Safety & Security

PERSONAL SAFETY

We have taken every possible measure to make your stay a safe and pleasant one. Barbados is also recognized for its safety, but do be aware of your surroundings as in any country. Please follow these safety tips.

IN YOUR ROOM

1. Always secure your room/entrance door.
2. Never let a stranger into your room. Always verify the identity of the person who knocks on your door.
3. Never give your room number to a stranger.
4. Do not display your room key in public or leave them in public areas or other places where they may be stolen.
5. It is also against the Hotel's policy for unregistered guests to be on the property without express permission from management.
6. Do not leave your balcony door unlocked at night or leave valuables, clothing, towels or shoes on the balcony.

AROUND THE ESTABLISHMENT

1. All stairs can be dangerous and particularly outdoor stairs which can be slippery when wet. Please exercise care when going up and down stairs and use the handrails.
2. Always lock your valuables in the provided in-room safe or safety deposit boxes at Front Desk should your room not have a safe.
3. Always make a mental note of the nearest emergency exits.

OUT & ABOUT

1. Do not draw attention to yourself by displaying large amounts of cash or expensive jewelry.
2. Do not leave valuables in your car when out driving.
3. It is important that you know where you are going. Ask for directions when unsure.
4. Do not wander to desolate or unlit areas alone.
5. Be aware of what is going on around you. If you see any suspicious activity, please report your observations to Management.
6. Be conscious of the vendors on the beach.
7. All off-property incidents should be reported to the police immediately.
8. Wearing of camouflage print is illegal in Barbados.

FIRE SAFETY

In the event there is a fire please remain calm and leave the area immediately. You can report it to the Front Desk or any Hotel Staff Member who will action our fire safety protocols accordingly.

The fire route is located behind your room door. If there is any smoke rising from behind a door or it feels hot to the touch DO NOT open it. In the case of a large fire DO NOT attempt to gather any belongings; get out of the room/area as fast as possible in a safe manner.

Each room is equipped with a smoke detector which will sound in the event of a fire. Your room is also equipped with a Fire Blanket in the event of a small fire on the stove top or in your room. Fire extinguishers are available on each floor. Please note their location.

MUSTER POINT

In the case of any emergency, or fire, there is a muster point located in the Hotel's Car Park.



SECURITY

Worthing Court Apartment Hotel is monitored via CCTV Cameras in all public and general areas. At night, a night receptionist/ security officer is located at the Front Desk to look after your every need and emergencies.

SICKNESS / INJURY

If you take ill at any point during your vacation please report it immediately to the Front Desk. A doctor or an ambulance can be called if you wish. There are three pharmacies within walking distance to the hotel should you need over the counter medication or if you have been prescribed medication from a recognized physician.



IN THE EVENT OF A HURRICANE

Each year between the months of June and November, hurricanes may occur in this part of the region. However, they are quite rare in Barbados. In the event that there is an official.

Hurricane Warning, guests will be given detailed instructions by the Hotel's Manager to ensure your safety and comfort.

There are three (3) phases in which we monitor Hurricanes:

PHASE 1: Hurricane Alert: This means that a hurricane is in the area, although it may be several hundred miles away; it will be monitored.

Phase 2: Hurricane Watch: A Hurricane is announced when it is about 36 hours away.

Phase 3: Hurricane Warning: A Hurricane expected to strike our location within 24 hours. We will call a meeting with the entire hotel should we enter a Phase 3 warning.

We will keep you informed during each stage and may make some changes in certain hotel services based on the severity of the expected weather.

If a hurricane is announced ensure that:

- All important documents, money and valuables are secure.
- Pack a small bag with essential personal items and medications, as well as a change of clothing.
- Put all your belongings in a suitcase and place them in a cupboard.
- DO NOT go swimming in the sea / pool or go outside until the all clear is given.
- The electricity will be shut off island-wide during the hurricane once the winds reach a certain speed.
- The restaurant would be closed during this period.
- Front Desk will contact you with any updates or bulletins.

HOUSE RULES

1. Checkout is at 12:00 Noon.
2. Persons who are not guests of the Hotel must be registered at reception as visitors, and notice must be given when they are leaving. Please respect this rule as it is for your own safety.
3. Management reserves the right to refuse the registration of any visitor at their discretion.
4. Your room is for your enjoyment. However, at Management's discretion you may be asked to leave for any excessive noisemaking, quarreling, partying, loud music or creating a nuisance.
5. All accounts should be settled on the evening prior to departure. Guests paying direct must pay on arrival. A cash deposit or credit card imprint is required at check-in.
6. Missing, broken or damaged items, fitting or furniture will be charged to you at replacement cost. A credit card imprint or BDS \$200.00 as a security deposit is required at check-in for this purpose.
7. Personal cheques are not accepted.
8. Worthing Court Hotel is an environmentally friendly property. We request that air-conditioning units not be used when windows and/or doors are open or when you are not in the room.
9. No glassware or bottles are to be taken poolside.
10. Topless bathing and topless sunbathing are against the law in Barbados.
11. Swimming is not permitted in the pool after 6:00pm. Notice there are no lifeguards on property, and swimming is at your own risk.
12. Aloe is a tropical plant sold on the beach for sunburn. It is not permitted on the property as it stains everything permanently. You will be charged for any damage caused by the plant and any aloe found in rooms will be discarded.
13. The hotel also offers a hospitality room with shower facilities for late departures. This is located next to the meeting room.

ACCOMMODATION

Worthing Court Apartment Hotel is comprised of self-catering rooms consisting of Standard Studios, Superior Studios, Junior One Bedrooms and One Bedroom Suites. All rooms are air-conditioned, have twin beds, queen or king beds, ensuite bathroom with shower combination, balcony or patio, and satellite TV, telephone with voice-mail, and a safe.

AIR-CONDITIONING

BEACHES

The beaches in the area are beautiful and impressive with their fine white sand and clear blue water; you could take a stroll to the following beaches:

BEACH ACCESS

The nearest access to the Worthing Beach is opposite the service station to the left of the hotel and Accra Beach is a 10 minute walk to the right of the hotel.

WORTHING BEACH:

Located on the South Coast of Barbados is the beautiful white sandy beach of Worthing. The sea in this area offers a multitude of delights for all sea lovers!

Just off-shore within swimming distance is an interesting coral reef to discover, filled with tropical fish. On the inside of this reef the swimming is extremely safe, the calm waters make it especially good for children and beginner-swimmers, as the depth of the water vary from approximately 2 - 6ft. Walking along a westerly direction along Worthing Beach, the sea becomes more lively and deep. This expanse of beach area has something exciting to offer everyone! Whatever your heart desires... it is waiting for you.

ACCRA BEACH:

This very popular South Coast beach offers a combination of exciting waves and calm swimming. Relax on a chaise lounge or on the soft white sand, under the shade of a casuarina or sea-grape tree, or enjoy one of the many water sports activities that are available from the beach such as windsurfing, sunfish sailing, Hobie Cat rides and snorkeling. Boogie boarding and body surfing are particularly popular. Vendor kiosks have been established at Rockley Beach, from which you can buy colourful clothing and local jewelry and handicraft.

Hop across the road to Quayside Centre for a great lunch (Grilled Fish, Chinese, Mexican, pizza, pasta, and ice-cream) and to shop for local craft, gifts and beachwear.

SOUTH COAST BOARD WALK:

If you walk to the right side of the Hotel, you will eventually meet the South Coast Boardwalk. This Boardwalk runs from Accra Beach all the way to the Hastings area, and is good for strolling or taking a nice run along the seaside. The Boardwalk is also decorated with many bars and restaurants. We do not advise using the boardwalk after dark, as it is not fully lit and not always patrolled by police.

All beaches in Barbados are public so feel free to roam our beautiful beaches. Please be warned that you **SHOULD NOT** eat berries found on the beach. In particular, the Manchineel Berry, which looks like a small green apple, will blister you and is **POISONOUS**. Even if you walk underneath a Manchineel Tree and water falls on you, it is possible that you will get blistered. These trees are usually marked with a red ring around the trunk. Please do not swim if red flags are up on the beaches as they indicate swimming conditions are dangerous. Also stay away from buoys as little sea insects that call the buoys home may sting you.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Beaches are public in Barbados; therefore you may find yourself approached by vendors and water sport operators.
- Say "No thank you" if you are uninterested in what they are selling.
- Transactions with unauthorized vendors will be at your own risk.
- Please note that the selling, or purchasing of illegal drugs or substances may result in prosecution.

BEACH & BATH TOWELS

In an effort to conserve the environment we operate a 'GREEN PROGRAMME' for our beach and bath towels. Your towels will be replaced every other day; if you require towels earlier, they will be available at Front Desk. Kindly note a laundry charge of Bds\$6.00 per towel will apply for an early towel exchange. Thank you for your co-operation as we endeavour to 'GO GREEN'.

In the event that a towel is lost, a charge of Bds\$20.00 per towel will be automatically billed to your room. Please dial Ext. 0.



CHECK OUT TIME

Checkout time is 12:00 noon. We kindly ask that you have your bags packed and out of the room and also your keys returned by this time. If you wish to settle any outstanding accounts the night prior to departure you are welcome to do so.

Should you wish to keep the room, we will make our best efforts to accommodate you based on the availability. A fee of US\$25 plus tax applies for a late check out for access granted until 3p.m. Failure to check out by the designated time will result in an extra night's charge being added to your room bill.

If the room is required and you have gone passed the allotted check out time, please note that management has the right to remove your personal belongings.

The Restaurant's dress code is casual and relaxed. We do ask when dining that gentlemen wear shirts and dry clothing and that ladies cover their swimsuits. It is strongly recommended that shoes be worn in the restaurant and throughout the property.

DOCTOR

For assistance, please call the Front Desk. Elcourt Clinic is an emergency 24 Hour clinic which is only 10 minutes away, while the Queen Elizabeth Hospital is approximately 20 minutes away from our hotel. We do have a list of doctors in the surrounding area as well as emergency and after-hours doctors who will come to the hotel, please note that call-out charges will apply.

DRINKING WATER

Owing to the island's natural coral structure, Barbados is renowned for having pure natural drinking water from the tap. Bottled water can be purchased from the bar or at the front desk.

DRUGS

Worthing Court has a zero tolerance policy for all illegal drugs and substances. Any person(s) selling, purchasing or consuming these substances will be reported to the authorities and evicted from the hotel. No compensation will be offered under these circumstances.

ELECTRIC POWER

The electricity is 110 Volts – 50 Cycles and a limited number of adapters are available through the Front Desk.

ENVIRONMENT & CONSERVATION

Worthing Court Apartment Hotel is committed to the preservation of our environment. We would therefore appreciate your assistance in the following areas:

1. Turn off your lights and air-conditioning when leaving your room. Please do not leave the air-conditioning running when doors and windows are opened. If you set your air-conditioning below 20 degrees C it will cause condensation.
2. Report any leaks.
3. Maximize the utilization of your beach and bathroom towels.
4. When at the beach remember that coral reefs are home to thousands of sea creatures, so when snorkeling, diving or on boat trips, please do not damage the reef or dispose of trash in the ocean.

FIRST AID

Basic first aid supplies are available from the Front Desk or you may purchase from the nearby pharmacies.

FURNITURE & FITTINGS

All our suites are fully equipped for your convenience and enjoyment. Kindly check the items in your room on check-in and immediately report any damages, missing or broken items to the Front Desk.

GRATUITIES

Gratuities are at your own discretion. If you wish to leave a gratuity for an individual you may do so directly; but if you wish to leave for a department or the entire team, we can provide an envelope at the Front Desk and this can be placed in our Gratuities drop box.

HOUSEKEEPING

Daily room service is provided. Housekeeping is open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Towels are changed every other day & sheets every 3 days. To assist us in our efforts to be environmentally friendly, please hang towels that you do not require to be changed; if you require a change, you may leave them on the floor or in the tub. We'll be happy to help you with any item needed that may not be in your suite. Please dial Ext. 0

HOSPITALITY ROOM

We have a complimentary Hospitality Room, for guests who have arrived early or have to check out at 12pm and have a later flight. The Hospitality room also has its own bathroom and shower facility for those who wish to use it are welcome to do so. So please enjoy!

IN-ROOM SAFETY DEPOSIT BOXES & VALUABLES

Please take the same precautions as you would at home. Do not leave cameras, jewelry and other valuables outside or unattended on property or at the beach when swimming or taking a walk. Valuables should be kept in the safety box provided in each room. Keep doors and windows closed and locked if leaving the accommodations. Worthing Court Apartment Hotel cannot accept any responsibility for loss of valuables left outside of the room safe. Some safes are operated by key, in the event that the safe in your room is electronic, please see the below instructions.

TO PROGRAM YOUR IN-ROOM SAFE PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS

- Your in-room safe's door should be found open.
- Behind the safe door, where the door hinge is located, you will find a red reset button.
- Press the reset button; two beeps will sound and the "proceed" light will illuminate.
- Type in your personal code (4 digits).
- Press "A" or "B" to activate code.

TO RE-OPEN THE DOOR

- Type in your personal code.
- Press "A" or "B".
- Door is unlocked
- The green light will come on; turn the knob clockwise in 5 seconds and pull out to open the safe.
- Please leave box open at your departure.

Please note: If battery light on the safe is illuminated, please inform Front Desk to have the battery changed. Please dial Ext. 0

In the event that you have lost the key to the safe



and it needs to be drilled open, you will be solely responsible for all fees associated with these charges.

INSECTS

Due to its tropical climate Barbados is home to a few pests namely mosquitoes and sand flies. Please wear repellent if they bother you and your room can be sprayed upon request. Repellent and After Bite lotions are available at the Front Desk.

IRON & IRONING BOARDS

For your convenience, ironing boards are already in your suite. We do have irons available at Front Desk. The irons are allotted to each guest for 1 hour at which time the iron is to be returned. Should an iron not be returned and we are unable to locate it you will be billed US\$50/iron.

KEYCARDS

Please note that there is a charge of US\$10.00 should you lose your room key. At departure, kindly leave the keys at Front Desk, and should you forget and take them home with you, we would appreciate if you would mail them back to us.

KITCHENETTE

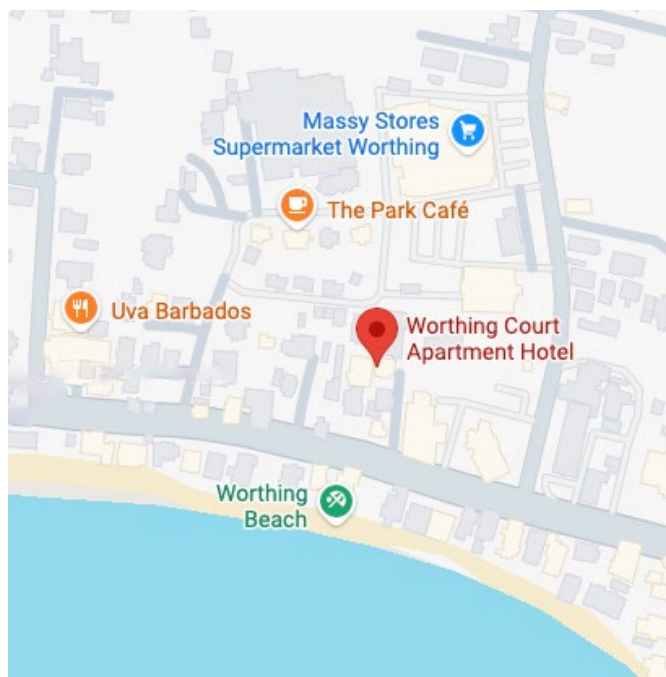
The stove is either electric or gas operated. Please take due care and attention when not in use. Check to make sure that the gas knob is in the OFF position, especially when you are leaving the room after having used the stove/oven. We also recommend that you make this check before retiring for the night. For your safety, the gas meter is checked twice throughout the night.

LAUNDRY

We provide a washer and dryer for your personal use, and the machines are token-operated. Tokens may be purchased at the Front Desk. The mini laundry is located on Block B in room#209. Soap powder is available for sale from the Front Desk. Should you require outside laundry services, this can also be arranged through the Front Desk.

LOCATION

Conveniently located 7 miles from the Grantley Adams International Airport and 5 miles from the capital, Bridgetown, we are in the heart of the trendy South Coast, with a gorgeous stretch of golden sand beach just across the road. Within walking distance, you will find two supermarkets, banks, post office, a pharmacy/chemist, a 24-hour convenience store, a gas/petrol station, and stores offering duty free shopping, boutiques, florist, beauty salon, gym facility, restaurants, bars and nightclubs.

MAIL/POSTAGE

Mail is received daily from the Front Desk, Monday – Friday. Should you wish to post anything during your stay or purchase stamps this can be done from the Worthing Post Office located behind the hotel.

MONKEYS

The Monkeys are lovely to look at, and lovely to photograph, but please be aware they are wild animals and are to be treated with respect. From time to time, you may see green monkeys on/off property and on occasion you may see them on the beach. We recommend not to feed the monkeys.

NEWSPAPERS

The local newspaper is called The Nation. The Nation is available for purchase from the 24 Hour Service Station. Please ask for details at the Front Desk.

NON-RESIDENT GUESTS

Management requests that you declare any non-resident guests to the Front Desk. If you allow any non-resident guests to enter your room, this will be at your own risk. All non-residents must be off the property by 10:00 pm.

NOTICE BOARD

Visit our notice board outside the Hotel's main offices to see what's happening with weather, tours, transportation, or dining. Also available on the wall are the hotels purchasing and environmental policies.

OISTINS

Located in Christ Church, is a major fishing community in Barbados with a modern fishing market. During the daytime at Oistins, you'll see Barbadian fishing boats and the weaving of fishing nets by local fishermen. Oistins is the site of the annual Fish Festival which honours those who contribute to the local fishing industry. Just around the corner from Oistins is Miami Beach, a great place to take a swim!

Oistins is also one of the hottest attractions in Barbados. Each Friday and Saturday night hundreds of locals and visitors flock to Oistins for the Fish-Fry, an opportunity to enjoy the very best local food - fried and grilled fish, fish cakes, sweet potato, macaroni pie, and coleslaw and so much more.

There are numerous vendors to choose from and seating is readily available. The sounds of island music fill the air, making for a memorable evening out in a very casual setting!

The Oistins Fish Fry has now become so popular that it is the second highest-rated attraction in Barbados.

To organize a taxi for Oistins, please dial 0, or take the Oistins bus for BDS\$3.50 and on return, the Bridgetown Bus for BDS\$3.50.

Free parking is provided but vehicles and contents are left at your own risk.



POOLS

Please note that the pool is unsupervised and swimming is at your own risk. No glass is allowed poolside. please respect all pool signage. Diving is not allowed.

Please note that there is no lifeguard on duty at the pool. All children under 12 years old must be supervised by an adult.

Non-guests are permitted to use our pool, once they receive confirmation from Front Desk. A fee of BDS\$20.00 would be applicable in this regard. Kindly refrain from bringing outside food and drinks around the pool area when the bar/restaurant is open.

SMOKING

Local Information

BARBADOS

Barbados is the eastern-most Caribbean island. It is located at 13.1N, 59.5W. The island, which is less than one million years old, was created by the collision of the Atlantic crustal and Caribbean plates, along with a volcanic eruption. Later coral formed, accumulating to approximately 300 feet. It is geologically unique, based on two land masses that merged together over the years.

BRIDGETOWN

Bridgetown (metropolitan pop 287,010 (2019), is the capital and largest city of Barbados. Bridgetown is sometimes locally referred to as "The City", but the most common reference is simply "Town".

The Bridgetown port, found along Carlisle Bay (at 13.106°N 59.632°W) lies on the south-western coast of the island. Bridgetown is the capital and commercial center and has a population of about 80 000. Bridgetown was originally named "Indian Bridge" for the rude bridge which had been constructed over the river (now known as the Careenage) by the Amerindians. It was later called the "town of St. Michael" in official documents, before finally being named Bridgetown.

The Chamberlain Bridge was opened in 1872 and was a manually operated swing bridge allowing entry into the inner basin of the Careenage. In 2006 the Chamberlain Bridge was replaced with a modern lift bridge.

In previous times, the careenage was an important hub of activity for inter-island trading vessels. Today the careenage is mainly used by pleasure craft (catamarans, yachts, fishing boats, etc).

Broad Street is the main street of Bridgetown and consists mainly of banks, department stores and duty free shops. Other streets in Bridgetown such as Swan Street, Roebuck Street and Tudor Street consist mainly of smaller shops and businesses, together with street vendors.
