

What's New?



Hit the Bike Trail

You've hiked the trails. Paddled the lakes. Seen the views and watched the waves. So you think you know the North Shore. But you haven't really experienced the shore until you've done it from atop two wheels. Powered by pedals, the rugged coastline and jagged mountaintops take on a whole new meaning. It's an intimate experience, and a trip unlike any other.

Bike the Gitchi Gami

One of the most accessible biking experiences along the North Shore is the paved Gitchi Gami State Trail. Running through the backyard of Bluefin Bay parallel to the shores of Lake Superior, this recreational trail is planned to eventually extend 88 uninterrupted miles from Two Harbors to Grand Marais. As of this summer, more than 29 miles are complete.

From Bluefin Bay, the closest trail sections are the Temperance River and the Lutsen Ski Hill Road Segments. The Temperance River Segment runs 3 miles each way and travels from Tofte through the picturesque interior of Temperance River State Park to the town of Schroeder. The Lutsen Ski Hill Road Segment offers 7.3 miles (one way) of paved trails and stunning Lake Superior views.

The Challenge of Off-Road

For bikers looking for a challenge, the North Shore offers no shortage of off-road experiences. Ranging from lung-busting, white knuckled single track to winding backcountry roads, the Bluefin Bay area is home to more than 2,000 miles of trails.

Perfect for families or those new to trail riding, the nearby Onion River Road trail is a 7-mile round trip ride featuring a gradual climb through scenic forest. Intermediate riders will want to check out Heartbreak Hill Loop. And Britton Peak offers a series of single-track adventures for everyone from beginner to advanced riders.

Of course, trails are available as far as the end of the Gunflint Trail and north of Grand Portage. To find your perfect trail, stop by Guest Services or visit visitcookcounty.com/biking.

Want to test your skills? You're in luck. Every June, the hugely popular Lutsen 99er draws mountain bikers from across the country ready to take on a 99, 39 or 19-mile course spread across the mountainous North Shore terrain.

Renovations, upgrades and improvements ensure guests experience the very best at Bluefin Bay Resorts

As a four-season destination, it's hard to beat Minnesota's North Shore: Warm summer days and lapping waves, vibrant fall colors atop breathtaking mountains, great skiing and the deepest snow, and gushing spring waterfalls along pristine hiking trails.

The Bluefin Bay Family of Resorts' neighborhood is as unique a location as one could possibly find in MN. So it makes sense that we're constantly striving to match both lodging and guest experiences to this gorgeous locale. At Bluefin Bay Resorts, we strive to make the indoors as great as the outdoors. And, enhancing the guest experience is always our top priority.

The Evolution of Your Bluefin Bay

Since its opening in September of 1984, Bluefin Bay has gone through some tremendous changes: Expansion of the original resort, improvement and greening of the facilities, continual additions to recreational activities offered to guests, and perhaps the biggest changes of all – the addition of two sister properties on Lake Superior – Surfside (2008) and Temperance Landing (2006).

"What makes Bluefin Bay so unique is how close we are to this spectacular lake," says Dennis Rysdahl, owner of the Bluefin Bay Family of Resorts. "Just as the lake keeps changing day after day and wave after wave, so are we. Our goal is make the resorts themselves as wonderful on a guest's fifteenth summer here as it was on their first."

That commitment to staying current and updated means change is constantly afoot. Some of that change takes place as growth. Bluefin Bay recently finished construction on six new condo units damaged in the fire of 2014, and Surfside will open three new luxury townhomes by the end of the summer.

Upscale, comfortable interiors of the quality our guests expect

Other change occurs continually in the form of updates and upgrades to ensure that each lakeside condo and townhome stays both current and comfortable, living up to the resort's "upscale" reputation.

Carol Perkins, Bluefin Bay's Quality Interiors Director, and her team visit every unit at least twice a year, inspecting for wear and tear, needed updates and overall quality. These inspections result in not just regular replacement of carpets, wallpaper and appliances, but also major overhauls.

At Bluefin Bay, work was recently completed on rebuilding all fireplaces, including new surrounding stonework. Furniture has been replaced in nearly every unit within the past six years. Last year alone, Bluefin Bay remodeled 20 bathrooms, complete with custom tile, showers and new whirlpools. And, the resort is on pace to complete 12 additional bathroom remodels in 2015. Ten kitchens were completely remodeled in 2014 and upgrades of the remaining kitchens will take place in units throughout the Bluefin Bay resort in 2015 and 2016. And the resort's new designer and decorator, Jessica Carlson, will be designing a plan to unify the quality and look across all units.

Getting Wired: Entertainment and technology upgrades

From an entertainment perspective, all TVs throughout Bluefin Bay have been upgraded and are now receiving HD signal and an expanded channel listing. Rooms also received brand new WIFI-equipped blu-ray DVD players, offering guests the chance to watch Netflix, Hulu and more right on their in-room TV.

Cell phone service throughout the area also received a boost when a new 150-foot tower was activated in January, with many carriers operating off the new service.

Outside grounds and property improvements

The Bluefin Bay Family of Resorts is continually working to match the beauty of the grounds with the beauty of our natural surroundings. In addition to new cedar roofs, repainted exteriors and replaced lakeside decking at Bluefin Bay, our landscaping crew works tirelessly to ensure every inch of the resort meets even the most exacting standards of our valued guests.


