CHINESE HUANGJIU

Best served at room temperature

A Chinese alcoholic beverage that is most popular in the Jiangnan area, Huangjiu is brewed by mixing boiled grains including rice, glutinous rice or millet with qu as starter culture, followed by saccharification and fermentation at around 13°C to 18°C. Its alcohol content is typically 16% to 20% with a flavour profile resembling a dry Oloroso sherry.

CHINESE BAIJIU

Best served at room temperature

Baijiu is a clear liquid usually distilled from fermented sorghum, and a colourless liquor typically coming in between 35% and 60% alcohol by volume. Moutai is known for its “jiang xiang” – fermented or pickled food aroma.

JAPANESE SAKE

Can be serve in chilled or at room temperature

Sake is an alcoholic beverage made by fermenting rice that has been polished to remove the bran. The clear to slightly yellowish rice wines have an alcohol content of around 15% and relatively mild flavour profiles, ranging from light and crisp to richer, more substantial, fruity notes.

NATURAL WINES

Natural wine is farmed organically and/or biodynamically and made (or rather transformed) without adding or removing anything in the cellar. No additives or processing aids are used, and 'intervention' in the naturally occurring fermentation process is kept to a minimum. As such neither fining nor (tight) filtration are used. The result is a living wine, wholesome and full of naturally occurring microbiology.

PÉTILLANT NATUREL

Sparkling wine made in the méthode ancestrale, meaning the wine is bottled before primary fermentation is finished, without the addition of secondary yeasts or sugars. The style is fresh and off-dry usually.

White wines made like red wines. Fermented with the grape skins, which gives wine its colour. Depending on how long the juice ferments with the skin – anywhere from a few hours to many months – skin contact wines can range in colour from golden, straw yellow to vibrant amber to deep orange

CHAMPAGNE – HENRI GIRAUD COLLECTION

Champagne Giraud can trace its history as far back as 1625 when François Hémart settled in the village of Aÿ in the heart of Champagne and acquired vines.

They bring the quintessence of Pinot Noir and of the exceptional Aÿ Grand Cru terroir. Its distinctive identity is elevated by the unapologetic use of oak from Champagne's Argonne Forest during the vinification and raising of its Champagnes. It results in Champagne of strong personality, unique saltiness, minerality and energy.
