Conservation and rescue of biodiversity in Lake Atitlán

On Monday, May 17, Porta Hotels was part of a volunteer service with the Friends of the Lake Association to contribute to the conservation of biodiversity in the Lake Atitlán basin and the protection of flora and fauna species.

A total of 30 bunches of tulle were planted in 60 linear meters on the beach of San Antonio Palopó, one of the towns around the lake

What is tulle and what is it for?

Tulle is a bio-remedial plant that acts as a natural filter against beach pollutants, controls the spread of cyanobacteria, and is a habitat for multiple life forms, crustaceans, mollusks, amphibians, fish, and local and migratory water birds. It is also used by communities to make handicrafts that help the local economy
