



CONCIERGE RECOMMENDED ACTIVITIES

WINTER 2025/2026

The Concierge team at the Stein Eriksen Lodge is pleased to welcome you for the winter season! The following are activities to consider, in addition to time on the slopes. Please note that some activities are up to an hour away from the lodge and may require transportation. Reservations are recommended and often required. Please visit the concierge desk for information and booking help.

Art Galleries – Park City’s art scene is thriving, offering a robust variety of unique art collections from local, national, and international, artists. On the last Friday of each month, nineteen galleries open their doors for visitors and locals to enjoy light refreshments and to admire their latest art installations.

Backcountry Ski Adventures - This day kicks off as you use your own power (i.e., your legs) to tour up the mountain and go where chairlifts do not. Our guides are equipped with an intimate knowledge of the area and are trained to provide you with a safe and fun experience. If you are looking to escape the crowds and ski untouched snow... and don't mind working for it, this experience is for you!

Bobsled Rides – Feel the rush as you speed down the Olympic track in a 4-person bobsled. A trained pilot will take you and two other passengers through fifteen curves, reaching speeds up to 80 mph, and pulling close to 5 Gs of force. Billed as the most intense minute of your life, this ride will give you an idea of what Olympic bobsled athletes experience. Riders must be sixteen with a valid driver’s license.

Cross-Country Skiing – A 20+ km cross-country ski center in the heart of Park City offers spectacular mountain views along one of three groomed loops. With 3k, 5k, and 10k+ loops, they are perfect for beginner, intermediate, and advanced classic or skate skiers. Heated underground parking, passes, equipment, and lessons, are all offered on-site. Private cross-country tours are also available.

Dog Sledding – Experience a once-in-a-lifetime dog sledding adventure. Taking a sled ride through remote terrain is nothing short of exhilarating. The companies we work with have teams of beautiful huskies and other arctic breeds, some of which are rescue dogs, all ready to take you on a sled guided by professional racers from all over the world!

Fly Fishing – If you are fly fishing on Utah's famous Provo River you can be assured of a great day fishing. Experienced guides provide the equipment and everything you need to catch a trophy in the crisp Utah air.

Heli-skiing – Both intermediate and expert skiers can helicopter into deep powder caches in private or small groups. Skiers take about seven runs averaging 14,000 vertical feet of unforgettable powder.

Horseback Riding – Horseback riding through beautiful private land is offered year-round from outfitters located about 35-60 minutes from the lodge. Viewing the mountains, the wilderness, and even wildlife in its natural habitat will create memories for everyone.

Ice Skating – Fun for the whole family. There are both indoor and outdoor options. Skate rentals are available, but make sure to dress warmly!

Park City Ghost Tours – This 90-minute walking tour of Park City includes stories about the town's history and the ghosts that still live here. Tours leave from Miner's Park on Main Street.

Park City Museum – After a \$9 million renovation and expansion, the Park City Museum offers a glimpse into our rough silver mining past. Located on Main Street in the heart of Old Town.

Sleigh Rides – Take a 30-minute tour of mid-mountain Deer Valley from right outside our back door. The small sleigh can accommodate up to five people, with a larger sleigh accommodating up to twelve.

Sleigh Ride to Dinner – This old-fashioned horse-drawn sleigh ride will take you from the base of the Park City Mountain Resort up the slopes to a mountain lodge and a western-style gourmet meal. Listen to entertainment and then enjoy your sleigh ride back.

Snowcat Skiing – An hour from Park City, enjoy 8-10 runs and 10,000 vertical feet.

Snowmobile Tours – Snowmobiling can offer a true back-country experience with over 100,000 acres of forested trails, huge meadows of seemingly bottomless powder, and breathtaking views from up to 11,000 ft. Trips can be arranged for one hour to all day.

Snowshoeing – Guided and unguided snowshoe tours are an excellent activity, whether you are looking for a scenic aerobic experience or just a peaceful walk in the woods. Certain outfitters offer transportation, picking you up at the lodge and driving you to a location nearby.

Tubing – Soldier Hollow and Woodward Park City offer snow tubing and fun for the whole family. Day or night, the family can zoom down the hill and ride back up to do it again.

Utah Olympic Park - Built for the Salt Lake 2002 Olympic Winter Games is a 400-acre venue that houses a sledding track, six Nordic ski jumps, a 2002 Winter Games Museum, and a multitude of adventure activities. The Olympic Park offers a bobsled course, tours, and a chance to see where Olympians made history!

Woodward Park City - This is a world-class, year-round action sports destination in one of the greatest outdoor regions in the world. Woodward Park City has lift-accessed snowboarding and skiing, as well as indoor and outdoor facilities for skateboarding, BMX, scooter, parkour, and cheer. Woodward Park City also offers snow tubing serviced by two surface lifts with the longest lanes in Utah.
