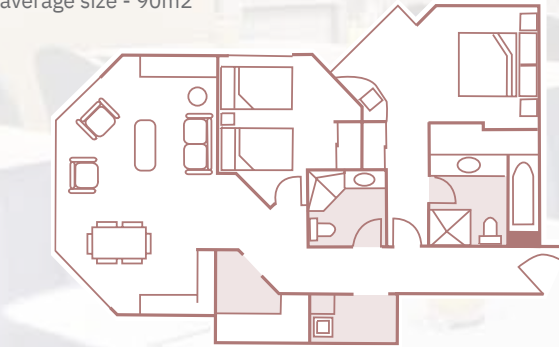

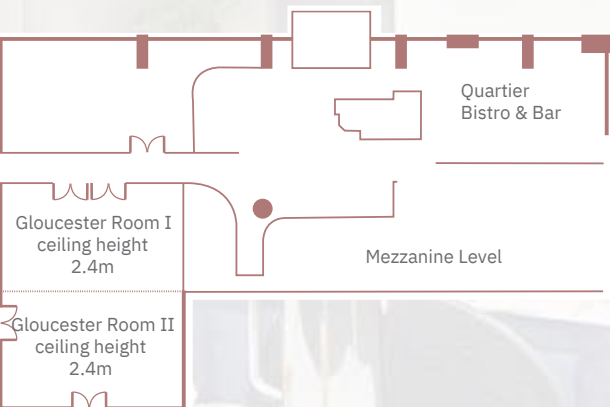
Meetings and events
