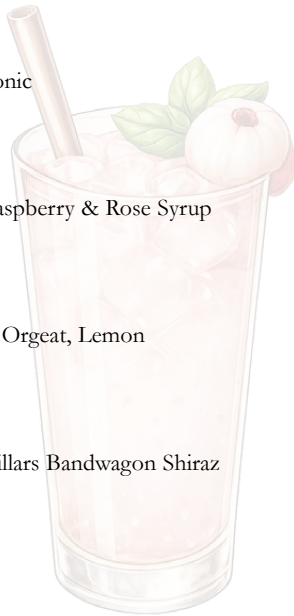

2023 | Alfio Cosentino, Vigna Don Paolo, Etna Bianco | Sicilia, Italy

This expression of Carricante from the volcanic soils of Mt. Etna displays an energy bursting with citrus oils, white flowers and a good pinch of salt. The palate is rich while still having bright acid to wrap around the fruit.

2023 | Pieropan, 'Calvarino' Soave | Veneto, Italy

Named after the "small ordeal" of working its challenging volcanic soils, the 2023 Calvarino is a vibrant, organic Soave Classico that balances a ripping acidity with an elegant, silky texture. This complex mid-weight white offers an intense bouquet of honey and stone fruits, finishing with salty mineral nuances that make it both a critical darling and an effortless crowd-pleaser.

2022 | I Custodi, 'Pistus', Nerello Mascalese | Sicilia, Italy

A soulful tribute to Sicilian tradition, the 2022 Pistus captivates with its bright red fruit profile and mineral-driven purity. Its graceful, light-bodied structure and polished tannins make for a refreshing and pristine expression of high-altitude Nerello Mascalese.

2017 | Cantine di Dolianova, Moscato di Sardegna | Sardegna, Italy

Grown on limestone and granite soils around Dolianova and crafted by the renowned Sardinian cooperative this moscato shows purity and lifted aromatics.

2023 | Giuseppe Quintarelli, Bianco Secco | Veneto, Italy

The 2023 Bianco Secco is a refined and captivating blend of local and international grapes, offering a layered profile of green melon, lime zest, and salty minerals that punch well above its class. By combining traditional Veneto varieties with a touch of air-dried fruit, the Quintarelli family has crafted a bright, textured white that balances elegant tension with a long, fresh finish.

2020 | François Millet & Fils, 'La Macabréé' | Auxey-Duresses, France

This compelling white Burgundy delivers an impressive breadth on the nose, slowly evolving with air into a fine, ginger-spiced profile that closely mirrors the style of a Meursault. On the palate, a textural richness meets a vibrant line of purity and freshness, beautifully framed by hints of apple and a delicate touch of fine tannin.

2020 | Massolino, Barolo | Piemonte, Italy

A complete and captivating expression of the estate's diverse terroirs, this classic garnet-red Barolo opens with a broad, evolving bouquet ranging from enticing spice to sweet floral and fruit notes. Traditional ageing in large Slavonian oak casks yields a full-bodied, well-structured palate that perfectly captures the powerful character of the region, offering incredible purity and excellent ageing potential.

2023 | Pressing Matters, 'R139' Riesling | Tasmania, Australia

Hailing from Tasmania's Coal River Valley, the 2023 R139 is a luscious Riesling defined by the estate's unique volcanic limestone soils and a cooling micro-climate that fosters deep fruit intensity and a steely acid structure. Part of a precisely calibrated range where the name clearly denotes its residual sugar level, this vintage captures the vineyard's "high-density, high-quality" philosophy through a vibrant, crystalline expression of late-ripened fruit.

PODERI ALDO CONTERNO

The Bussia vineyard is far more than a source of fruit; it is the physical foundation of the Conterno legacy and the realization of a dream decades in the making. While the family's roots in Monforte d'Alba stretch back to the 19th century, Bussia represents the specific terroir Aldo chose in 1969 to define his independent vision. The estate acts as a "calm and patient interpreter" of this land, famously practicing a rigorous selection process known as taking the "fillet" of the vineyards. Though their 25 hectares could easily yield up to 280,000 bottles annually, the family chooses to cap production at approximately 80,000 bottles, ensuring only the most virtuous essence of the Bussia hills – the heart of the Barolo area – is ever bottled under the Aldo Conterno name.

Despite this intensity, the village's best sites utilize their high elevations to maintain a characteristic "limestone lift" and mineral freshness, resulting in wines that marry a massive, brooding structure with staggering aromatic complexity.

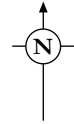

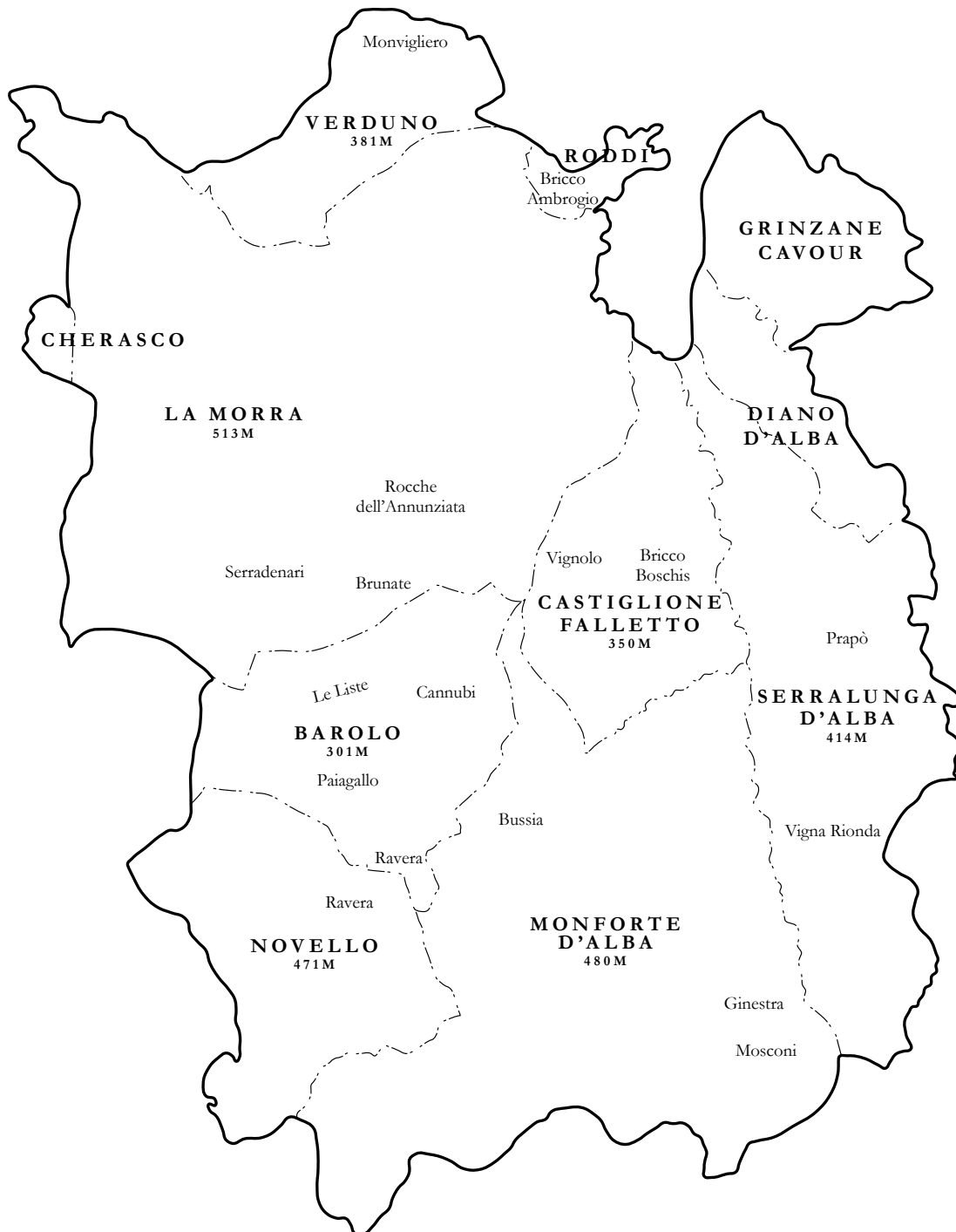

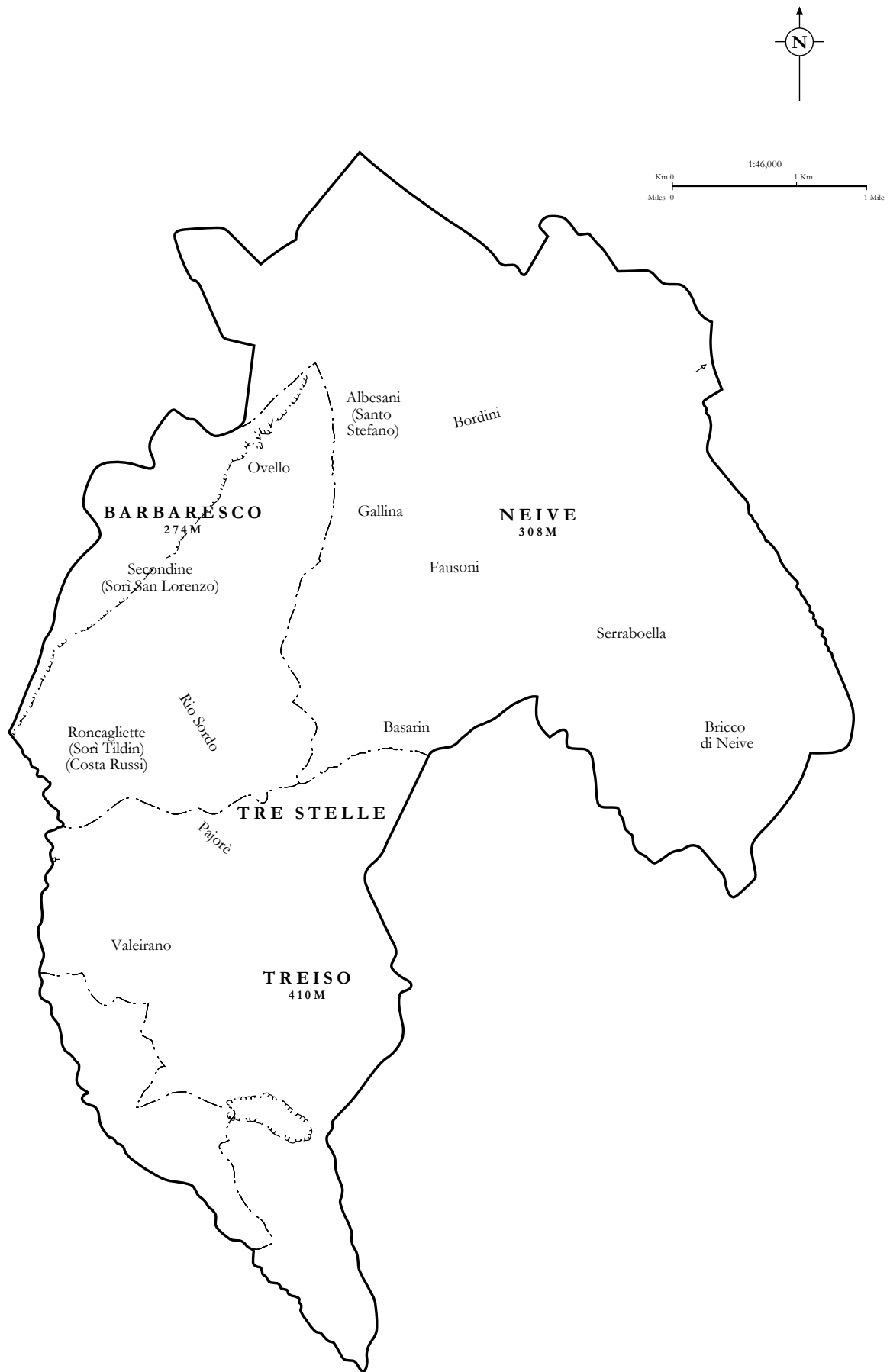

The Whites of Piemonte

First released in 1983, "Gaja & Rey" spilled a lot of ink. Planting Chardonnay within the boundaries of Barbaresco was considered an heresy at the time. It is now one of Italy's finest white wines.

Rossj-Bass gets his name from the Rossj vineyard named after Rossana, Angelo's second daughter. The wine is a blend of Chardonnay with a hint of Sauvignon blanc.

Single Vineyards of Barbaresco

The single crus used to be blended with Barbera but have been 100% Nebbiolo in recent vintages.

"Sori" is local dialect for "sunny," and it is used for the best vineyard sites with great sun exposure.

Sori San Lorenzo is a very steep vineyard near rivers with a limestone rich soil absorbing any excess water. San Lorenzo is the Patron Protecting Alba's Cathedral. The family kept the name after buying the vineyard of the church.

Sori Tildin is an amphitheater-shaped vineyard at the top of the hill above the Costa Russi vineyard. The soil is sandier and warmer here, and vines are planted vertically and at a higher density. Tildin was the diminutive of Angelo's Grand mother, Clotilde.

Barolo

Dagromis is a blend of 7 crus. There is a beautiful mosaic here of both vine age and terroir, starting with vines planted in 1965.

Sperss, Nostalgia in Piemontese dialect, is a vineyard in the heart of Serralunga that was dear to Angelo's Father and is the first step of the family outside of Barbaresco.

Conteisa, Contest in Piemontese Dialect refers to the 100 years old dispute over the ownership of the Cerequio vineyard: la Morra and Barolo. The wine is usually more sensual and richer.

SPOTLIGHT ON - ANGELO GAJA

TOSCANA

Pieve Santa Restituta is the first step of Angelo outside of Piemonte. The vineyard was purchased in 1994 and many redevelopments work have been done to align the estate with Angelo's winemaking beliefs.

The Ca'Marcanda project was propelled by Angelo Gaja's ambition to challenge himself with Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot. After over 20 meetings with the previous owners the 70ha site was purchased at the end of 1996. The name Ca'Marcanda is derived from these protracted negotiations and is a term in the Piemontese dialect that means 'house of endless negotiations'.

The Whites of Tuscany

The Vistamare Vineyard (Sea View in Italian) is located near Bibbona, just outside of the Bolgheri appellation. It is a blend of Vermentino, with a 20% Fiano and 10% barrel aged viognier.

Meaning 'She', it is an affectionate name in Sicilian dialect; used by locals to refer to Mount Etna.

South Facing slopes on the Etna are famous for its red wines. 80% of the entire Etna slopes are planted with Nerello Mascalese. Here again, the family decided to go against the trend and to plant mainly a white grape: Caricante. The wines comes from 2 vineyards both above 600m above sea level and show all the minerality the volcanic soils have to offer. Most of the Idda Production will be white.
