# **Privacy Collection Notice Statement**

The UniLodge and Essence accommodation properties are managed by a group of companies including UniLodge Australia Pty Ltd (ACN 078 921 169), Essence Communities Pty Ltd (ACN 639543740), and their related bodies corporate (collectively, **UniLodge**).

UniLodge is committed to protecting the privacy of individuals and their personal information or personal data (as defined in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) (**Australian Privacy Act**) or the New Zealand Privacy Act 2020 (**NZ Privacy Act**), together the **Privacy Law**, in respect of individuals within Australia or New Zealand, as the case may be) or personal data (as defined in the *General Data Protection Regulation* (**GDPR**) in respect of individuals in the EU).

#### You understand that:

- 2. The purposes of UniLodge collecting your personal information or personal data includes but is not limited to:
  - (a) processing your request to participate in a residence activity, and providing you with ancillary support and services for that activity;
  - (b) assisting you in the case of any injury or emergency in connection with us or that occurs on premises that we manage; and
  - (c) exercising our duty of care to you when you are on premises that we manage including, where applicable, conducting voluntary welfare checks and assisting you to comply with applicable mandatory under-18 student curfew obligations or public health regulations;
  - (d) if applicable, processing your payment in connection with your participating in residence activities;
  - (e) providing you with marketing materials communications concerning upcoming events we consider may be of interest to you;
  - (f) ensuring your safety when on premises that we manage and verifying any instances of breach of residency rules, the applicable law or complaints by way of video recording and image capture,

and you agree to your personal information or personal data being collected and used for, and in connection with, these purposes and any other purpose in our Privacy Policy.

- 3. In some instances, we may collect personal information or personal data from your alternative contact (such as your parent or guardian). You acknowledge that your alternative contact is aware that we hold their information for the purposes of exercising our duty of care to you.
- 4. In some instances, we may collect personal information or personal data from you which you have voluntarily provided but which is unsolicited. To the extent reasonable, we will delete or de-identify any unsolicited personal information. However, due to the nature of our IT system, if you use our IT system to send or receive personal emails we will be unable to remove any personal information or personal data which is backed up and stored on our servers. You acknowledge and you agree to your personal information or personal data being collected and stored by us.
- 5. If we do not collect this personal information or personal data in connection with the purposes in paragraph 2, we may not be able to assist you with your application to reside at premises which we manage.
- 6. Your personal information or personal data may be disclosed to the following classes of people and organisations for the purposes in paragraph 2:
  - (a) us, our personnel and related entities;
  - (b) our third party service providers (such as event co-ordination and hire, payment processing providers, and IT suppliers);
  - (c) your university or other educational provider;
  - (d) medical or health service providers that are required to assist you in the case of a medical or public health emergency;

- (e) third parties who assist us with the marketing process and any other organisation set out in our Privacy Policy; and
- (f) other disclosures as required by law.
- 7. It is possible that some of the information collected for the purpose of your residence at premises we manage may be disclosed to our related bodies corporate or service providers outside of Australia or New Zealand, as the case may be. You consent to your information being disclosed to a destination outside Australia or New Zealand (whichever applies) for this purpose, and you understand and acknowledge that either the Australian Privacy Principle 8.1 or the NZ Privacy Act will not apply to such disclosures of your personal information or personal data outside of the relevant jurisdiction.
- 8. Our Privacy Policy sets out the process as to how you can access and correct any of your personal information collected for the purposes outlined in paragraph 2, as well as to how you can make a complaint if you believe we have breached the Privacy Law in the handling of your personal information.
