




Where nature whispers in your ear








Flavors born from a Sustainable kitchen



Culinary Activity Pachamanca

Pachamanca means "Pot of the Earth" in English; it is an ancient dish of Andean origin, considered part of the Cultural Heritage of the Nation, and one of the most representative of Peruvian gastronomy.

CAPACITY DURATION min: 2 people 3 hours



In addition to the Pachamanca, our visitors will be able to taste the typical drink of Cusco, since the time of the Incas, La Chicha or "aswa" in Quechua, is a fermented drink that was offered in ceremonial events and that today continues to be offered in Cusco houses.








Ancestral wisdom Preserved in the Andes for generations

Cusco is one of the places on the planet with many people dedicated to studying the wisdom of Pachamama, or Mother Earth. Our guests enjoy unique experiences at the hand of authentic shamans. We practice focused rituals in channeling energy, in gratitude, and asking protection from the Apus (the name given to the higher spirits of the protector mountains).



Offering to the Earth, or Pachamama Ritual

The ritual consists of a ceremony of gratitude to the gods of nature, offering the Earth different ingredients such as coca leaves, sweets, cereals, and more.

The shaman invokes the gods of the Andean cosmology, and the guests make their requests to Mother Earth.


Andean wedding "Arac Masin"

The Andean wedding, an ancestral ritual that unites the couple for life in body, mind, and spirit.

This traditional ceremony, performed in a mystical setting, forms an unbreakable bond between the couple and the elements of nature.


