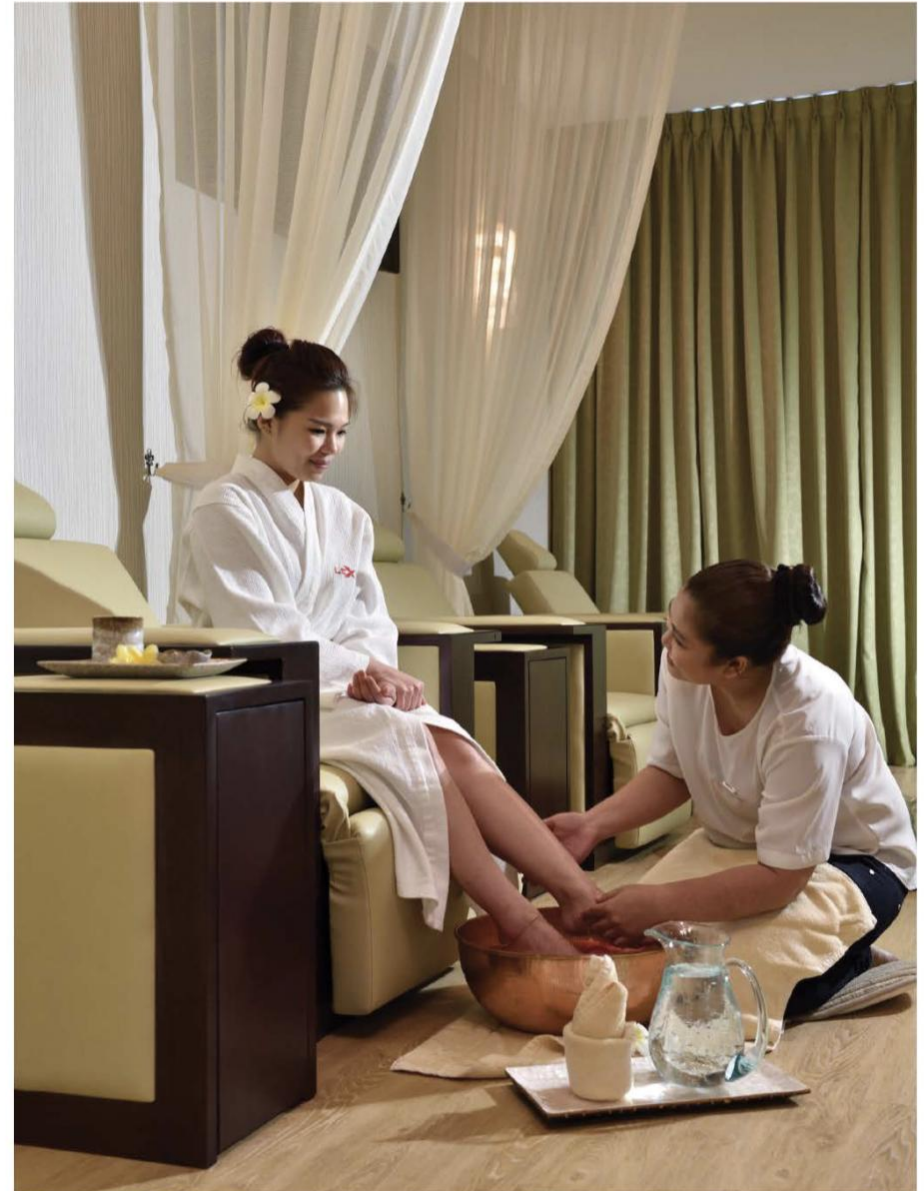
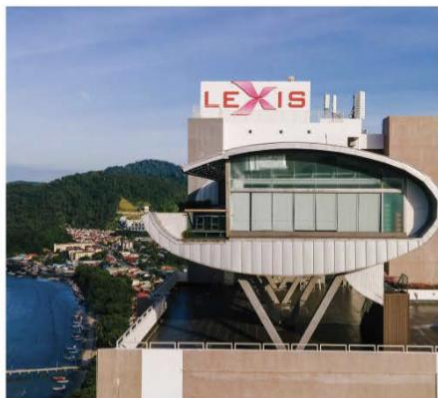
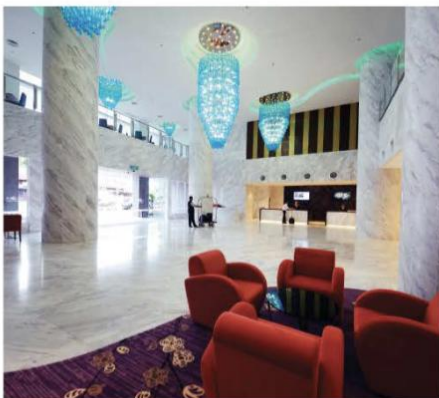




A FAMILIAR BRAND IN A NEW SETTING

Lexis Suites Penang may not have the water villas its Port Dickson sisters are known for, but it more than makes up for it with signature comfort and the fresh charm of Teluk Kumbar, where fishing villages and sea views reveal a quieter side of the island.





Lexis is not new to me. My late mother adored the resorts in Port Dickson, and over the years, they became our go-to spot for quick family getaways.

Whether it was Grand Lexis or Lexis Hibiscus, each visit left me with fond memories of spacious rooms, private pools and a relaxed, home-away-from-home vibe.

With friends too, Lexis has been a favourite choice—comfortable, fun and unfailingly reliable.

That's why stepping into Lexis Suites Penang feels both familiar and refreshing. Located in Teluk Kumbar on the island's quieter southern tip, this all-suite resort is the brand's first foray outside Port Dickson.

I don't quite know what to expect at first, but the moment I arrive, I sense that the same Lexis DNA of space, privacy and warm service is very much intact—just with a Penang twist.

All About Space, Views and Surroundings

True to its name, Lexis Suites Penang is an all-suite resort, offering 222 spacious units that each come with two standouts: a private pool and a steam room.

It's a combination that instantly sets the resort apart, giving families and groups the freedom to create their own rhythm of rest and play.

From my suite, the balcony opens to sweeping views of

the Straits of Melaka, with fishing boats dotting the horizon.

On each side of the coast, glimpses of kampung life unfold, with charming houses and colourful boats lining the shore. We are surprised by this setting—it is a Penang we have never quite seen before.

The bustle of George Town feels distant here; instead, Teluk Kumbar offers a slower, gentler pace, where the calm of the sea and the rustic charm of fishing villages create a rare pocket of tranquillity. Nevertheless, the hotel is just a shuttle ride from malls like Queensbay.

Inside, the suite is designed with comfort in mind—two king-sized beds, a lounge area and all the thoughtful touches that make a stay feel effortless.

It's easy to see why this resort is popular with families, as the private pool allows for hours of fun without even leaving the room. For couples, the privacy and indulgence make for a relaxing, intimate escape.

The resort also offers plenty of options beyond the room. The dining outlets include Roselle Coffee House, which serves up a hearty buffet spread and

Breakfast here is a treat, with local flavours alongside international favourites, ensuring everyone finds something they enjoy. On Saturday nights, Roselle fires up a Brazilian-themed BBQ buffet from 6.30pm onwards.

Recreational facilities include a spa, karaoke rooms and bicycle rentals for those who want to explore the surrounding area.

And, of course, being in Penang, you are never too far from good food. A short drive from the resort takes you to Bayan Lepas and further north to George Town, where the island's legendary street food scene awaits.

What makes Lexis Suites Penang memorable, however, is how it manages to deliver the Lexis experience in a setting that feels distinctly Penang.

It carries the warmth and comfort I've always associated with the brand, yet introduces me to a quieter, more laid-back side of the island.

For me, it feels like reconnecting with an old friend—familiar in many ways, but with a few surprises that make the encounter all the more enjoyable.
