Vienna is a *fur*tastic place to be and has plenty to offer for dogs as well, but there are some rules and regulations to follow. So, em*bark* on a wonderful journey throughout the city with your four-legged friend while bearing in mind that ...

- ... dogs must be kept on a leash in public areas and on the streets.
- ... a muzzle and a leash are mandatory for dogs when using public transport.
- ... dogs also need a ticket for public transport. These are available at all ticket machines.
- ... dogs are not allowed in grocery stores, museums, theaters, and some historical parks.

... dog dirt has to be cleared away; otherwise it can be expensive. Poop bags are provided for free in all dog zones and all over the city.

Hundezone Donauinsel

The dog-friendly beach on Donauinsel is the place to be when looking for some refreshment.

Location: between Floridsdorfer Brücke and Nordbrücke How to get there: Ride the U6 to 'Handelskai' and take the exit marked 'Donauinsel'. Then, just walk past Floridsdorfer Brücke and stay alongside the riverbank.

<u>What to expect</u>: A few sandy stretches next to the path that give you a holiday feeling, shallow water where dogs can cool off even if they are not the biggest fans of swimming, other dogs to play with, and lots of different things to discover.

<u>Good to know:</u> There are plenty of poop bag dispensers as well as bins available, helping to keep the area clean with ease. Please note that cyclists and joggers also use this path, so watch out if your dog is easily spooked.

Hundezone Prater

If your dog could choose one place to go, it would most probably be the dog area at Prater. This comes as no surprise since it is the biggest one in Vienna!

Location: Prater

How to get there: Take the U1 to 'Praterstern', then walk – with your dog on a leash – along Prater Hauptallee until you reach doggy paradise.

<u>What to expect:</u> Nearly 300K square meters of green space for your dog to enjoy.

<u>Good to know:</u> Please keep in mind that there is a bike path throughout the area.
