2021 Morgon, Côte du Py, Domaine Jean Foillard, Beaujolais, France \$950

*Jean Foillard, the Master of Natural Wine in Beaujolais, has swiftly exalted the terroirs of Morgon and the Côte du Py. His wines are celebrated for their silky, suave texture and impressive concentration, making them perfect for cellaring. His signature style is unmissable and has become one of the most sought-after in Beaujolais, reflecting his dedication to natural wine and his profound understanding of the land.*

2009 Chateau Musar Bekaa Valley, Lebanon \$1,180

*Chateau Musar is renowned for its non-interventionist approach, embracing natural fermentation and minimal use of sulfites. This exceptional wine blends traditional Bordeaux varieties with Mediterranean grapes like Cinsault and Carignan. Founded in 1930 by Gaston Hochar, Chateau Musar boasts a rich history that beautifully reflects Lebanon's ancient winemaking traditions. The result is a wine that is both unique and deeply rooted in heritage.*

Best served at room temperature

*A Chinese alcoholic beverage that is most popular in the Jiangnan area, Huangjiu is brewed by mixing boiled grains including rice, glutinous rice or millet with qu as starter culture, followed by saccharification and fermentation at around 13°C to 18°C. Its alcohol content is typically 16% to 20% with a flavour profile resembling a dry Oloroso sherry.*

*Sake is an alcoholic beverage made by fermenting rice that has been polished to remove the bran. The clear to slightly yellowish rice wines have an alcohol content of around 15% and relatively mild flavour profiles, ranging from light and crisp to richer, more substantial, fruity notes.*

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## NATURAL WINES

Natural wine is farmed organically and/or biodynamically and made (or rather transformed) without adding or removing anything in the cellar. No additives or processing aids are used, and 'intervention' in the naturally occurring fermentation process is kept to a minimum. As such neither fining nor (tight) filtration are used. The result is a living wine, wholesome and full of naturally occurring microbiology.

### PÉTILLANT NATUREL

Sparkling wine made in the méthode ancestrale, meaning the wine is bottled before primary fermentation is finished, without the addition of secondary yeasts or sugars. The style is fresh and off-dry usually.
