In a historic performance, the Knights secured their first-ever title with a commanding 110-run victory over the South Castries Lions in the finals held at the Gros Islet Mini Stadium.

The final match was a showcase of true cricketing excellence. The Knights delivered a powerful batting per-

formance, putting up a massive 247 for 5 in their 20 overs. Jard Goodman led the charge with an explosive 95 off just 44 balls, while Kimani Melius, who was later named Player of the Tournament, added a lightning-fast 63 off 24. Their aggressive partnership set the tone for a dominant night, and the Knights' bowlers followed through with precision and pressure, bowling out the Lions for 137 in just 17.2 overs.

This championship is the result of hard work, strategic planning, and a strong sense of commu-



nity values that Bay Gardens proudly supports. The season was filled with standout performances, including Tyrel Chicot's historic hat-trick during the group stage and his tournament-best 21 wickets, which earned him the title of Bowler of the Tournament. Kimani Melius also emerged as the top batsman with a remarkable 518 runs across the tournament.

Beyond the individual accolades, what stood out most was the spirit and determination of the entire Gros Islet team. The energy they brought to every match and their commitment to excellence resonated deeply with fans across the island.

### A Year of Change: Bay Gardens Resorts Empower At-Risk Youth from the Babonneau Secondary School

In May 2024, a quiet initiative began that would go on to transform the lives of several at-risk boys at the Babonneau Secondary School. It all started when the teacher, Mrs. Adams reached out to Bay Gardens Resorts, asking for help to inspire students in an after-school program aimed at guiding those on the verge of going off track.

Bay Gardens responded with thoughtful intention, enlisting grassroots leader Shabazz Mitchell, whose powerful journey from street life to community leadership made him the perfect mentor. Together, they launched a series of impactful interventions starting with honest talks about manhood, discipline, and building a better future.

The program quickly evolved to include hands-on experiences tailored to the boys' interests. Music lovers joined studio sessions through Airborne Academy with support from Ezra D'Funmachine and Corey Raggie, while young athletes received donated football boots from Education Minister Hon. Kenson Casimir. Five boys also gained valuable work experience at Bay Gardens Resorts during the Easter holidays, where exposure to a professional environment helped boost their confidence and outlook.

The results have been remarkable. Teachers and parents reported improved behaviour, with some boys earning leadership roles and awards. Over the past year, the group has also enjoyed enriching field trips to farms, stables, and automotive events.

Annual CHTA Marketplace in Antigua



### **INGREDIENTS:**

- \* 1.5 ounces white rum
- \* 2 ounces pineapple juice
- \* 1 ounce passion fruit juice
