## WESTERN AUSTRALIA'S WINE REGIONS



Western Australia's wine regions are as diverse as the landscapes they occupy, offering a remarkable range of climates, terroirs, and varieties. The historic Swan Valley, Australia's second-oldest wine region, began in 1829 and remained WA's sole wine region for 125 years. Uniquely positioned just 25 minutes from Perth, it continues to thrive with sun-drenched hills ideal for heat-loving varieties.

Further south, the Geographe region stands out for its diversity, with over three dozen varieties planted across Harvey, Capel, and Ferguson Valley. This variety reflects the region's dynamic character and ability to produce wines of distinctive style. Pemberton and Great Southern add to this richness with dramatic contrasts—from rugged coastlines to towering timber forests. Their cool climates and isolation yield wines that express the pristine, ancient environments from which they originate.

Finally, Margaret River has become synonymous with world-class wine. When Dr. John Gladstones identified its potential in 1966, few could have predicted its rise. The first vines at Vasse Felix marked the beginning of a region celebrated for elegant wines shaped by a gentle climate and the moderating influence of the Indian Ocean. Today, Margaret River remains a benchmark for structure, vitality, and grace.

## RIESLING

Riesling is one of Australia's most revered white varieties, with legendary expressions from Clare and Eden Valleys in South Australia setting the benchmark for decades. For Western Australia, particularly the Great Southern region, Riesling is quietly building its own legacy — one defined by ethos, passion, and the cool-climate sites it calls home. West Australian Riesling tends to be dry, racy, and citrus-driven, with palates featuring stunning lime, green apple, and prominent minerality, underpinned by crisp acidity and a long, clean finish.

## CHENIN BLANC
