# SINGLE MALT SCOTCHES

## SPEYSIDE

### **ABERLOUR A'BUNADH**

Meaning 'the original' in Gaelic, A'bunadh has achieved a cult following among malt lovers.

### **THE BALVENIE –DOUBLEWOOD**

This Speysider was initially aged in traditional oak casks before it was finished in casks which previously held Caribbean rum. Sweet vanilla forms a creamy palate with notes of apples and mangoes with a hint of orange in the background.

### **THE BALVENIE – CARIBBEAN CASK 14 YR**

This Speysider was initially aged in traditional oak casks before it was finished in casks which previously held Caribbean rum, imparting some extra sweetness and warmth to the whisky. The fabulous result is a well-rounded whisky with notes of toffee, fruit and vanilla.

### **CARDHU 12 YR**

Pioneered by Helen and Elizabeth Cumming, two of the earliest female distillers, this medium gold dram is known for its sweet aromatics and rich palate of orange, dark chocolate, delicate smoke and toffee.

### **CRAGGANMORE 12 YR**

This Speyside is rich and spicy, with a very satisfying complexity and well-sherried backbone.

### **CRAIGALLACHIE 12 YR**

Oodles of dynamic fruit notes with a distinctive current of smoke running through the middle.

### **DALWHINNIE 15 YR**

Rated 95 points by Jim Murray. An underrated classic with just a hint of smoke. Lots of apple, pear and toffee.

### **GLENFARCLAS 17 YR**

Full-bodied and rich, it fills and coats the palate with warming nutmeg, sherried fruits, cinnamon and mixed peels. A complex and sophisticated dram worthy of a taste!

### **GLENFIDDICH 12 YR**

The world's number one selling single malt. Glenfiddich accounts for 35% of the world's single malt scotch sales. Enough said!

### **GLENFIDDICH IPA**

First they made the beer and then aged it in barrels for a month. They then took the barrels to the distillery and aged the scotch in the same IPA barrels. A noble experiment.

### **GLENNFIDDICH XX**

A collaboration of 20 Malt masters to pick 20 barrels and then marry them together for one stupendous single malt.

### **GLENFIDDICH 18 YR**

An elegant nose, faintly sweet, scented with apple and wood. Glenfiddich 18yo is a robust and full-bodied single malt whisky, yet remains remarkably soft, rounded and long lasting.

### **GLENFIDDICH 21 YR**

#### **WINTER STORM**

Experimental series continues. Finished for up to 6 months in ice wine casks from Peller Estates. Concentrated aromas of canned peaches, vanilla, and clotted cream. Silky on the palate. The finish is medium in length, slowly drying, but fruity to the end.

### **GLENFIDDICH 21 YR**

#### **GRAN RESERVA**

Finished in Caribbean Rum soaked casks to give this well aged whisky notes of vanilla and toffee sweetness. Complex and smoky with a nose of leather and oak.

### **GLENGRANT 12 YR**

Orchard fruits open it up, with orange and apple. A touch of pastry and a dusting of icing sugar. Touches of almonds last on the finish.

### **GLENGRANT 18 YR**

Ripe, tropical bouquet of pineapple stalk, mango, lychee, and elderflower with hints of honey-roasted walnut and lemon peel. Soft, chewy salted caramel and milk chocolate unfurl on the palate with hints of baked plum and coriander.

### **THE GLENLIVET**

Founders Reserve A NAS scotch that garners excellent reviews. "Delicate and complex, this newly released Scotch boasts scents of maple sugar and spice, and unfurls on the palate with a distinctly floral start that evolves into creamy vanilla, honey, sarsaparilla and baking spice."

### **THE GLENLIVET 12 YR**

The world's second most consumed single malt. Grassy and light with floral notes.

### **THE GLENLIVET 15 YR**

This lovely 15-year-old whisky is matured in French Limousin oak casks. The Limousin oak has a more open grain which lets the whisky get into the oak. Creamy rich and buttery on the nose with sweet fruits and delicate spice on the palate.

### **THE GLENLIVET 18 YR**

Expect lots of honey and caramel from the get-go, winding into an interestingly dry and lingering finish entwining leather, cocoa, coconut and ginger.

### **THE GLENLIVET ARCHIVE 21 YR**

The nose is full and rich with notes of sandalwood and pine with a long sweet finish. Highly regarded by the world's whisky lovers.

### **MACALLAN 12 YR SHERRY OAK**

Crisp and sweet with notes of sultanas and fresh apple blossom. One of the best out there in its age group.

### **MACALLAN 15 YR**

Sublime and full, with a hint of rose and cinnamon. The taste is intense with rich chocolate with a hint of orange and raisin. The

finish is lingering with a hint of chocolate, orange and dried fruits.

### **MACALLAN 18 YR**

With maturation taking place in a combination of European Sherry seasoned casks, American Sherry seasoned casks and American ex-bourbon casks, this expression boasts bountiful notes of vanilla, dried fruit and wood spice.

### **MACALLAN HARMONY**

Macallan has collaborated with renowned pastry chef Jordi Roca (from El Celler de Can Roca, which has three Michelin stars, we'll have you know) on a smashing single malt with a decidedly chocolatey flavour profile. Macallan whisky maker Polly Logan worked with Roca as well as Casa Cacao chocolatier Damien Allsop on this expression, which is made with whiskies aged in sherry-seasoned European oak casks and sherry-seasoned American oak casks. As you might expect, this brilliant single malt pairs wonderfully with chocolate.

### **MACALLAN – RARE CASK**

Ruby red in colour. On the nose, soft notes of opulent vanilla and raisin give way to a sweet ensemble of apple, lemon, and orange. All balanced by a spicy quartet of root ginger, cinnamon, nutmeg and clove. On the palate, this spicy quartet is unwavering. Oak resonates, timeless, polished and rich. Vanilla and chocolate lead the finale along with a light citrus zest. The finish is warming and woody.

### **THE SINGLETON 12 YR**

The Singleton of Dufftown is a satisfyingly refined, beautifully balanced single malt that is naturally rich and smooth. It offers sweetness, crunchy nuts and smooth fruity richness.

# HIGHLANDS

## **ABERFELDY 16 YR**

This expression is finished in Oloroso Sherry casks. Raisins and cinnamon on the nose give way to butterscotch and caramel.

## **ANCOC 12 YR**

Whisky Distiller of the year 2017. A delicate scotch with flavours of barley, spices and butterscotch-vanilla.

## **BALBLAIR 17 YR**

An electric start on the nose with a vivid aroma profile of sour cherries, dried apricots, nuts and sherry. Very complex and entertaining with a layered texture. The finish is never ending. An outstanding example amongst other great whiskies.

## **DALMORE 12 YR**

Aged in Bourbon Barrels then half is transferred to Sherry barrels to finish. The two halves are blended back together for a fruit forward; sweet and rich whisky.

## **DALMORE 15 YR**

Matured in Matusalem, Apostoles and Amoroso Sherry casks, it proffers all those winter spice, orange and chocolate notes characteristic of Dalmore Aroma: Orange marmalade, cinnamon and nutmeg.

## **DALMORE 18 YR**

Matured in American oak and oloroso sherry casks. Fragrant with honey, vanilla, ginger, orange marmalade, and a hint of smoke. Relatively full-bodied, with flavors of tangy orange, marzipan, sherry, bitter chocolate, then oak. Licorice and citrus fruit finish.

## **DEVERON 12 YR**

A core of butterscotch with waxy malt and apple pie. A sweet and delicious dram. Finishes with wood spice, vanilla and soft oakiness.

## **DALMORE – KING ALEXANDER III**

A sextuple-wood bottling from Dalmore. This auspiciously-named dram was matured in wine, Madeira, Sherry, Marsala, Kentucky bourbon and Port casks. Medium, well-rounded. Winter berries, spice, zesty orange. Liqueur finish.

## **GLENMORANGIE SIGNET**

While it carries no-age-statement, there is said to be an element of some of the distillery's oldest and rarest stocks, ranging from 35 to 40 years, in this Highland single malt. Sweet, syrupy cinnamon and dry malt lead, followed by chocolate orange and a hint of lime.

## **GLENMORANGIE**

### **10-YEAR-OLD - ORIGINAL**

The backbone of the Glenmorangie whiskys. Fruity and thick with a long malty finish.

### **GLENMORANGIE 14 YR QUINTA RUBAN**

A symphony of understated opulence. Marzipan, fresh apple and pear, milk chocolate, red berries, candied ginger, and praline on the nose build slowly, leading into a fruity, spiced palate. It sings on the finish, with a parting crescendo of hazelnut, spice, cigar wrapper, and lengthy oak.

## **OBAN 14 YR**

The distillery was built in 1794 offering the best of the highlands and combines it with the peaty flavours of the islands.

## **OBAN 21 YR**

Limited release. Distilled in 1996 and bottled in 2018. Cask strength at 57.9% ABV. Intense smooth sweetness of orange on the nose that carries through on the palate. It changes in the glass and you get all kinds of flavours coming through.

## **OLD PULTENEY CASK**

### **STRENGTH 2007**

The Maritime Malt, Old Pulteney is distilled in the port of Wick, Caithness. This expression was laid down in 2007 and matured for more than a decade in a single cask. No. 254 of 372 bottles.

# ISLAY

## **ARDBEG ARDCORE**

Ardbeg goes Ardcore! This limited edition expression from the distillery on Islay was made with roasted black malt, giving it an intense flavour profile, which is described as being “like biting a spiky ball” on the label. Not a tasting note we’ve ever seen before.

## **ARDBEG 10 YR**

This is a big powerful whisky filled with smoke! Citrus and pear notes squeeze their way though but the smoke lingers for hours.

## **ARDBEG’S THE WEE BEASTIE**

The youthful age statement may take many scotch drinkers by surprise, but don’t let double-digit bias prevent you from enjoying this exciting yet easy-drinking peat bomb. Salt water and seaweed, smoke and sweet peat tussle on the nose, while vanilla, fresh berries, and ample nuttiness spread out and take hold.

## **BOWMORE 12 YR**

The peaty smokiness of this Islay favourite is balanced with lemon and honey.

## **BOWMORE 18 YR**

Incredibly complex with beautiful soft fruit and chocolate balanced with a light smokiness. Bowmore refers to it as “Cosseted away in the finest hand-selected, oak casks and allowed to mature in its own sedate pace this is one of the most remarkable, perfectly balanced single malt scotch whiskies of its kind.”

## **BRUICHLADDICH PORT CHARLOTTE HEAVILY PEATED**

Somewhat like eating a chorizo and roasted red pepper sandwich on the beach on a summer’s day, but it retains the sweet freshness of the distillery character. With water, the lovely smell of cow’s breath. There’s dry smoke to start with on the palate, becoming sweet (flash-fried scallop) with sugared almond on the finish.

## **BRUICHLADDICH LADDIE**

Delicate aromas of honey and dried fruit combine with flavours of caramel and apricots with a light smokiness.

## **BUNNAHABHAIN**

The taste starts with a light fruit and nut appeal that leads to a malty sweetness, finishing into a beautifully rich full-bodied experience.

## **CAOL ILA 15 YR UNPEATED**

This is the first of these unusual Islay malts to have been distilled this millennium, being filled into refill American oak hogsheads and refill European oak butts back in 2000. Warming and a little more toffee’d now with hedgerow greenery and fruit.

## **LAGAVULIN 12 YR**

This expression has enjoyed a dozen years of maturation in refill American oak casks before being bottled up at 56.5% ABV. The theme for the Special Releases this time was ‘Legends Untold’, and as such, this one features a lion on the label. But not just any lion, it’s a lion with a flaming mane!

## **LAGAVULIN 12 YR – SINGLE CASK 200<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY**

This year’s 12 year old Lagavulin Special Release is part of the distillery’s 200th anniversary celebrations! Aged in refill American oak hogsheads. Caramel notes star on the palate, similar in this respect to the 2015 release, but with the smoke is sweeter and less sooty. Instead, there’s more evocative seaweed-covered harbour wall notes.

## **LAGAVULIN 16 YR**

Intense and smoky-sweet. Seaweed flavours with a big smoky finish. Double gold medal at the World Spirit awards 2017.

## **LAPHROAIG QUARTER CASK**

Released in 2004, this bottling was aged for around 5 years before being finished in a quarter cask for several months. The size of the cask is quite small, thus does not require such a long maturation. An explosion of sweetness, with fiery chilli heat, TCP, sweet cereals and a touch of cola syrup.

## **LAPHROAIG 10 YR**

Very peaty with hints of honey and black pepper. A touch of water adds to the nuances of this whisky.

## SCARABUS

A whisky for those with a curious mind and eye for detail. Bold and honest about its origins and just a little mysterious about everything else. From Arnahoe, the first distillery to be built on Islay since 2005. On the nose: really pleasant,

## LOWLANDS

### AUCHENTOSHAN 12-YEAR-OLD

An aroma of caramelized almonds and vanilla make this the cr me brulee of scotch.

### AUCHENTOSHAN THREE WOOD

A Lowland single malt matured in three different casks, namely; Pedro Ximenez Sherry casks, bourbon casks and Olorosso Sherry casks. Rich. Liqueur cherries in dark chocolate, more sherried fruit, ripe dark forest fruits, like Black Forest Gateaux.

### GLENKINCHIE 12-YEAR-OLD

Based close to Edinburgh. It has come to be known as the Edinburgh malt. You will pick up notes of lemon grass then a spicier lively finish.

## THE ISLANDS

### TALISKER 10 YR (ISLE OF SKYE)

A fresh and fragrant nose. Through thick, pungent smoke comes sweet pear and apple peels, with pinches of maritime salt from kippers, seaweed.

### ISLE OF JURA 12 YR

Matured in a combination of American Oak and Olorosso Sherry casks. Flavours of chocolate fudge, nutty barley and pear come through.

### HIGHLAND PARK 10 YR

A subtle Sherry influence but balanced with a heathery smoke and a taste of sea spray.

### HIGHLAND PARK 12 YR (ORKNEYS)

Salted lemons and honey with a taste of crunchy green apples followed by a smoky finish with a silky mouth feel.

### LINDORES ABBEY

Lindores Abbey is the officially recognised site of the first recorded distillation of Scotch whisky, all the way back in 1494, when King James IV commissioned Brother John Cor to make aqua vitae with eight bolls of malt. It was aged in ex-bourbon, ex-sherry, and STR ex-Burgundy red wine casks, and offers up an impressive light yet rich flavour profile.

### HIGHLAND PARK 18 YR (ORKNEYS)

Ripe fruit and floral notes followed by soft smoke. Complex and delicious. A constant favourite amongst whisky lovers.

### JURA JOURNEY

It was aged exclusively in American white oak ex-bourbon barrels and bottled at 40% ABV. A tasty introduction to Jura's single malts.

### LEDAIG 10 YR (ISLE OF MULL)

Quite light and well-balanced. Medium-bodied and quite rich. There are notes of spice and smoke gathering above the charred oak. The peat is quiet and dry with a touch of black pepper and earth.

### ROBERT BURNS

A single malt from the Isle of Arran distillery, celebrating the famed Scottish poet, Robert Burns. Fruity and rich, vanilla, pannacotta, apple and lime peel on the palate



# INTERNATIONAL SINGLE MALTS

## **AMRUT FUSION (INDIA)**

A blend of Indian and Scottish elements. Combines fruit, oak and vanilla with a touch of peat.

## **BRENNE (FRANCE)**

This is very good, with honey, date, liquid chocolate, honeycomb, and some spice bite. But it's also very unusual, Brenne is released in single casks, so they vary dramatically. It's made by a French cognac maker. Aged in Cognac Barrels. Different but good.

## **LAIRD OF FINTRY (CANADA)**

A small batch Canadian single malt. With forest notes of toasted oak and tones of vanilla, plum and raisins.

## **LAIRD OF FINTRY RUM CASK**

The original Laird of Fintry finished in a rum cask which adds a lovely sweetness.

## **PAUL JOHN (INDIA)**

Honey, spice and a bourbon liquorice aroma leads to a spiced, oak tinged honey flavour with peaty soot and copper. The smoked mocha brings on the finish of a bold whisky.

## **PUNI SOLE (ITALY)**

The taste is distinctively sweet with strong notes of honey and blood orange that are counterpointed by creamy flavours of walnut and spicy oak.

## **PENDERYN SHERRYWOOD (WALES)**

This Welsh whisky has been aged in ex-bourbon barrels and ex-Oloroso sherry casks to bring out its rich fruity flavour. It starts with aromas of dark fruit and rich toffee mingled with green apples and hazelnuts to create a deeper mystery. Followed by rich sweetness that gives way to refreshing dryness with sweet notes of toffee and sultana persist in the long finish.

# IRISH WHISKY

## BUSHMILLS

The whisky from the North. Widely considered the oldest distillery in the world being granted a charter to produce whisky in 1608 by King James I.

## GLENDALOUGH

A tiny craft distillery from the Wicklow mountains has a Kelowna connection. One of our own is a stakeholder in the distillery! Our own taste of Ireland.

## JAMESON BLACK BARREL

A special pot still whisky-heavy version of Jameson. Black Barrel has lots of first-fill bourbon and sherry casks in the mix, giving it a much richer flavour than regular Jameson, with a strong sherried note.

## JAMESON CRESTED

With a high proportion of pot still and Sherry-matured whiskeys, this is a top Irish blend, a real gem.

## JAMESON IPA

The second release in Jameson Caskmates range, finished in casks that once held zesty IPA.

The combination adds further layers of hop fruitiness to the whiskies already fruity character as well as a touch of citrus, floral notes and some balancing bitterness.

## JAMESON

A blend of pot still and grain whisky. Then triple distilled to give the whisky its signature smoothness. Then aged in oak casks for four years. The largest selling Irish whisky in the world producing 31 million bottles annually!

## PROPER TWELVE

Founded by CEO Connor McGregor, the name from the district of Dublin he grew up in. It's a blend of triple distilled single malt, Irish grain spirit, and matured in bourbon barrels. Aroma of charred oak, vanilla, honey with flavours of chocolate and green apple, with a soft finish.

## REDBREAST 12 YR

This is a pot still whisky (single malt) which is triple distilled from malted and unmalted barley. Matured in Bourbon and then Oloroso Sherry casks. Spicy and fruity.

## REDBREAST 15 YEAR OLD

A sumptuous single pot still whisky with a great degree of aging, Redbreast 15 is richer, earthier and stronger than its 12-year-old sibling. An essential part of any whisky-drinker's education.

## RED SPOT

The relaunched Red Spot is a 15 year old single pot still Irish whiskey, comprised of three different whiskeys aged separately then blended. One is matured in Oloroso sherry casks, one is aged in bourbon casks, and the final one is initially aged in bourbon casks before being finished in Marsala wine casks.

## ROE & CO.

Bottled at 45% abv without chill filtration. A blend of single malt and grain whiskeys matured exclusively in bourbon.

## TEELING SMALL BATCH

Started in hand-picked oak casks and finished in rum barrels this is a very smooth Irish. This has been a family run distillery since 1782.

## TULLAMORE DEW

Second only to Jameson in world-wide sales. The DEW on the label is the initials of Tullamore's former owner Daniel E. Williams who worked himself up from stable boy to the owner.

## TYRCONNELL 16 YEAR OLD

A super single malt, double distilled at the Cooley Distillery using its unusually shaped copper pot stills (small in size and long in neck) giving the whisky and copper lots of contact that resulted in a refined and layered spirit. This Tyrconnell was then bottled at 46% ABV, after it was aged for 16 years in ex-American oak bourbon barrels in a 200 year-old granite warehouse.



### **WRITERS TEARS**

Only begun in 1999 this whisky has entered the market as a super-premium, triple distilled craft Irish Whisky.

### **YELLOW SPOT**

The Yellow Spot is a single pot still Irish whiskey which has been matured in three types of cask: American bourbon cask, Spanish Sherry butts and Spanish Malaga casks for a sweeter flavour. Aged 12 years.

## **BLENDS**

### **ALFRED GIRAUD HARMONIE**

Alfred Giraud has blended together three French malts for the Heritage expression. The spirit is then aged in three different cask types, with new French Limousin oak, American oak and casks which previously held XO Cognac.

### **BALLANTINES**

First released in 1910. This whisky is a blend of 40 single malt and grain whiskies. Floral, citrus and vanilla come through.

### **BALLANTINES 17 YR**

Full bodied with creamy vanilla. One of the best Scottish blends.

### **CHIVAS REGAL 12 YR**

Layered flavours of brown butter and oatmeal give way to a slightly smoky finish.

### **THE FAMOUS GROUSE**

Contains The Macallan and Highland Park scotches. Light and easy drinking.

### **THE GAULDRONS**

“The Bay of Storms”. This is a small batch blend of Campbelltown single malts. Salt and sweet cereal and gentle smoke make a wonderful combination of flavours.

### **JOHNNY WALKER BLUE LABEL**

Legendary! An exquisite blend made from Scotland’s rarest and most exceptional whiskies. Only one in every ten thousand casks has the elusive quality, character and flavour to deliver the remarkable signature taste.

### **JOHNNY WALKER**

#### **BLACK LABEL 12 YR**

The iconic Johnny Black has an unmistakably smooth, deep, complex character. An impressive whisky to share on any occasion, whether you’re entertaining at home with friends or on a memorable night out. Best Blended Scotch 5-12 Years, Jim Murray’s Whisky Bible 2017.

### **MONKEY SHOULDER**

This unique blend of three Speyside Single Malts is aged in ex-bourbon casks which impart a smooth and mellow vanilla flavour into the whisky with hints of zesty orange, honey and spiced oak.

### **NIKKA – FROM THE BARREL**

2018 Whisky of the year! Soft, sweet butterscotch and orange peel meet poached pears and stone fruits. Earthiness appears as dried autumn leaves, coffee, old oak, and tobacco.

### **NIKKA COFFEE MALT**

Using the two Coffey stills at the Miyagikyo distillery, which were imported from Scotland to Japan in 1963, Nikka have produced a number of single cask single grain whiskies from time to time over the years. This, however, is their larger release of wonderfully exotic single grain whisky.

### **SUNTORY HIBIKI**

This lovely Japanese blend has a nose of lychee fruit, a hint rosemary and sandalwood. Sweet candied orange peel round out the palate.

### **SUNTORY TOKI**

A blended whisky from Suntory’s three distilleries: Yamazaki, Hakushu and Chita. Toki has a different composition to another Suntory blend, Hibiki, as its main components are Hakushu single malt and Chita grain whisky.

# CANADIAN WHISKY

## BEARFACE

A relative new comer to the Canadian Whisky world. Bearface is aged 7 years in Bourbon barrels and then put into Red Wine barrels and finally finished in new Hungarian oak barrels.

## CENTURY RESERVE 30 YR

A wonderful 30 year old Canadian whisky. Made from 100% corn. This single cask Canadian whisky, barreled in 1988, is a terrific find! Incredibly smooth yet complex. No longer available in stores.

## CROWN ROYAL

A blend of 50 Canadian whiskies. This whisky was placed on the train to commemorate the visit of King George VI in 1939 wrapped in its iconic purple bag. Crown is rich and robust with hints of vanilla and oak.

## CROWN ROYAL

### NORTHERN HARVEST RYE

This whisky made headlines in 2016 when it won World Whisky of the Year in Jim Murrays Whisky Bible! A touch spicier with a higher rye content but still Crown Royal smooth.

## FORTY CREEK DOUBLE BARREL

Corn, barley and rye whiskies are individually aged and then blended. Then they put the blend into once used bourbon barrels for another two years. A fine sipping whisky.

## FORTY CREEK BARREL SELECT

Aged in old bourbon barrels and new American white oak. Features aromas of vanilla, apricot, honey, toasted oak, black walnut and spice.

## GOODERHAM & WORTS

A blend of corn, rye, wheat and barley and bottled at 44.4% ABV this pours a golden/amber colour. The four grains all add their unique flavours to give this whisky wonderful notes of honey, toffee and stone fruit.

## GIBSON'S 12 YR

## J.P. WISERS DELUXE

Wiser's signature blend. Caramel, dried fruit, toasted grains, vanilla and toffee all show on the palate. A Canadian iconic whisky since 1857.

## LOT 40 RYE

Expertly distilled in small batches using only the finest locally sourced ingredients. By distilling in a single copper pot still, the result is a whisky that starts off earthy and woody tasting and then becomes full bodied and complex with a velvety vanilla oak finish.

## PIKE CREEK

Stored in non-climate controlled warehouse Pike Creek barrels expand in the summer and contract in the winter driving the whisky into the wood giving the liquid a rich amber colour. Peppery notes and toffee on the nose give way to dried fruits on the palate.

## WISER'S 15 YR

Deliciously smooth. This needs to be sipped and savoured to get a true appreciation of the full depth of its flavour.

## WISER'S 18 YR

Multiple award winning Canadian whisky with an exceptionally smooth finish. Autumn florals, green apple, fresh pine, caramel and oak. Old enough to vote!

## WAYNE GRETZKY

### NO.99 RED CASK

Made from age old distilling practices and then finished in Gretzky Red Wine barrels. Honouring tradition with a touch of innovation.

# CANADIAN CRAFT WHISKY

## **ALBERTA PREMIUM CASK STRENGTH**

Warm, peppery rye spice is enveloped in maple and honey, supported by aromatic spicing of nutmeg and clove. With water, a wonderfully complex and balanced spirit emerges, undulating between cotton candy sweetness, black pepper spice, walnut praline, and new leather umami. Jim Murray's Whisky of the Year 2020.

## **FORTY CREEK "VICTORY"**

Corn and rye whiskies blended with a tad of Villard Noir Starboard wine commemorate Canada's victory in a battle fought in the War of 1812 where Forty Creek now distills whisky. Toasted oak staves were inserted into half of the fully matured whisky for 2 months. A strong maple nose dissolves into hints of fruitiness, while a sweet palate balances and restrains drying tannins. Fruity, creamy, and mouth-filling with peppery spices.

## **INDIGENOUS SINGLE MALT**

A local offering from West Kelowna! A distillers Blend by Colin Wertz. Aged in Port and Cognac barrels giving it a sweet aroma of Sultanas and strawberries, baking spice, black pepper, vanilla and a whisp of smoke.

## **ODD SOCIETY - PROSPECTOR**

Prospector is 100% Northern BC rye, transformed into liquid, steam, and back again. It is then coaxed into new, heavily charred American White Oak barrels. With a heady nose of brown sugar, dried prune, vanilla and oak, this full-bodied rye melts on the tongue into light spice and stone fruit notes, leaving with a crisp, dry finish like crackling leaves.

## **ODD SOCIETY - COMMODORE**

Commodore honours tradition—beckoning back to a Scottish heritage—while proudly thriving in its West Coast berth. This refined spirit is distilled with 100% BC grown, malted barley. To that, it owes its distinctive peppery-sweetness, along with its dark fruit and tobacco notes. Gold Medal Winner.

## **OKANAGAN SPIRITS RYE**

With a blend of 51% of our Coldstream Valley Rye, and 49% of our locally malted BC Barley, this three year-old hand-crafted Rye is aged in our custom American white oak barrels and then cut with our secret source of local artesian well water.

## **OKANAGAN SPIRITS LAIRD OF FINTRY**

Distilled in a copper pot still and using only malted barley, yeast and water the folks up in Vernon have crafted a fine single malt. Highly coveted and sold by lottery do not miss the chance to taste this fine whisky.

## **LAIRD OF FINTRY RUM CASK**

Our local distillers have also recently produced a rum cask expression of the Laird of Fintry that we also carry with pride.

## **SHELTER POINT THE COLLECTIVE**

This unique whisky was a collective of 5 employees who each picked out their favourite cask and then blended them together to make this whisky! This whisky has distinct notes of vanilla and cinnamon and bursts of fruity flavour. Gold Medal Winner.

## **SPIRIT OF THE EL**

A collaboration with Okanagan Spirits that went exceptionally well. We took their BRBN and added Quail's Gate Old Vines Foch Port to a cask. Then we aged it in an oak cask for 6 months. The port smooths out the whisky on your palate. We are so proud of we call it The Spirit of the El!

# AMERICAN & BOURBON

## 1792 (BOTTLED IN BOND)

This straight Kentucky bourbon whisky is “from barrels all filled during the same season was bottled at exactly 100 proof.” The color of a rich wildflower honey. Warm and full, and more mouth-forward. The aromas are brought through in the flavour, with a layered maple and coffee-toffee sweetness and oak grounded by an earthy quality. The finish lingers, with a smooth yet spicy and savory buzz.

## ANGEL'S ENVY

Named for the “angel’s share,” the portion that evaporates from the barrel during the aging process, this golden amber spirit is finished in Port barrels, which explains those juicy red-fruit notes that slide into the long finish.

## BASIL HAYDEN'S BOURBON

Lively nose, good rye snap and spice, a bit of mint and oaky edge. Sweet, spicy, and easy to like, this is whisky without flaw, well-done and tasty, if not overly ambitious or challenging.

## BASIL HAYDEN'S DARK RYE

With aromas of spice, tea and a hint of peppermint, Basil Hayden’s has a very pleasant light-bodied and gentle bite with a clean dry finish. A high amount of Rye grain in the mash bill lends a nice spiciness.

## BLACKENED

Using our proprietary BLACK NOISE™ finishing process, each batch of whisky is blasted with its very own Metallica playlist, curated by the band themselves. The low-frequency sound waves force the whisky to penetrate deeper into the barrel, extracting more caramel, honey and vanilla flavors from the wood.

## BLANTON'S SINGLE BARREL

The Kentucky Derby bourbon. The first single barrel bourbon sold commercially. A deep, satisfying nose of nutmeg and spices. Powerful dry vanilla notes in harmony with hints of honey amid strong caramel and corn.

## BOOKERS

This bourbon is not for the weak. A very complex and intense nose that runs from oak,

leather, caramel and hints of fruits continues on the tongue with a very pleasant burn that gives way to more leather, oak vanilla and spice. It’s a bourbon with a bite and should be bloomed with some water.

## BUFFALO TRACE

This deep amber whisky has a complex aroma of vanilla, mint and molasses. Pleasantly sweet to the taste with notes of brown sugar and spice that give way to oak, toffee, dark fruit and anise.

## EAGLE RARE

Aged for no less than 10 years. The nose is complex, with aromas of toffee, hints of orange peel, herbs, honey, leather and oak. Tastes of candied almonds and rich cocoa finish dry and lingering.

## FOUR ROSES

Crisp yet soft and smooth. Fresh fruit, hints of pear and apple with a mellow, long and pleasant finish. Multiple Gold medal award winner.

## HEAVEN'S DOOR

Heaven’s Door is a whisky brand developed in collaboration with Bob Dylan. The bottles feature the iron gates created by Dylan in his studio. Elegantly perfumed with notes of toasted wheat, cereal, tree dust and marzipan. The palate is elevated and airy almost weightless.

## JACK DANIELS HONEY

A blend of Jack Daniels whisky and a unique honey liqueur of their own making. With hints of honey and a finish that is naturally smooth.

## JACK DANIELS

Mellowed through 10 feet of sugar maple charcoal. It is only ready when their tasters say it is. Look, aroma and taste are all factors.

## JIM BEAM

Aged four years in new American Oak barrels. A long family tradition has created one of the world’s most popular bourbons. Sweet corn, caramel smoothness has a loyal following all around the world.

## LEGENT

This is a very unique bourbon as it is a collaboration of two famous whisky makers. Fred Noe, Jim Beam's Master distiller and Shinji Fukuyo, Suntory's chief blender. The bourbon is aged for 5 years then finished in California wine casks and a second finish in Sherry casks.

## LONGBRANCH

A bourbon with Texan connections The liquid goes through two filtrations. One of American white oak and another through Texas Mesquite wood. A collaboration with Mathew McConaughey and Wild Turkey Master Distiller Edie Russell.

## KNOB CREEK

Rich, sweet, woody, full bodied, almost fruity. An unflinching balance of deep, old-style flavor with natural oak sweetness.

## MAKERS MARK

Red winter wheat is used to add to the corn to give this bourbon a very smooth taste. Woody oak, caramel, vanilla and wheat prevail on the nose with a balance of caramel, vanilla and fruity essences. The finish is smooth and subtle.

## MAKERS MARK

### MOCHA REVIVAL

This is a unique series by Makers Mark. There are 10 finishing staves added to the barrel to impart different flavours. This one has 1 American pure; 3 Makers Mark 46; 4 Roasted French Mocha and 2 Toasted French Spice. Giving this cask strength (55.5 % abv) its unique flavour characteristics.

## MICHTERS SOUR MASH

Whisky Exchange Whisky of the year for 2019. First whisky made in the United States to achieve this honour. Its unique grain selection means it cannot be categorized as a rye or a bourbon. Its name comes from using some of the fermented mash from the previous batch as a starter for the new mash to be fermented.

## OLD FORESTER

A soft and sweet aroma with a taste that softens quickly with hints of sweet corn and oak. Spicy with soft vanilla and light orange notes. Created in 1870 it is the only whisky to maintain production before, during and after prohibition.

## OLD FORESTER 1920

The perfect proof. Rich in color, aroma, and flavor. It begins with powerful caramel, baking spice, chocolate, cherries, cinnamon, and toffee. Then nuance and complexity. Honey, jalapeño, rosemary, crème brûlée, malt, and fruit, from the spicy citrus of grapefruit to prunes and dried apricots.

## OLD GRANDAD

In this glass is a liquid that shines a medium copper colour, with pleasantly sweet and spicy aromatics. On the palate it is smooth and gently warm, with flavour notes of caramel, butterscotch, toasted pecan, dried apricot, nutmeg, grated ginger and cinnamon. The finish is clean and soft, with lingering candied flavours.

## RABBIT HOLE

Rich, honeyed aromas of grilled corn cakes, walnut bread and a hint of mint. On the palate, full-bodied, moderately sweet and appealingly spicy, massively and dangerously quaffable.

## RITTENHOUSE RYE

Rittenhouse Straight Rye Whisky has a storied past with a heritage that commemorates Philadelphia's famous Rittenhouse Square. Bottled-in-Bond, today's Rittenhouse carries the distinct, spicy flavor that is long associated with the brand.

## SAZERAC RYE

Versatile, crisp, and an ideal match for cocktails that also include orange liqueur as well as its namesake classic cocktail. Light aromas include vanilla and a touch of juicy citrus. Flavours run to bitter chocolate, and black tea, finishing with a peppery tingle. Velvety fee, despite the brisk alcohol.

## VIRGINIA BLACK

A collaboration between Brent Hocking (Deleon Tequila) and Drake. Yes, that Drake. A blend of 2, 3, and 4-year-old bourbons. Smooth and silky with notes of caramel and some spiciness from rye grains.

## WELLER

The original wheated bourbon whisky features an exceptionally smooth taste by substituting wheat for rye grain. This bourbon stands out with its burnt orange colour and softer flavor notes by avoiding the spiciness of the rye grain.

## **WILD TURKEY**

This Kentucky Bourbon is aged up to six to eight years in “alligator charred” barrels, yielding honey-vanilla aromatics and mouthwatering, rounded maple and vanilla notes that close out with clove and cinnamon spark.

## **WOODFORD RESERVE**

A clean brilliant honey amber colour. Rich, chewy, rounded and smooth, with complex fruits, cinnamon and cocoa. Toffee, caramel, chocolate and spice notes abound. Multiple gold medal winner. The distillery dates from 1812 and is a National Historic Site.

## **WOODFORD RESERVE**

### **DOUBLE OAKED**

Uniquely matured in separate, charred oak barrels – the second barrel deeply toasted before a light charring – extracts additional amounts of soft, sweet oak character.

## **WOODFORD RESERVE MASTER**

Collection is the take on crafting a spirit that exhibits the flavours of a classic beer style, in this case a rich, roasted malty stout. The result is the Fall 2021 Master’s Collection release named Five Malt Stouted Mash, a rich and robust expression of Woodford Reserve Kentucky Straight Malt Whiskey.

## **WOODFORD WHEAT WHISKY**

If you like your whiskies to be wonderfully creamy with a good helping of fruity sweetness to them, you’ve come to the right place. This expression is made with a mash bill of 52% wheat, 20% malt, 20% corn and 8% rye, leading to a satisfying flavour profile that should do well sipped neat or in cocktails.
