




Located where the dynamic developments of Marina Bay intersect with the world famous Singapore skyline, and where the historic district meets the future,



# CLIFFORD PIER





## ONE FULLERTON



A graceful, modern 2-storey waterfront development blessed with stunning vistas, the One Fullerton is perfectly poised to take advantage of the **all-day attention of tourists as well as the over 50,000 business executives** and residents in the area.

One Fullerton is the new focal point for waterfront dining where diners and night revelers enjoy resplendent views of the Marina Bay waterfront. 
One Fullerton is directly adjacent to the well-recognised, historic Merlion Park, home to the Merlion – Singapore's icon that attracts over 1 million unique visitors every year. One Fullerton is also well placed alongside a vantage point on the F1 track of the world's first night city Grand Prix. This is a focal point for the entire Marina Bay area with vast appeal to tourists and locals alike and a vibrant urban gathering point. It is well served by over 6000 parking spaces within five minutes' walk.

## Customs House



A charming conservation building featuring unique fine dining and entertainment concepts with stunning waterfront views.

Built in the late 1960s, this was the Customs Harbour Branch building, one of the earliest of Singapore's public buildings to be built in the simple and functional idiom known as the 'Modern' style. The bowtie-shaped protruding panels on its facade create distinctive visual interest and the square, umbrella-like pavilions at the end of the pier also present a sleek, elegant appearance. It was the home of the Singapore Customs Police, tasked with watching over one of the world's busiest harbours, as Singapore's shipping and trade boomed from the 1960s onwards.



The place to see and be seen, the Customs House attracts a sophisticated and energetic crowd of jet-setters, celebrities, socialites and locals as well as tourists.


## THE FULLERTON HOTEL SINGAPORE

### WORKING POPULATION

area including the Esplanade, Marina Bay, Marina Bay
Sands, Gardens by The Bay, the Asian Civilisations
Museum, Merlion Park, Clarke Quay and the
Marina Barrage.

There are over 7000 5-star hotel rooms in the Marina Bay area, accommodating the surge in high spending business and leisure travellers.






The Fullerton Heritage precinct benefits from easy underground access to both Raffles Place MRT and the Bayfront MRT station at Marina Bay. There are also clearly marked connections with the new developments along the Marina Bay through covered, all-weather pedestrian walkways, underground tunnels and the like.

River taxis ferry passengers from our own dedicated landing points to the Marina Bay Sands across the Bay as well as the established riverfront areas of Clarke Quay and Boat Quay.
