  - How many weddings can they accommodate on any given weekend?
  - Can they help you manage your payment schedule?
  - Will they assist with overall budget management?
  - Ask about any unique services they may offer.
  - Ask about a wedding that didn't go as planned and how they got back on track.
  - Ask if they can give you a few recent references.
