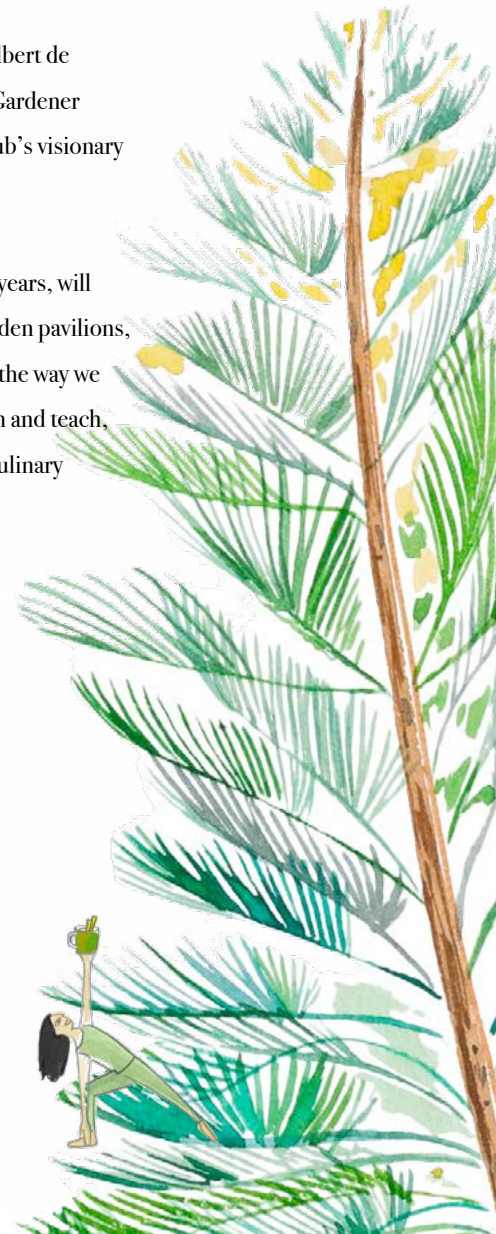

Cabinet de curiosités

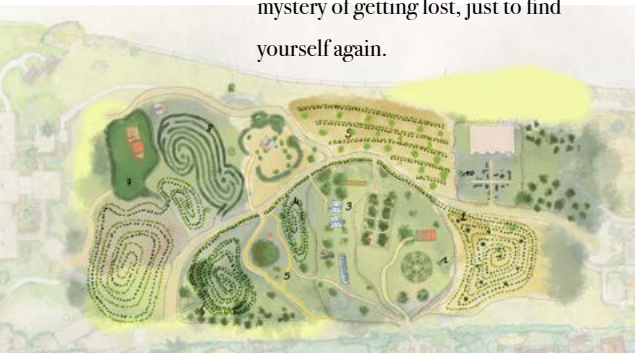

The Heritage & Tomato Gardens

Our gardens are home to 300 vegetable and herb varieties, and 100 tomato varieties stemming from Louis Albert's very own conservatory in France, established over 30 years ago. In the wealth of this medley comes the concept of biodiversity, and a teaching tool to discover what kind of active principles the various plants can bring to our overall health and wellbeing, as well as leading and employing techniques that utilise resources efficiently and embrace the philosophy of upcycling.
