#### Flow of Events for the Vow Ceremony

- Gather in the Eight-Fold Paths Area where you will be seated in a Diwan.
- Engage in a 10-15 minutes meditation session guided by our Yoga Guru.
- Move to Navagraha area where the priest will be waiting to begin the puja of enhancing and pacifying the astrological influences.
- Walk with the priest to Fire Pavilion area to begin the vow exchange ceremony.
- Sprinkling of the holy water three times by the priest to cleanse and purify. This symbolizes the soul's connection with the divine essence to seek spiritual blessings.
- Exchange Kush rings made of Vedic sacred Kusha, known as a sign of purity and good luck.
  Believed to make prayers more powerful, Kusha is a divine holy grass used for Vedic rituals for
  purificatory process. For religious purposes, a specific shloka is recited and plucked only the next
  day after full moon on Krishna Paksha. The Kush Rings symbolizes that the union is a sacred bond
  blessed by the celestial forces, paving the way for a life filled with love, protection and spiritual
  harmony.
- Exchange garlands that represent the journey of togetherness and love that binds two hearts as one.
- Adorn your wife with Potey which is a symbol indicating the love and commitment. It symbolizes good luck and being mates for life. *(Optional)*
- Daub your wife's forehead with red/orange hue of Sindoor which is believed to epitomize love, ardor and steadfastness making it an apt emblem for a wedding. This gesture is considered as an act of affection and devotion that the husband manifests towards his wife. (Optional)
- Exchange of seven vows while going around the holy fire. Here, each vow is recited by the couple during each round that represents a rite of passage ceremony to reseal the bond.
- Exchange Supari (Betel Nut) that symbolizes the formal announcement and acceptance of the
  relationship. It is considered to remove the negative feelings present in our lives and a depiction
  of giving away alter ego. The act is also considered a gesture to thank for loyalty and to evoke
  blessings.
- Thumb fingerprint in the vow exchange scroll in the shape of a heart to reinstate the promises.
- Light seven Diyas where each Diya signifies one lifetime and each life time to be filled with goodness and purity, and lighting them denotes dispelling darkness and going into light.
- Share Parsad (food offered to God) with each other as a symbol of accepting blessings.
