Set within 600 acres of beautiful Warwickshire countryside, our hotel offers the perfect escape where both you and your four-legged companion can relax and explore.

With scenic walks on your doorstep, it makes it easier for guests to take their dogs out for morning and evening walks.

We’re also incredibly fortunate here at Polo Club Hotel to be surrounded by some of Warwickshire’s loveliest green spaces — many just minutes from our door. Whether you’re after a gentle amble to stretch your legs after a long drive, or a longer countryside trek to tire out an energetic pup, this county has something for every dog and every walker.

Inside this booklet, you’ll find our favourite local routes, handpicked for their scenery, dog-friendliness, and very ease of access from the hotel. We hope these walks help you and your four-legged companion make the most of your stay.

So grab a lead, pack some water, and go explore!

UFTON NATURE RESERVE (UFTON FIELDS)

Distance: 1.3 miles

This former limestone quarry has been reclaimed by nature into a 78-acre haven. It features a beautifully maintained, flat, 1.25-mile (2.1 km) all-weather circular trail that makes walking effortless in any season.

HOLY WELL WALK (SOUTHAM)

Distance: 2 miles from the carpark

A gentle 2.5-mile historic trail leading past England's oldest recorded holy spring alongside the River Stowe. Portions pass through open farming fields where livestock may graze, meaning a lead is handy.

MILLENNIUM WAY: LONG ITCHINGTON AND THE GRAND UNION CANAL

Distance: 3.2 miles

Flat, scenic waterside walking along the canal. Highly dog-friendly with paths connecting to local dog-welcoming canal-side pubs like The Blue Lias Inn or The Two Boats Inn.

CHESTERTON WINDMILL

Distance: 5 miles

A short 10-to-15 minute open grassland wander around the iconic 17th-century stone tower landmark with sweeping rural views.



BURTON DASSETT HILLS COUNTRY PARK

Distance: 6.1 miles

Offers wide-open rolling hills with sweeping 360-degree panoramic views of the Warwickshire countryside. Dogs are welcome on leads.

WARWICKSHIRE LAVENDAR FARM (SEASONAL)

Distance: 9.1 miles

Warwickshire Lavender Farm is a charming, family-run attraction located in Bubbenhall, Warwickshire. Founded as a retirement project in 2016, it grew from a few beehives into a peaceful haven dedicated to health, wellbeing, and local agriculture.

RYTON POOLS

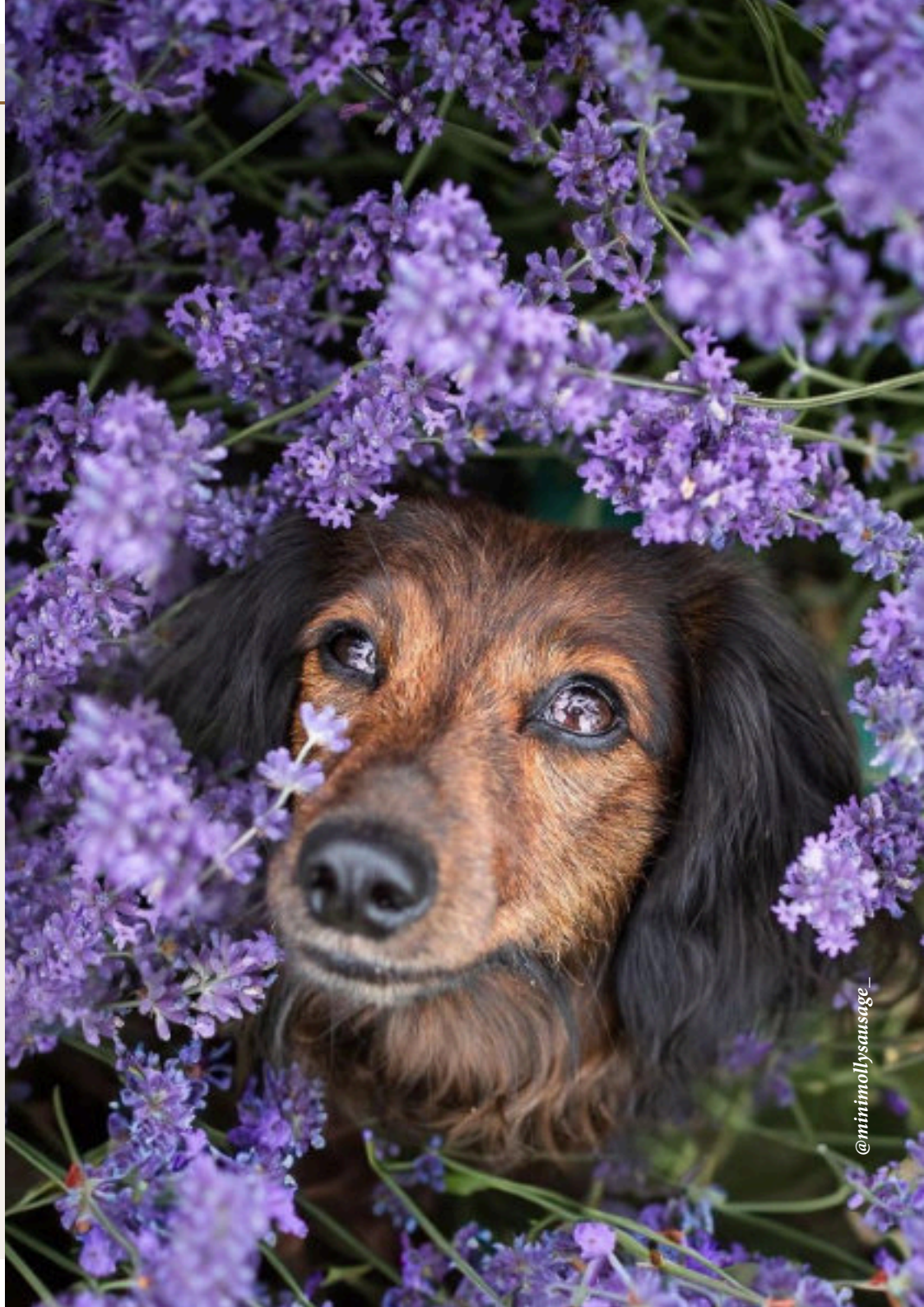
Distance: 9.9 miles

The park features several well-surfaced paths that make walking easy for pushchairs, wheelchairs, and mobility scooters. It loops around multiple tranquil pools (great for spotting water birds) and connects directly to the ancient Ryton Wood via the Warwickshire Wildlife Trust.

KENILWORTH CASTLE

Distance: 11.9 miles

Scale the heights of the tower built to woo Queen Elizabeth I and marvel at the mighty Norman keep. Explore the exhibition in the Gatehouse, and imagine the majesty of the Great Hall playing host to medieval monarchs and early Tudor kings.
