THE HIGHLANDER HOTEL AND HER SUPPER CLUB ARE BACK

The Highlander Supper Club was built in 1967. The hotel, ballroom and pool followed in 1974. For the next 30 years, both experienced extraordinary success playing host to celebrities like Micky Mantle, Joan Baez and Arnold Palmer, arguably becoming one of the most popular entertainment, event, dining and hotel destinations in Iowa history.

The next 20 years were a time of slow decline for The Highlander, by 2019 the icon was in serious distress. Iowa entrepreneur, Angela Harrington purchased the Highlander in December of 2019, three months before a pandemic would bring financial catastrophe to the industry. Three years later, thanks to her husband Steve, the interior renovation is complete and the property is now designated as a local landmark by the Iowa City Historic Preservation Commission. Don't tell Steve, but outdoor plans include a new parking lot, pickleball courts, a splash pad fountain in the courtyard, and mini golf! :)

The Highlander Hotel has been reinvented as a chic boutique urban resort, now the only independent hotel in Iowa City, one of two hotels in Iowa owned by a woman, the other being her sister hotel also owned by Harrington - Hotel Grinnell in Grinnell, Iowa. The Supper Club, shuttered for two decades, but with its epic sunken bar restored, again is now a multi-generational gathering place for entertainment and steak & seafood fare reminiscent of the original 1967 Highlander Supper Club menu.
