400 Tea Lights Candles Lit by Resort Guest and Staff to Commemorate Earth Hour

Port Dickson, March 30, 2019 - Lexis Hibiscus Port Dickson participated in the annual worldwide Earth Hour in raising awareness of and taking action against the worldwide global warming issue on Saturday, 30 March 2019 for the second consecutive year.

By turning the lights off, the resort saved up to 754.93 kilowatt of electricity in a mere one hour.

Earth Hour was launched by WWF in Sydney in 2007 as a symbolic event, it is one of the biggest movements for the environment inspiring millions of people all around the world to take positive action for our planet.

The event started off with fire show performance by sport and recreational team at outside of the resort's main lobby. All in-house guests were gathered at outside of the resort lobby and witnessed some thrilling daredevil acts and stunts. Hotel guests and staffs then called to engage in candle lighting session to commemorate Earth Hour. A big "60+" logo of Earth Hour was illuminated at the resort's main lobby along with performance by in-house live band with the environment and nature theme songs.
