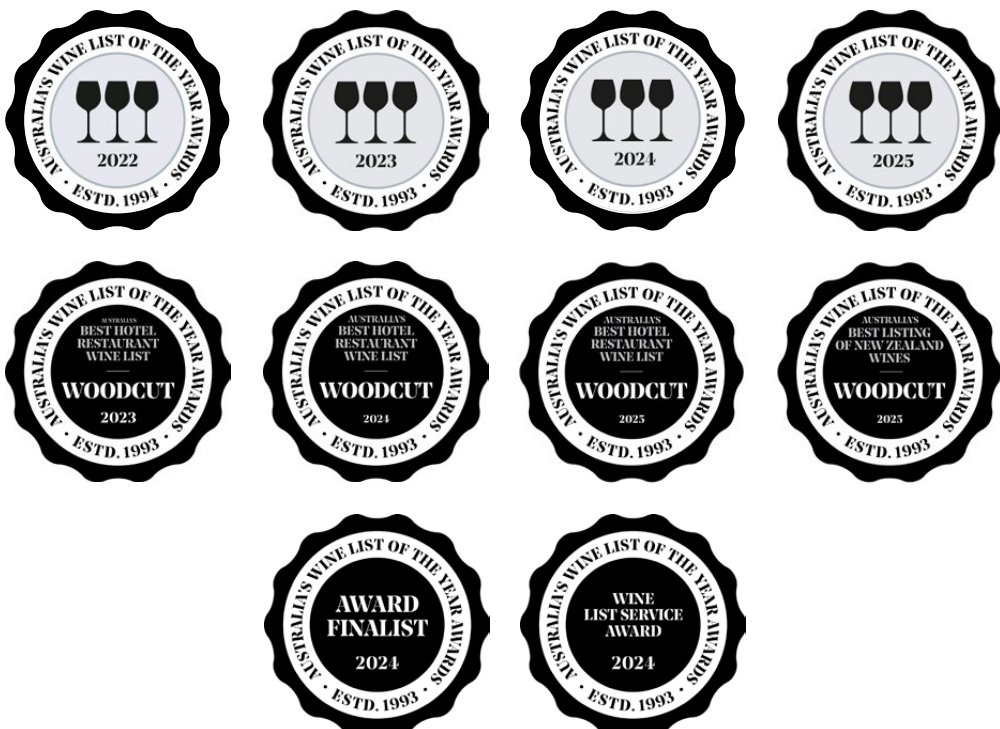

KOLONNE NULL

From Berlin to the world, Kolonne Null are creating premium non-alcoholic wines, made with passion and innovation. Grapes are carefully selected from diverse regions, then pressed using traditional methods and placed through a de-alcoholisation process. Research in their laboratory includes analysis, sensory testing and blending techniques. Wines are co-produced with award-winning international wineries and only the finest compositions become part of the collection, resulting in an exquisite alcohol-free indulgence.

Kolonne Null's unique de-alcoholisation method involves gentle 'vacuum distillation' at a temperature of 30°C, removing the alcohol down to a maximum of 0.3%. This is followed by 'aroma recovery' to capture the distinct aromas and preserve the character of the original wine, resulting in a fresh, new non-alcoholic alternative with no artificial colours or flavours.

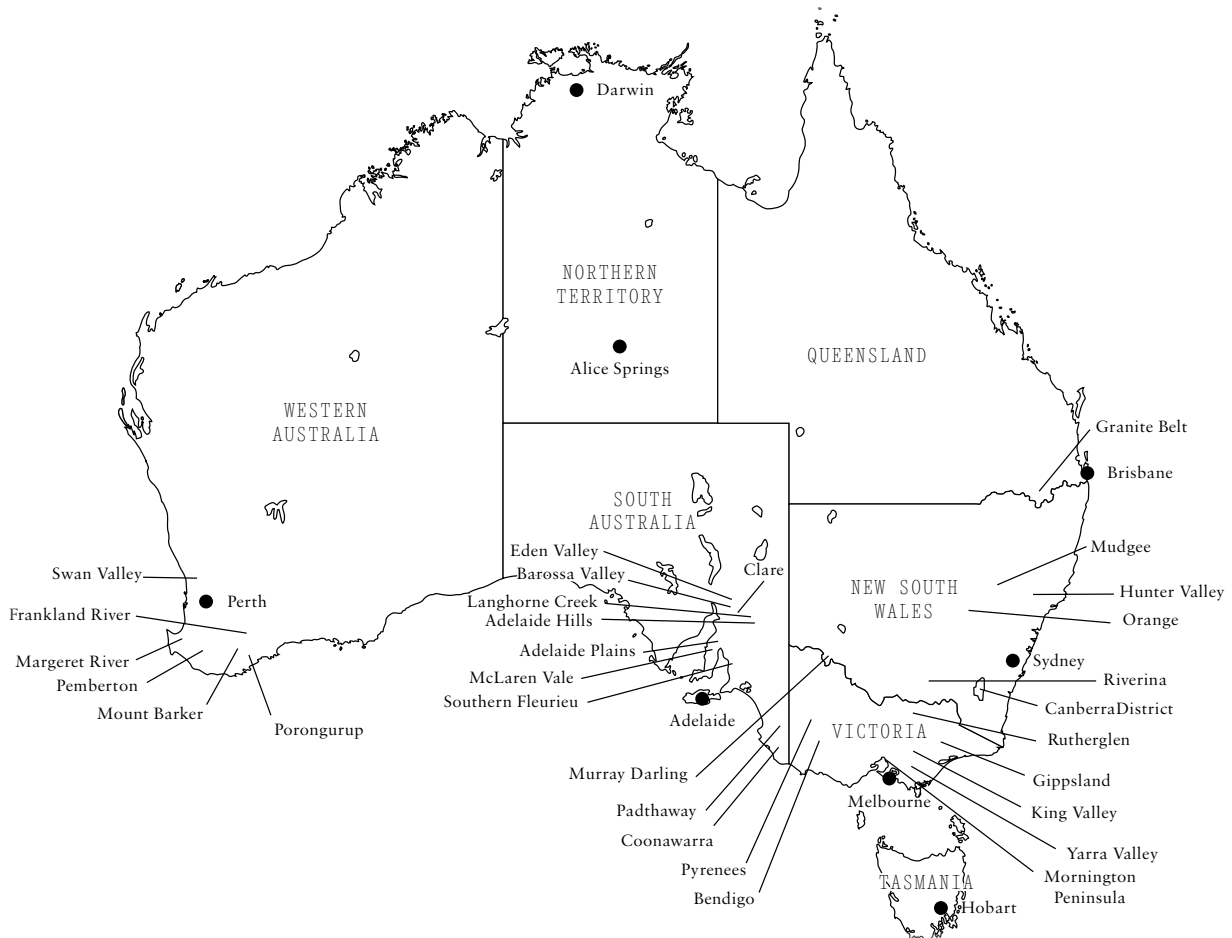
BIRTHPLACES OF AUSTRALIAN WINE

The areas surrounding Sydney have the longest grape growing histories in Australia. The original grape vines came with the First Fleet and were planted at Sydney Cove in 1788. New South Wales is Australia's most populated state, however it represents only around 30% of Australia's total production on an annual basis. Following on from the initial vines arriving in 1788, Captain John Macarthur planted vines near Camden and Gregory Blaxland planted vineyards around the Parramatta River in the early 1800s. James Busby's collection of 362 vines, originally planted at the Botanical Gardens, was the most significant development in the early history, and cuttings from these specific vines made their way to other parts of NSW, Victoria, and South Australia.

The State, boasts an incredibly diverse range of climates, including coastal (Shoalhaven Coast region lying south of Sydney) to Alpine (across the top of the Great Dividing Range), where hardy growers persist at over 500m above sea level.

Moving west over the Great Dividing Range and along the inland flowing Murrumbidgee and Murray Rivers are the warm-climate regions of Riverina and Perricoota, and the northern portion of the Swan Hill and Murray Darling. One of Australia's most renowned and historic wine regions - the Hunter Valley - is located just north of Sydney, Australia's bustling multicultural business and centre.

ANCIENT SOILS, ANCIENT CULTURE

Munda is the Indigenous Wirangu and Kokatha word for land, expressing the rich history of the select place from which it's cultivated.

For over 80,000 years these sacred regions have made up Kurna Country, Ngadjuri or Peramangk Country. Munda Wines proudly celebrates these Aboriginal Countries, as well as the people who have lived here, thrived here, and have lovingly tended the munda.

Munda Wines in collaboration with artisan winemakers from the specific countries mentioned have partnered in deep respect for munda. Indeed, winemakers and viticulturalists who grow vitis vinifera (grape vine) in these regions have done so for many decades, across generations. They understand the unique landscapes and climates in which they cultivate their vines, ensuring respect to munda in all their undertakings.

The distinct wine style of Munda Wines is to stay true to the tastes and body of the munda. Utilising minimal interventions, as well as using oak regimes to showcase munda, and preferring to bottle relatively early.

Most importantly and integral to the work that Munda Wines produce, is work with their winery partners and the Tjindu Foundation. Creating tangible pathways and an array of opportunities for Indigenous people to foray into the wine industry.

TYRRELL'S - HUNTER VALLEY, NSW

Established in 1858 by English immigrant Edward Tyrrell, Tyrrell's Wines is one of Australia's oldest family-owned wineries, deeply intertwined with the Hunter Valley's viticultural history. Edward planted Shiraz and Sémillon on his 320-acre Pokolbin property, "Ashmans," laying the foundation for a dynasty now led by fourth- and fifth-generation descendants, including Bruce Tyrrell AM and his son Chris Tyrrell, CEO since 2023.

The Tyrrells revolutionized Australian winemaking with milestones such as the 1963 debut of 'Vat 1 Sémillon', now Australia's most awarded white wine (5,500+ medals) . In 1968, they introduced Australia's first commercial Chardonnay, 'Vat 47' , using cuttings from historic vineyards. Their innovative spirit extended to sustainability, adopting screw caps in the 1980s to preserve quality, a move later embraced globally.

The family stewards eight of the Hunter Valley's 11 oldest vineyards, including the "Sacred Sites" range from vines over 100 years old. The "Old Patch Shiraz" (planted 1867), a three-time 100-point scorer, epitomizes their dedication to heritage . Their 1879 Shiraz block, pre-phylloxera and dry-farmed, remains a cornerstone of their winemaking.

The Tyrrells' success mirrors the Hunter's unique terroir – sandy soils for Sémillon's crisp acidity and red volcanic soils for Shiraz's elegance. Bruce Tyrrell's leadership earned accolades like the Order of Australia (2006), while the winery's inclusion in "Australia's First Families of Wine" underscores its national influence.

Today, Tyrrell's balances tradition with innovation, ensuring their 160-year legacy thrives through sustainable practices and a commitment to quality, embodied in their motto: "Nothing is great unless it is good".

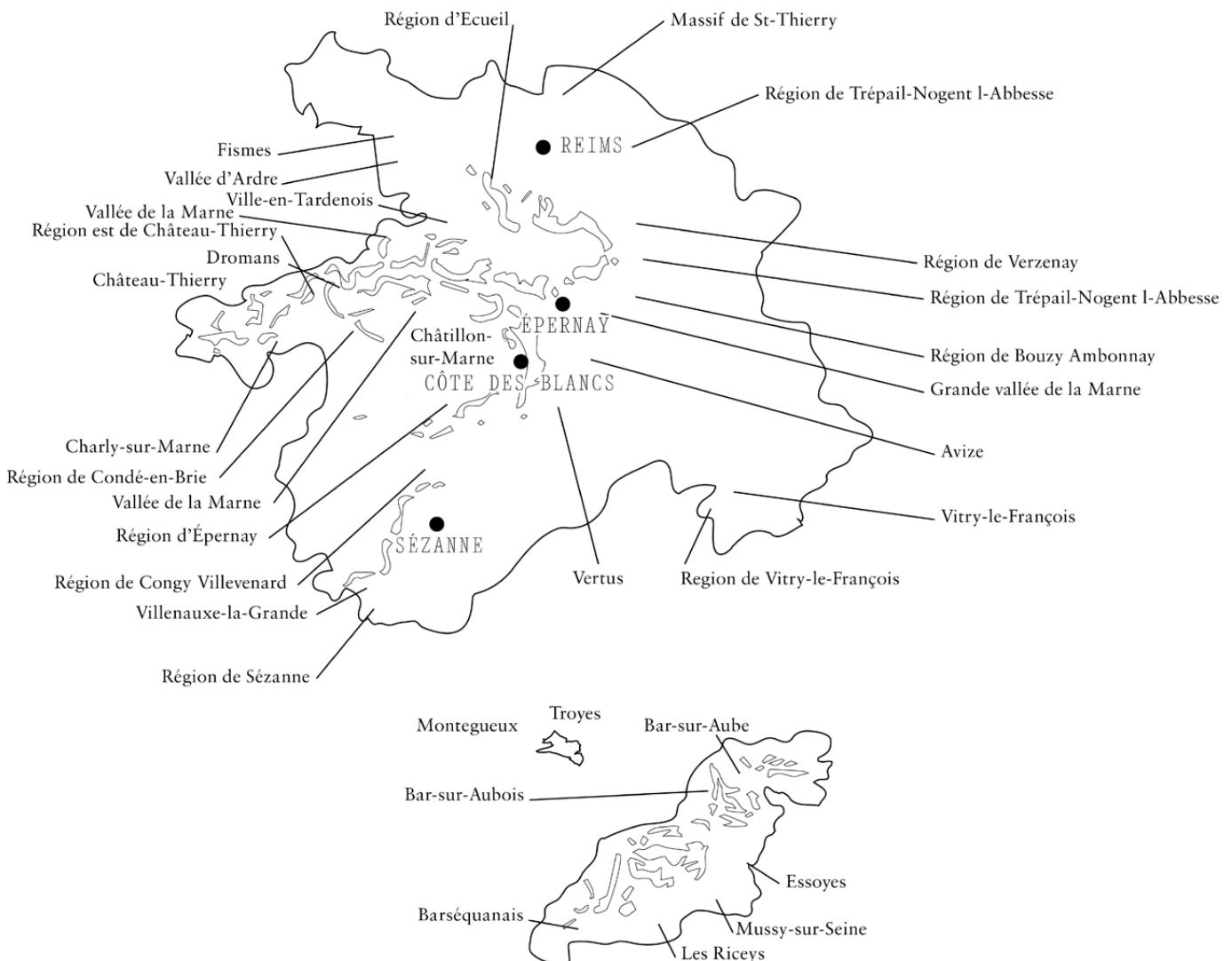

CHAMPAGNE WINE MAP

Champagne is located in the northeastern region of France, approximately 150 kilometers east of Paris. This cool-climate area is characterised by its chalky soils, which provide excellent drainage and impart a distinct minerality to the wines. The region is divided into five main sub-regions: Montagne de Reims, Vallée de la Marne, Côte des Blancs, Côte de Sézanne, and Aube.

The history of Champagne dates back to Roman times, but its transformation into the sparkling wine we know today began in the 17th century. Dom Pérignon, a Benedictine monk, is often credited with refining the production process, though the 'méthode champenoise' (secondary fermentation in the bottle) was perfected over time. Champagne gained royal favor in the 18th century, becoming the drink of choice for French kings and European nobility. By the 19th century, a few international Champagne houses had established its global reputation.

Today, Champagne remains a symbol of celebration and luxury, its unique terroir and meticulous craftsmanship ensuring its place as the pinnacle of sparkling wine.

HOUSE VS GROWER CHAMPAGNE

The difference between a Champagne House and a Grower Champagne lies in their scale, philosophy, and approach to winemaking, each offering a unique expression of Champagne.

Champagne House, known as *Négociant-Manipulants* (NMs), are large established producers. They source grapes from multiple vineyards across Champagne, blending them to create a consistent, house-style *cuvée* year after year. Their focus is on precision, blending expertise, and maintaining a recognisable flavour profile. These houses often have centuries of tradition, leveraging advanced technology and large-scale production to meet global demand. While they may produce single-vineyard or vintage champagnes, their primary goal is consistency rather than highlight individual *terroirs*.

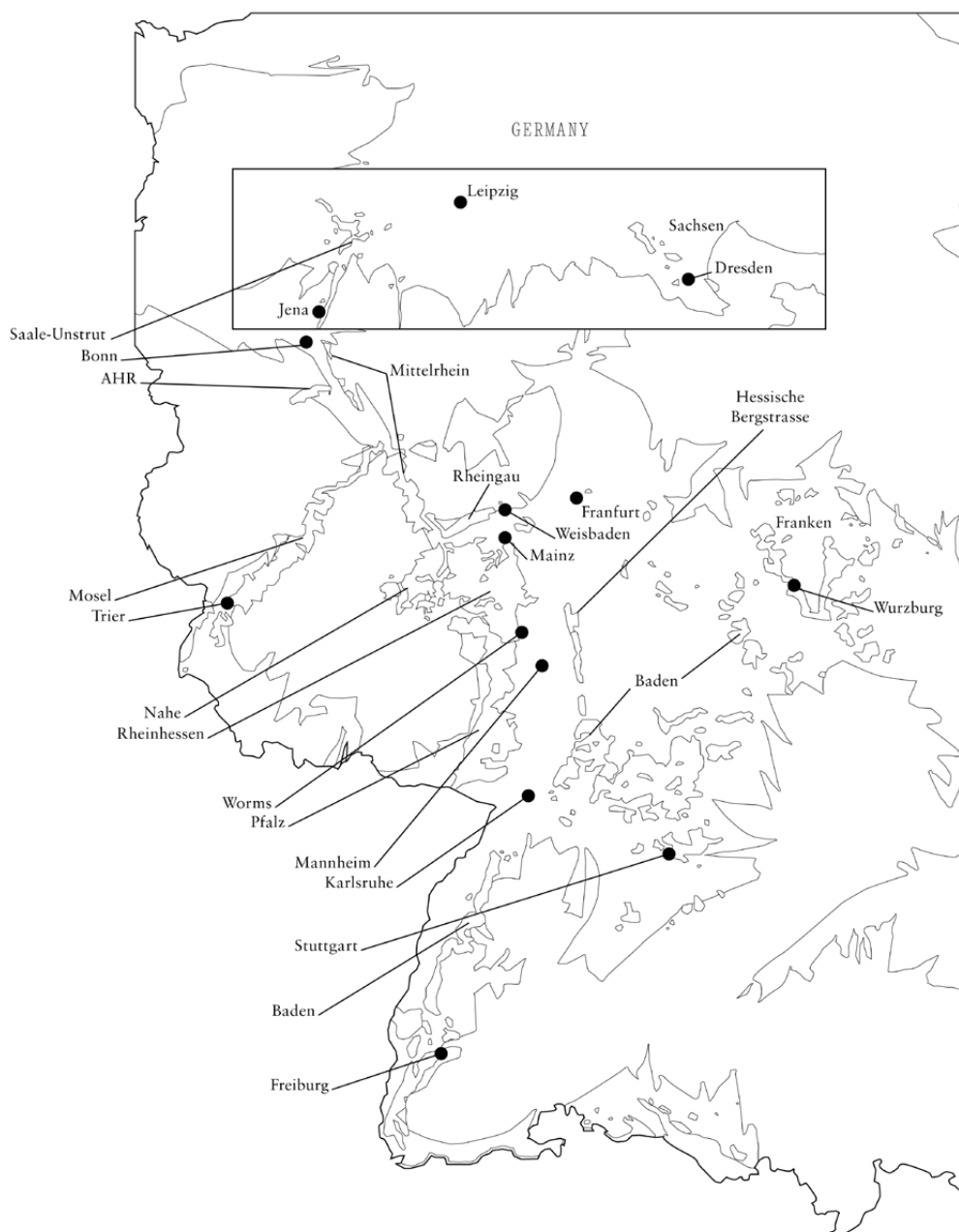
Grower Champagnes, labeled *Recoltant-Manipulants* (RMs), are crafted by small, often family-run estates that grow their own grapes and produce Champagne on-site. These producers focus on *terroir*-driven wines, showcasing the unique characteristics of their specific vineyards. Grower Champagnes are typically made in limited quantities, with an emphasis on artisanal methods, organic practices, and minimal intervention. Each bottle reflects the nuances of the soil, climate, and winemaker's philosophy, offering a more intimate and authentic experience. Both styles celebrate Champagne's magic but in distinct ways - Champagne House for their timeless elegance, and Grower Champagnes for their artisanal charm.

GERMANY WINE MAP

Germany's wine industry is a treasure trove of fascinating facts! Nestled along the banks of the Rhine, Mosel, and other picturesque rivers, Germany's vineyards are some of the world's northernmost, thriving in cool climates that produce vibrant, high-acid wines. The steep, slate-rich slopes of the Mosel Valley are particularly iconic, yielding some of the planet's most exquisite Rieslings - crisp, aromatic, and age-worthy.

Germany is the birthplace of Riesling, its flagship grape, but don't overlook Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir), which flourishes in regions like Baden. Fun fact: Germany has 13 wine regions, with the Pfalz being the second largest and Rheinhessen the biggest, home to the famous "Liebfraumlch" (though modern German wines are far more sophisticated!).

Historically, winemaking dates back to Roman times, but it was monks in the Middle Ages who refined viticulture. Today, Germany balances tradition with innovation, embracing organic and sustainable practices. And here's a quirky tidbit: the world's largest wine barrel, the *Heidelberg Tun*, holds over 58,000 gallons – cheers to that

Pinot Meunier – originating in France, likely Champagne or the Loire, Pinot Meunier is a distinct mutation of Pinot Noir, prized for its acidity, fruitiness, and frost resistance. It arrived in Australia in the 1830s, almost certainly within 'James Busby's' foundational collection of European vine cuttings imported for the nascent colonial wine industry. Initially, it was often mistaken for or interplanted with Pinot Noir. For over a century, its primary role was anonymous blending, especially into sparkling wines mimicking Champagne alongside Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Significant plantings grew with Australia's premium sparkling boom from the 1980s onwards, and only recently have its unique qualities gained recognition for single-varietal wines, particularly from cool regions like Great Western, Yarra Valley and Tasmania.

BURGUNDY WINE MAP

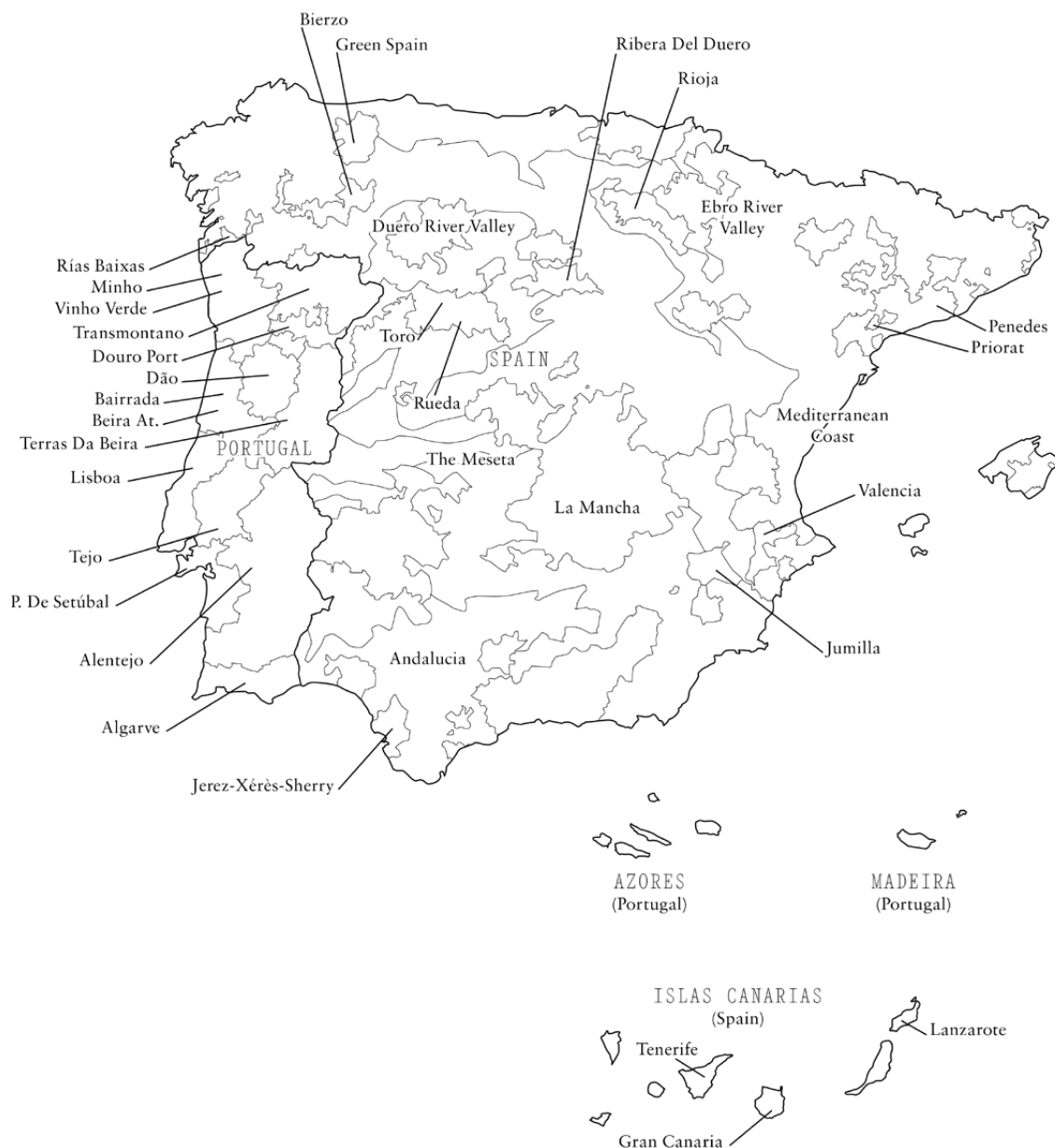
IBERIAN PENINSULA WINE MAP

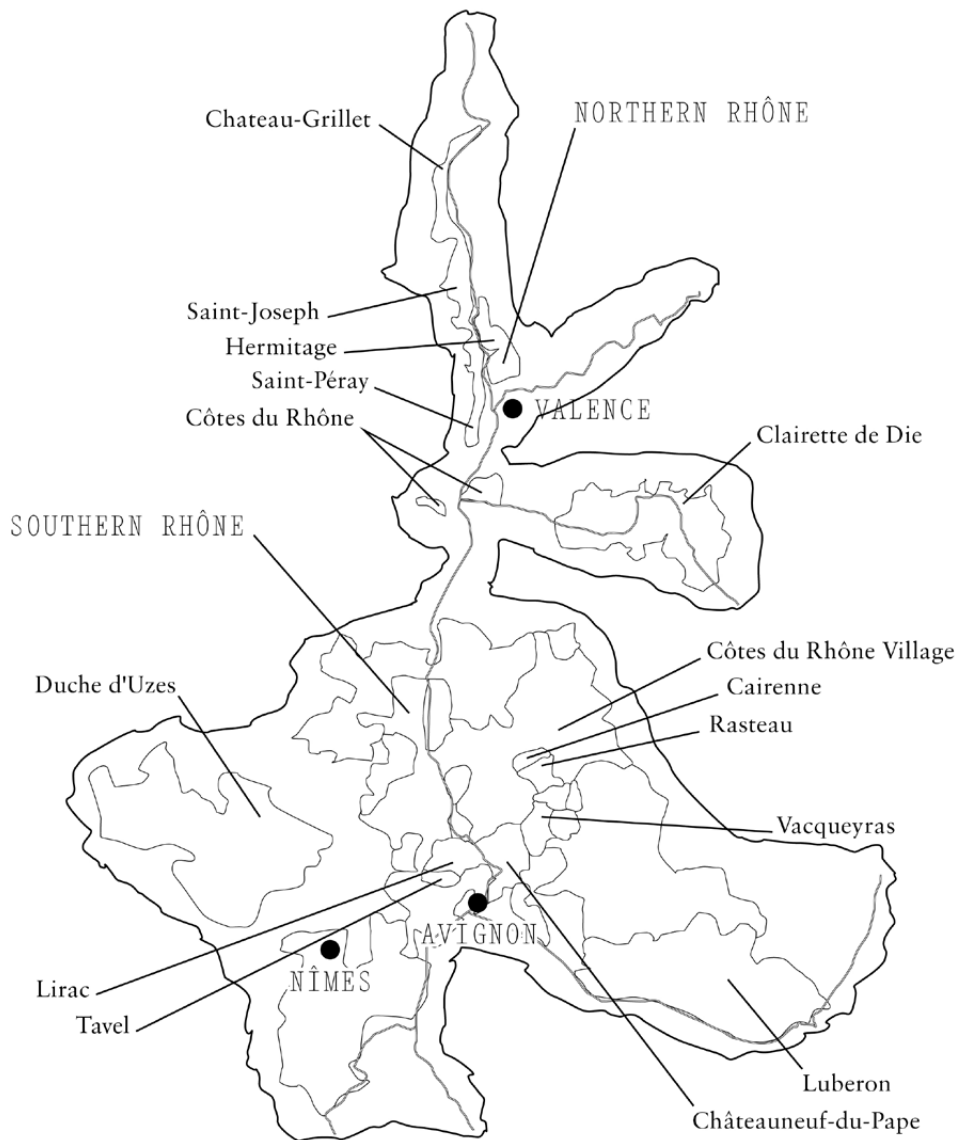

Tasked by LVMH to locate China's ideal red wine terroir, Jordan spent four years surveying regions before selecting Yunnan over alternatives like Ningxia. His expertise identified the microclimates avoiding monsoons and winter vine-burying, enabling organic cultivation and optimal ripening.

Innovation & Terroir – Producers like Ao Yun and Xiaoling leverage high-elevation sites and Burgundian techniques, signaling quality focused evolution beyond mass production.

Ao Yun symbolizes China's luxury wine ascent, though broader industry recovery hinges on premiumisation and global narrative-building.

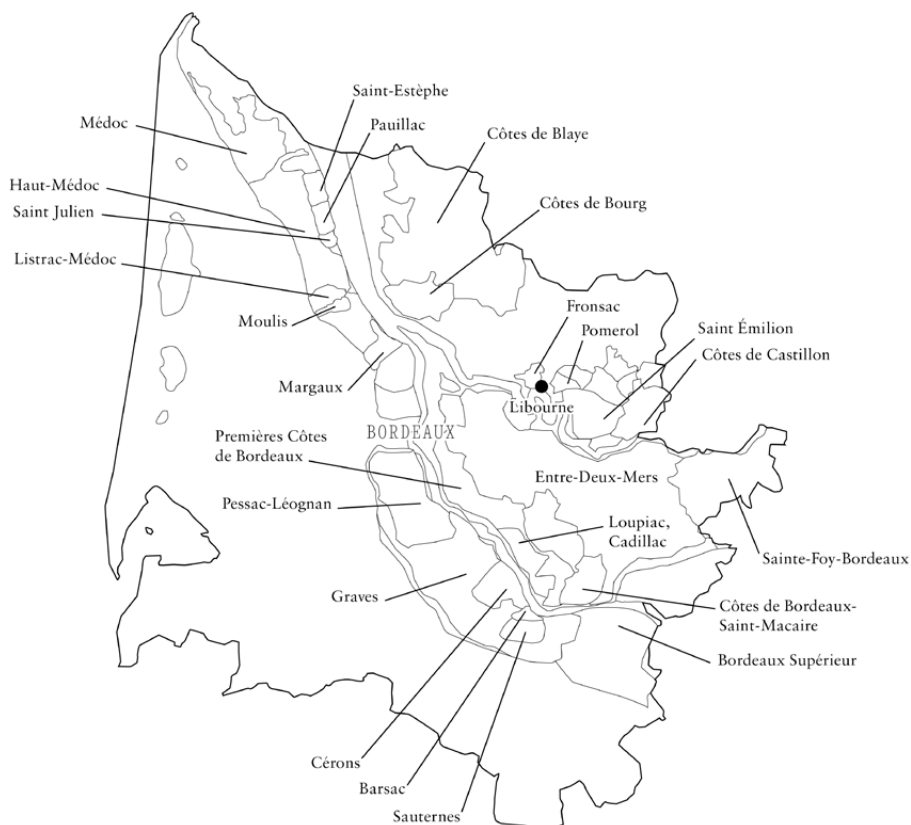

Meanwhile, Italy's Vin Santo and Spain's Pedro Ximénez (PX) Sherry offer nutty, raisin-like sweetness. Fun fact: Ice wine, made from grapes frozen on the vine, is a specialty of Germany (Eiswein) and Canada, where the cold climate ensures perfect conditions. Dessert wines are a testament to patience and craftsmanship, perfect for pairing with cheese, pastries, or sipping solo. Cheers to indulgence!

Brandy and Cognac are the aristocrats of distilled spirits, each with a rich heritage and distinct character. Cognac, the pinnacle of brandy, hails from the Cognac region in southwestern France. Made exclusively from Ugni Blanc grapes, it's double-distilled in copper pot stills and aged in French oak, yielding flavours of vanilla, dried fruit, and spice. Fun fact: Cognac's aging classifications (VS, VSOP, XO) reflect its elegance and complexity, with XO requiring a minimum of 10 years in barrel.

Brandy, a broader category, is produced worldwide. Spain's Brandy de Jerez, aged in sherry casks, offers nutty, caramel notes, while California's brandies are known for their bold, fruity profiles. Armenia claims to be the birthplace of brandy, with its Ararat brandy dating back to 1887.

Both spirits have royal roots – Cognac was favored by European monarchs, and brandy was a sailor's staple during long voyages. Today, they remain symbols of refinement, perfect for sipping neat or crafting classic cocktails.
