ONE-HOUR TRIPS: Great for beginners and young children ages 6 and up. This ride goes along the Snake River and is perfect if you just want a taste of horseback riding!

TWO-HOUR TRIPS: This ride starts on a flat trail and gradually transitions uphill to where you will see great views of the Snake River and surrounding area! This is a great short trip if you want to see good views.

THREE-HOUR TRIPS: Ride along the Horse Creek Drainage where you will eventually cross the creek on horseback! This ride will also have the same views as the two-hour trip.

HALF-DAY TRIPS: This ride is perfect if you want to travel a little further and see some wildlife. You will ride along the border of the Gros Ventre wilderness, stopping for a picnic at the half-way point.

FULL-DAY TRIPS: This is the whole experience if you want to spend the whole day in Jackson Hole on horseback! You will have the opportunity to see beautiful views, wildlife, and cross creeks while climbing hills. Lunch is also included on this ride!

SUMMARY

Enjoy a guided horseback ride atop the East Gros Ventre Butte! Take in the unique views of the Teton Mountain Range, the town of Jackson, and the surrounding area from atop your horse. We recommend wearing closed toe shoes and long pants!

REQUIREMENTS

WHAT TO WEAR/BRING

Wear water friendly shoes that will stay on. Neoprene booties can be rented for \$5. Wear water friendly clothing and be sure to bring a change of clothes. Wetsuits for adults are available for \$15; kids get free wetsuits.

SUMMARY

This is a beginner friendly experience, perfect for all! The West Table to Sheep Gulch section begins with mostly Class 1 and 2 waves to provide a warm up before hitting the more exciting, Class 3 rapids in the next section. This is a "pool and drop" stretch of river, which means there are nice calm stretches of water to float and swim in between each set of waves.

NATIONAL PARK TOURS & SAFARIS

HALF DAY IN GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK

WHAT TO WEAR

Comfortable clothing according to the season, rain/wind shell, sunglasses, and sunscreen. It's always wise to bring snacks and extra water.

JENNY LAKE

This bike tour will use the "Paved Pathway" in Grand Teton National Park. The tour rides directly beneath the majestic peaks of the Teton Mountain Range through wide open sagebrush plains with bordering lodge pole pine and aspen forests. This is an out and back route on a paved pathway. The terrain is relatively flat – an easy ride.

SPREAD CREEK

This mountain bike tour follows the Spread Creek Drainage through incredible mountain meadows and aspen groves with prize winning views of the Tetons. This tour uses a combination of dirt service roads and single-track routes whose terrain is moderate. An awesome mountain bike riding experience.

TETON VIEW

This mountain bike tour follows along the eastern border of Grand Teton National Park through the open sagebrush plains with incredible views of the Tetons. The tour travels on a combination of less traveled paved and dirt roads with moderate terrain – an exciting full day of riding experience.

FLAGSTAFF

This mountain bike tour begins in the high alpine meadow of the Togwotee Pass area with its abundance of colorful wildflowers and follows the Flagstaff Creek through lush pine forests to Lily Lake and Sagebrush Flats. This tour offers breathtaking views of the Teton Range around each corner.

WHAT TO WEAR: Sun hat, sun shirt, sunglasses (polarized), light pants or shorts, shoes that protect toes, and plenty of sunblock.

REQUIREMENTS: Valid Wyoming Fishing license. Licenses can be purchased on-line at https://wgfd.wyo.gov/apply-or-buy/

SUMMARY: Cast for native trout on one of the most cherished waterways in the world of fly fishing. Full day trips occur on eight sections of the river within Grand Teton National Park, Bridger-Teton National Forest, and parcels under the authority of the Bureau of Land Management.

WHAT TO WEAR: Sun hat, sun shirt, sunglasses (polarized), light pants or shorts, shoes that protect toes, and plenty of sunblock.

REQUIREMENTS: Valid Wyoming Fishing license. Licenses can be purchased on-line at https://wgfd.wyo.gov/apply-or-buy/

SUMMARY: Journey to hidden gems of the fly-fishing world. Cast for some of the largest Brown and Rainbow trout in the West.

WHAT TO WEAR: Sun hat, sun shirt, sunglasses (polarized), light pants or shorts, shoes that protect toes, and plenty of sunblock. Yellowstone trips are wade fishing except for Lewis Lake.

REQUIREMENTS: Valid Wyoming Fishing license. Licenses can be purchased on-line at https://wgfd.wyo.gov/apply-or-buy/

SUMMARY: Guided trips are offered on the Firehole, Gibbon, Madison, Snake, and Yellowstone rivers. Crayfish Lake and Lewis Lake are also options.

WHAT TO WEAR: Sun hat, sun shirt, sunglasses (polarized), light pants or shorts, shoes that protect toes, and plenty of sunblock.

REQUIREMENTS: Valid Wyoming Fishing license. Licenses can be purchased on-line at https://wgfd.wyo.gov/apply-or-buy/

SUMMARY: The Salt River is perfect for people new to fly fishing and favorite among dry fly purists. Cast from the boat for native Cutties and Rainbow Trout.



ATV TOUR

SUMMARY

The tour starts about 30 minutes north of Jackson in the Bridger Teton National Forest. This trip includes about 2 hours on the trail with great mountain scenery. The morning starts by driving along the National Elk Refuge and Antelope Flats. Keep your eyes open for bison, antelope, and moose sightings. This half-day trip originates at the base of Shadow Mountain or Slide Lake. Enjoy excellent views of the Tetons.

REQUIREMENTS

Drivers must be 16 years old with a valid driver's license. Passengers must be 8 years or older.

Half Day: Enjoy views of the Tetons (weather permitting) as you enjoy one of the most unique ways to see Jackson Hole. Start by driving along the National Elk Refuge and Antelope Flats. Your guide will have extensive knowledge of the area's history!

Full Day: Enjoy one of the most unique ways to tour the valley with a knowledgeable guide and get off the beaten path. This trip takes you along the Elk Refuge and then deep into the Gros Ventre Valley, to remoe spots such as Gunsight Pass and Crystal Creek, with river crossings and opportunities to spot wildlife.

REQUIREMENTS

Drivers must be 18 years old with a valid drivers license, and passengers must be 8 years old or older.
