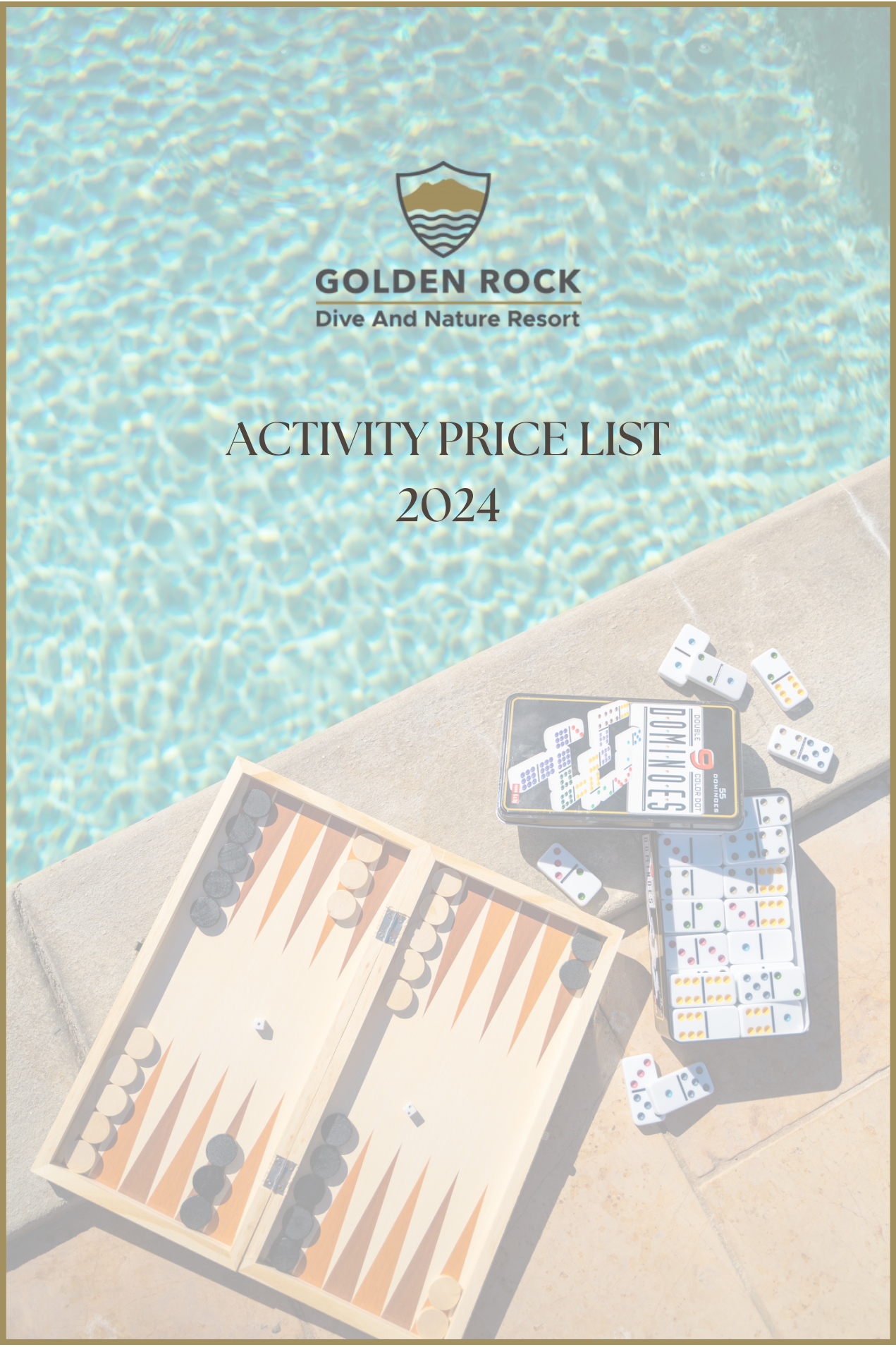

Swimming Pool Opening Hours

Both swimming pools are open from sunrise to sunset, and the lagoon is open from 10am to sunset. We don't have any lifeguards on duty, therefore swimming is at your own risk. We do not encourage diving or jumping into the pools.



Hummingbird Pool

The Hummingbird pool, located next to Breeze, is available to all in-house guests and day pass users, and has a depth of 1.50 meters. A towel station is located poolside where you can pick up clean towels and drop off used towels in the designated bay.

Sun loungers and umbrellas are available on a first come first serve basis, and electrical charging points can be found at the base of all umbrella's to easily charge your electrical items. Showers can also be found poolside.



Hibiscus Pool

The Hibiscus pool is for in-house guests to use, with a depth of 1.50 meters. A towel station, sun loungers, umbrellas, electrical charging points and showers are also available. The Hibiscus pool has a pool bar and deck perfect for those poolside cocktails and snacks!

The Lagoon

The resort's salt water lagoon at Bobbie's Beach Club is the Caribbean's largest ocean fed, cliff edge lagoon, with a maximum depth of 27 feet. Towels, sun loungers and showers are available for all in-house guests.

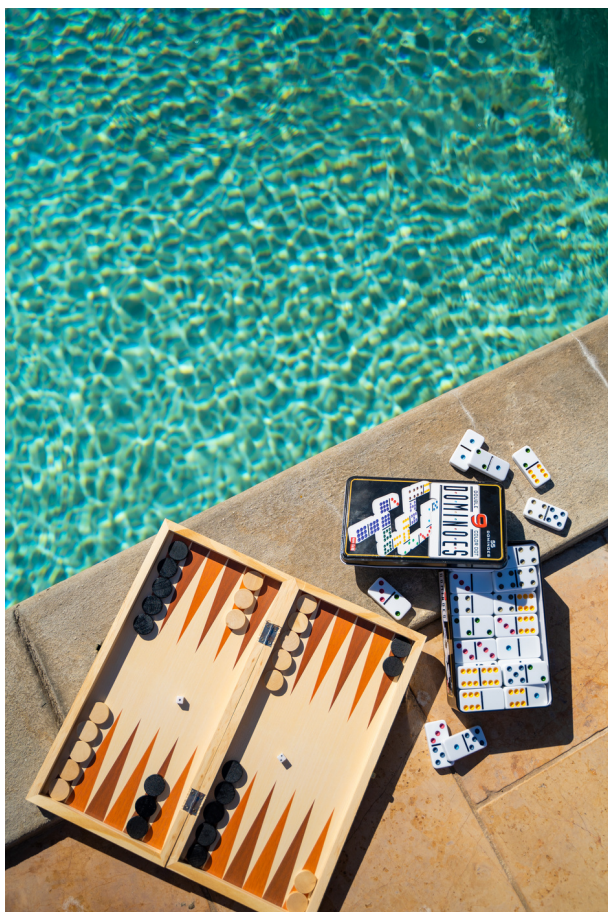


Ocean Front Gym

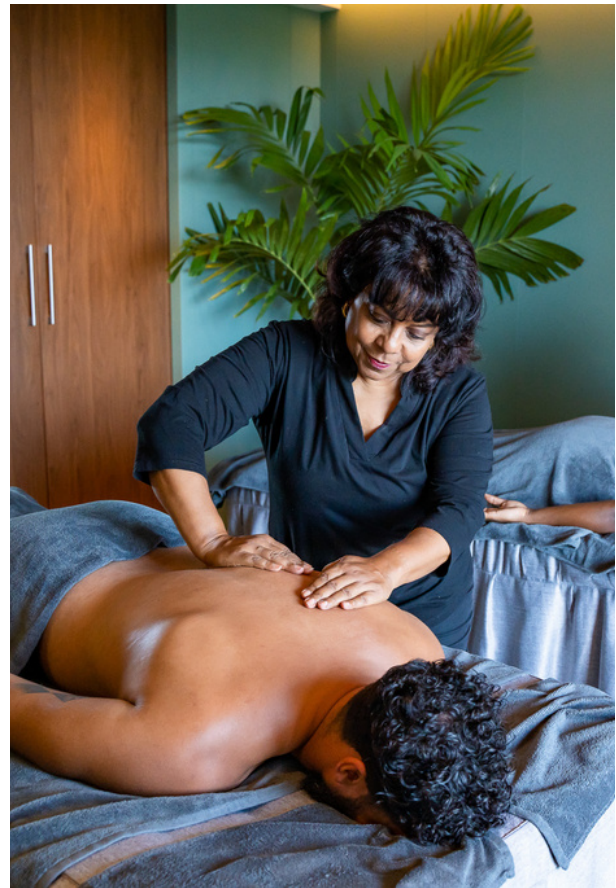

Stargazing

Hiking the Quill / Boven National Parks

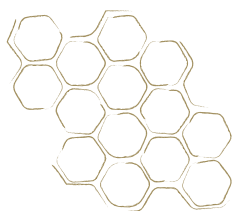

Winair flies daily between Statia and St. Maarten, with connecting flights to Saba, St. Barths and St. Kitts.

Makana Ferry offer services between all the island on certain days of the week so looking up the ferry timetable is advisable.

If you don't want to be restricted by public transport timings, speak to our team about private boat charters or plane charters that can take you to the local islands for a day trip.

The pristine waters around Sint Eustatius, offer a variety of 36 dive sites in the Marine Park, which is bigger than the island itself, and most of the dive sites are located within 3-miles of the harbor.

Statia was termed "Best Caribbean Diving Destination" by National Geographic in 2022, and most recently voted "Best Wreck Diving", "Best Macro Life" and "Best Marine Environment" in the Scuba Diving Magazine Reader's Choice Awards 2024.

HISTORY AND MARINE LIFE

St. Eustatius National Marine Park was established in 1996 and encompasses the entire coastline of the island, from the high water line to the 30 meter depth contour, totalling 27.3 km², an area larger than the island itself.

There are two reserves within the marine park, with one having a strict no fishing or anchoring allowed. The marine park is managed by a non-profit organisation STENAPA (St. Eustatius National Parks Foundation) which was set up by Statians who wanted to protect and preserve the flora and fauna of the island for future generations.



Below the surface STENAPA are protecting Statia's pristine coral reefs, 18th century shipwrecks and vibrant sea life, such as sharks, rays and sea turtles.

From historical sources like old newspaper articles and government correspondence, it is known that hundreds of ships sunk around the island in colonial times, however only a handful of these ships have been discovered and documented.

In 2017, hurricanes Irma and Maria not only damaged the island but underwater as well. Nevertheless, they did expose the remnants of an 18th-century vessel now called Triple Wreck.

One of the most popular sites for divers is Anchor Point, where you can find a large colorful anchor. Another site is Lost Anchors, where five anchors can be found embedded into a beautiful reef full of barrel sponges, tube sponges, and rope sponges. In total there are more than 200 century old anchors to be found in the waters around Statia.

Other relics of the past that can be found underwater are cannons, old bottles and pottery. They have become part of the reef over time and are beautifully overgrown, making them very interesting subjects for underwater photography.
