannins which are the perfect match with our famous Cotoletta a la Milanese.

2022 | Pierro Gatti, Moscato Frizzante | Piemonte, Italy

Light and slightly bubbly, this is the perfect pair with a creamy gelato.

2021 | Elena Walch | Vigna Kastelaz | Alto Adige, Italy

This is a distinguished white wine crafted from a renowned single vineyard in Tramin, Italy. Situated on a steep, south-facing slope, the Vigna Kastelaz vineyard produces a full-bodied wine with a creamy texture, balanced by fine saline undertones and a refreshing acidity. This is one of the best Gewürztraminer produced in Europe.

2021 | Armand Heitz Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru, La Maltroie | Bourgogne, France

This is a refined expression of Chardonnay from Burgundy's esteemed Côte de Beaune region. Sourced from the La Maltroie Premier Cru vineyard, this wine showcases the distinctive terroir of calcareous brown soils rich in marl, contributing to its depth and aromatic complexity.

2019 | Elvio Cogno, Barolo Cascina Nuova | Piemonte, Italy

Young vines can make a great Barolo that can be enjoyed without having to wait 20 years. This is what Valter wanted to prove, and it has been achieved with brio. This textbook Barolo shows intense aromas of rose petals and present itself in a delicate tannin structure true to its origine.

2011 | Château La Tour Blanche, Sauternes, 1er Grand Cru Classé | Bordeaux, France

One of my longtime favorite Châteaux in Sauternes. The Château, and its vineyards, was gifted by his previous owner to the French government in 1909 with one condition: they had to create a winemaking school within its walls. 2011 was a brilliant vintage for La Tour Blanch and the wine shows hint of confit pineapple and vanilla.

This expressiohn of Carricante from the volcanic soils of Mt. Etna displays an energy bursting with citrus oils, white flowers and a good pinch of salt. The palate is rich while still having bright acid to wrap around the fruit.

2023 | Domaine de la Suffrene, Bandol | Provence, France

Embrace the holiday feeling with this rich rosé from the famous hills of Bandol; perfect combination with our lobster pasta.

2022 | Cantalici, Baruffo Chianti Classico | Tuscany, Italy

This is Italy's most famous red wine. A gorgeous Sangiovese, with a hint of rusticity; enhancing the charred flavor of the rib-eye.

2020 | Tenute Dettori, Moscadeddu | Sardegna, Italy

Tenute Dettori has been leading the way on a natural approach to Sardinian winemaking. Famous for its floral and exotic aromas, this Moscato brings sweetness with a vibrant acidity, with a hint of saltiness.

2022 | Whittmann, Aurlede Riesling GG | Rheinhessen, Germany

From cult German winemaker, Philipp Wittmann this Riesling is super clear, refined and elegant with a deep and pure nose thanks to vines planted in 1949 and 1959. Generous exotic fruit and spice are balanced by a pure and mineral structure.

2021 | Elena Walch Beyond the Clouds Chardonnay | Alto Adige, Italy

Alto Adige's first super cuvée was born in 2000. Ever since, Elena Walch and her two daughters have been producing one of Italy's best chardonnays.

2018 | Colleoni, Rosso di Montalcino | Tuscany, Italy

In 2018 Marino made a strict selection for his Riserva and decided to declassify the grapes from his Brunello di Montalcino vineyards into this amazing Rosso. This is dense, serious and highly balanced with mineral notes and great vibrancy.

2011 | Château La Tour Blanche, Sauternes, 1er Grand Cru Classé | Bordeaux, France

Nebbiolo, on the other hand, would be the brooding, quiet man in the corner, harder to understand but infinitely more complex."

AMBASSADORS OF ANGELO GAJA

Pioneer at their time, rebel during their prime, the Gaja family have always been highly regarded as world class winemakers.

Since the creation of the Domaine in 1859, the Gaja family has been leading the industry in the region and have reached the status of cult winemakers.

In the late forties, Giovanni Gaja, Angelo's father, took over the business and started the revolution. He wanted to put their name on the label, showing that the importance of the winemaker was not second to the terroir. The famous label was born showcasing the large letter G A J A.

In 1961, Angelo takes the lead and starts looking for more land to grow vines.

1964: acquisition of Sori San Lorenzo vineyard; 1971: acquisition of the Sori tilde and Costa Russi vineyards. As always, Angelo decides to follow his instinct and refuses to bend in front of the consortium and the many rules of the DOC. He removes his three single vineyards from the famous Barbaresco appellation and declassifies them as "Langhe".

The rest is history... but the Gaja story does not end here.

Angelo wants to conquer the rest of Italy and slowly explore the idea of purchasing other vineyards. With very high standards and a lot of patience, they purchase vineyards in Tuscany and further on, in Sicily.

Pieve Santa Restituta was purchased in 1994, Ca'Marcanda land was planted in 1997.

The project Idda took shape in 2016, but Angelo intention to make wine on the volcano land started way before the nineties.

Today the family owns 110 hectares in Piemonte, 26 in Montalcino, 126 in bolgheri and co-owned 20 hectares in Sicily.

PIEMONTE

This is where it all started. Kings of Barbaresco, Master of Nebbiolo; The Gaja never cease to impress with the elegance and precision of their wines.

The Whites of Piemonte

First released in 1983, "Gaja & Rey" spilled a lot of ink. Planting Chardonnay within the boundaries of Barbaresco was considered an heresy at the time. It is now one of Italy's finest white wines.

Rossj-Bass gets his name from the Rossj vineyard named after Rossana, Angelo's second daughter. The wine is a blend of Chardonnay with a hint of Sauvignon blanc.

Barbaresco

Gaja's Barbaresco is sourced from 14 different vineyards over the communes of Barbaresco and Treiso.

The grapes are fermented separately plot by plot & aged separately for 12 months in French oak. The component parts are then blended then aged another 12 months in Slavonian oak botti.

Single Vineyards of Barbaresco

The single crus used to be blended with Barbera but have been 100% Nebbiolo in recent vintages.

"Sori" is local dialect for "sunny," and it is used for the best vineyard sites with great sun exposure.

Sori San Lorenzo is a very steep vineyard near rivers with a limestone rich soil absorbing any excess water. San Lorenzo is the Patron Protecting Alba's Cathedral. The family kept the name after buying the vineyard of the church.

Sori Tildin is an amphitheater-shaped vineyard at the top of the hill above the Costa Russi vineyard. The soil is sandier and warmer here, and vines are planted vertically and at a higher density. Tildin was the diminutive of Angelo's Grand mother, Clothilde.

AMBASSADORS OF ANGELO GAJA

TOSCANA

Pieve Santa Restituta is the first step of Angelo outside of Piemonte. The vineyard was purchased in 1994 and many redevelopments work have been done to align the estate with Angelo's winemaking beliefs.

The Ca'Marcanda project was propelled by Angelo Gaja's ambition to challenge himself with Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot. After over 20 meetings with the previous owners the 70ha site was purchased at the end of 1996. The name Ca'Marcanda is derived from these protracted negotiations and is a term in the Piemontese dialect that means 'house of endless negotiations'.

The Whites of Tuscany

The Vistamare Vineyard (Sea View in Italian) is located near Bibbona, just outside of the Bolgheri appellation. It is a blend of Vermentino, with a 20% Fiano and 10% barrel aged viognier.

The noble, spicy tones are accompanied by fruity berries, fresh cherries, and violets. When aged in small oak casks, Lagrein unfolds its elegant, full-bodied character.

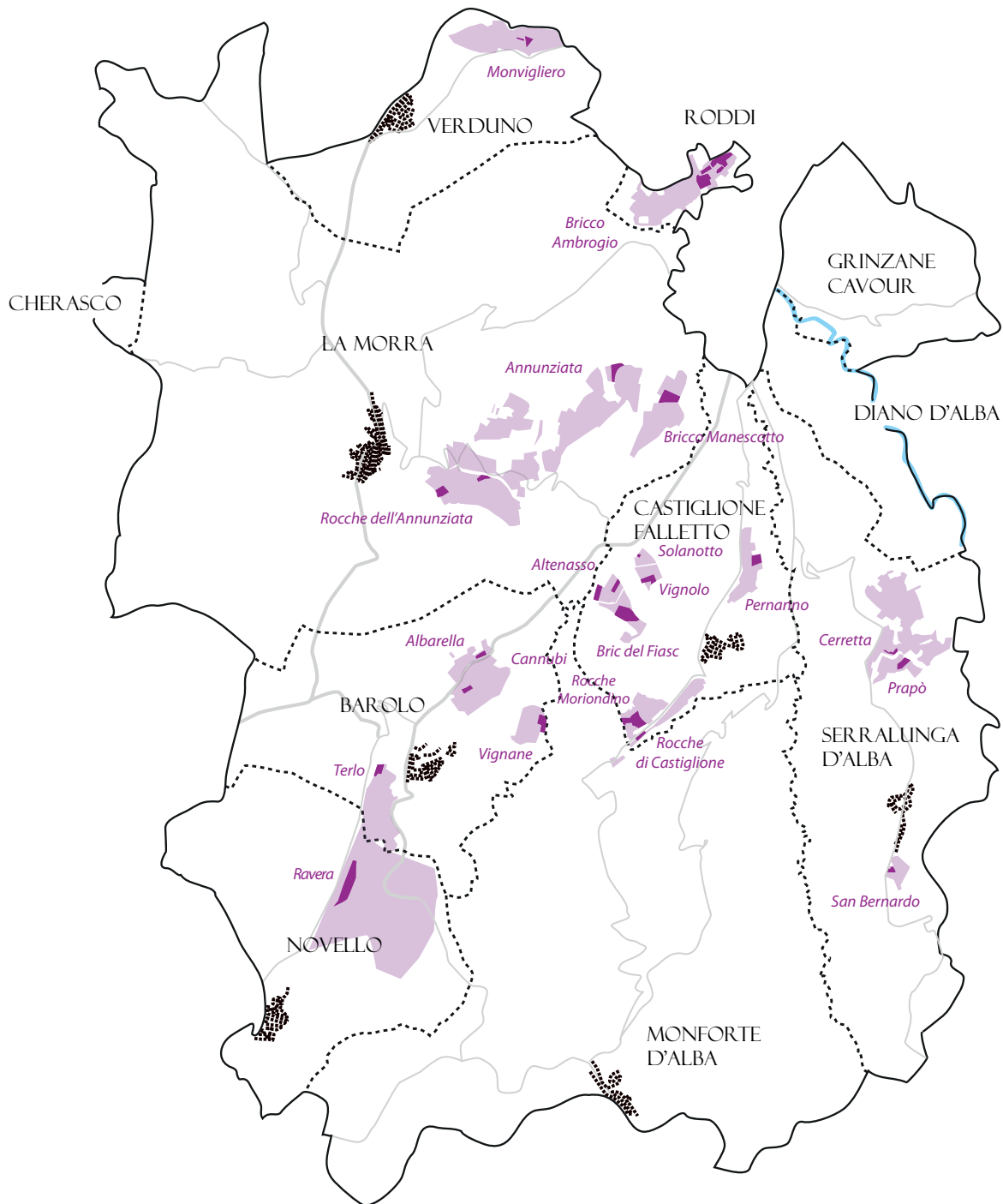
