Skiing

Deer Valley offers a refined skiing experience with impeccably groomed trails, luxurious amenities, and breathtaking alpine scenery tailored for guests who appreciate world-class service. With a skier-only policy and limited daily ticket sales, it ensures uncrowded slopes and an atmosphere of serene exclusivity. Outside of Deer Valley, there are 6 other ski resorts located within a 2-hour drive of The Chateaux.

Sleigh Rides

Take a 30-minute tour of mid-mountain Deer Valley from just outside our doors. Small sleighs can accommodate up to 6 people, and large sleighs accommodating up to 12. Quick rides followed by a dinner are also available at Empire Pass and Park City Mountain Resort.

Snowshoeing

Guided and unguided snowshoe tours are an excellent choice, whether you are looking for a scenic aerobic experience or just a peaceful walk in the woods. Some outfitters even offer transportation to take you directly to your nearby tour.

Bobsled Rides

Feel the rush as you speed down the Olympic track in a 4-person bobsled. A trained pilot will take you and 2 other passengers through 15 curves, reaching speeds up to 80mph, pulling close to 5 G's of force.

Cross-Country Skiing

A 20+ km cross-country ski center in the heart of Park City offers spectacular mountain views along with one of 3 groomed loops. Skiers of all skill levels from beginner to advanced are welcome.

Curling

A fun social winter experience, with local rinks hosting both casual games and league play amid a festive alpine backdrop. Whether you're a seasoned strategist or trying it for the first time, it's an unexpectedly charming way to spend a snowy evening.

Fat Tire Biking

Fat tire biking in winter transforms Park City's snow-covered trails into an exhilarating playground for adventure seekers. With oversized tires designed for traction and stability, riders glide through groomed paths and powder-filled forests, blending adrenaline with scenic serenity.



Ice Skating

Fun for the whole family. There are both indoor and outdoor options. Skate rentals are available, but make sure to dress warm!

Snowboarding

Park City Mountain Resort delivers an exhilarating snowboarding experience with expansive terrain parks, powder-filled bowls, and stunning vistas across the Wasatch Range. From mellow groomers to advanced runs, it's a playground for all levels.

Snow Tubing

Soldier Hollow and Woodward Park City offer snow tubing and fun for the whole family. Day or night, the family can zoom down the hill and ride back up to do it again.

Utah Olympic Park

Built for the Salt Lake 2002 Olympic Winter Games and future host again for 2034, the Olympic Park is a 400-acre venue that houses the bobsled, luge tracks, 6 Nordic ski jumps, a 2002 Winter Games Museum, and a multitude of interactive adventure activities.

Woodward Park City

This world-class, year-round action sports destination is host to all kinds of activities like snow tubing, freestyle terrain parks, indoor skateboarding, trampolines, and more.

Backcountry Ski Adventures

This day kicks off as you use your own power (your legs) to tour up the mountain and go where chairlifts do not. Guides are equipped with intimate knowledge of the area and are trained to provide you with a safe and fun experience. If you are looking to escape the crowds and ski untouched snow...and don't mind working for it, this experience is for you.

Dog Sledding

Experience a once-in-a-lifetime dog sledding adventure. Taking a sled ride through remote terrain is nothing short of exhilarating. The companies we work with have teams of beautiful huskies and other arctic breeds, some of which are rescue dogs, all ready to take you on a sled guided by professional racers from all over the world.



Fly Fishing

If you are fly fishing on Utah's famous Provo River, you can be assured of a great day fishing. Experienced guides provide the equipment and everything you need to catch a trophy in the crisp Utah air.

Helicopter Skiing

Both intermediate and expert skiers can helicopter into deep powder caches in private or small groups. Skiers take about 7 runs averaging about 14,000 vertical feet of unforgettable powder.

Horseback Riding

Horseback riding through beautiful private land is offered year-round from outfitters located about 35-60 minutes from The Chateaux. Viewing the mountains, the wilderness, and even wildlife in its natural habitat will create memories for everyone.

Hot-Air Ballooning

Take in the absolute best views of Park City with a hot air balloon ride high above the town. Your hot air balloon excursion will begin at sunrise when the atmosphere is the most stable and predictable. Your ascent will take you up nearly 1000 feet while you enjoy the snow-capped mountains and frost-covered land below.



Ice Castles
