


#### **GORDON RIVER CRUISE**

- Step ashore at Sarah Island for an interpretive tour before returning to Strahan.


#### HELLS GATES TO SARAH ISLAND

### PREMIER UPPER DECK



## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Spirit of the Wild is equipped with a hybrid diesel-electric propulsion system, allowing us to shut down the diesel engines while on the Gordon River. You'll cruise quietly in the wilderness.

#### DAYLIGHT SAVINGS IN TASMANIA

Applicable between the first weekend of October and April. The optimal private charter experience is between these months, as the days are longer, allowing more time to take in the views as the sun sets over the Southern Ocean.

- Approx. sunset time October: 7.45pm
- Approx. sunset time November: 8.20pm
- Approx. sunset time December: 9.00pm
- Approx. sunset time January: 8.45pm
- Approx. sunset time February: 8.40-8.00pm
- Approx. sunset time March: 8.00-7.14pm

Departures may be subject to weather.

Spirit of the Wild can also be used as a floating venue while docked in Strahan between April and October.
