


THE MISSION INN HOTEL & SPA

Your Place in History

Occupying an entire city block and encompassing 320,000 square-feet, The Mission Inn Hotel & Spa is located in downtown Riverside, California. The Inn began as a two-story adobe guesthouse in 1876. In 1903, Frank Miller began to expand the original facilities, a process that took more than 30 years to complete. The finished project incorporates design elements from throughout the southwestern United States and several Mediterranean countries with a particular influence from the California missions. It incorporates the work of several California architects including Arthur Benton, Myron Hunt and G. Stanley Wilson. The Inn represents a blending of architectural elements, flying buttresses, domes, a bell tower, clock towers, interior courtyards and patios, a five-story open-air rotunda and a circular wrought-iron staircase.

The Inn features 239 guest rooms (Including 28 suites), Duane's Prime Steak's and Seafood, the Mission Inn Restaurant and Spanish Patio, Las Campanas Mexican Cuisine & Cantina, Bella Trattoria, and the Presidential Lounge. The property also houses 15,100 square-feet of meeting and banquet space, 5,000 square-feet of outdoor courtyard space, a Classic Californian out-door swimming pool and two wedding chapels.

Drawing on the rich, colorful history the Mission Inn Hotel & Spa possesses, Kelly's Spa bridges the gap between the indigenous Spanish mission architecture of the hotel and the serene, sophisticated spaces of a luxurious European Spa.

Kelly's Spa is the creation of Kelly Roberts who, together with her husband Duane, owns the Mission Inn Hotel & Spa. The lavish 7,000 square-foot spa has an intimate feel that offers a tranquil refuge for guests to retreat from the hustle of the outside world. Inspired by the villas of Tuscany, the spa features a warm color palate of gold accented with green and terra cotta, all brought to life by the soft light of custom Venetian chandeliers. In addition to the 12 treatment rooms, with five featuring outdoor terra cotta tiled patios, two specifically for therapeutic baths, and a nail salon, there are two private villas that can be used for couples, groups of friends, or for those wishing anonymity. Guests of the spa can choose from an extensive treatment menu of luxurious Italian therapies, traditional Swedish and Shiatsu massage and specialty facials.

Our Pick: Kelly's Signature Anti-aging Facial. Using pure, indigenous ingredients, this facial calms and restores balance. This unique treatment lightens natural pigments and fills in lines and wrinkles. The results- oriented facial increases the moisture content of your skin at the cellular level. This 80 minute organic facial is gentle enough for any skin type and is a virtual face lift that will make you feel 10 years younger!
