Under the creative direction of acclaimed architect Ernesto Bedmar, who has helmed the hotel’s previous renovation projects, room categories in the Mayfair Wing have been thoughtfully revitalised. The new interiors embrace a contemporary yet timeless aesthetic, striking a refined balance between sleek sophistication and warm elegance.

A soothing palette of light and earthy tones sets the mood – complemented by clean lines, natural wood finishes, leather accents, vinyl plank flooring and sustainable sisal rugs, a durable natural fibre derived from the Agave Sisalana plant that enhances a sense of cosiness and timeless organic appeal. Curated black-and-white photographs of nostalgic local scenes by French artist Gilles Massot add character and are a nostalgic homage to a storied past.

Deluxe Mayfair Room (King Bed), Bathroom Area

The revitalised rooms feature stylish design details and private balconies overlooking either the Balinese-inspired Mayfair Pool or lush greenery. Guests may enjoy the option of natural ventilation through ceiling fans and open balcony doors, alongside air-conditioning. Each room also includes an en-suite bathroom with a bathtub.

Other thoughtful modern amenities include leather swivel chair, an LCD flat screen TV and international sockets. The refreshed Mayfair room types and thoughtfully designed to suit different travel needs:

- **Deluxe Mayfair Rooms:** Available in twin or king configurations, these rooms feature private balconies with pool or garden views and a relaxed, resort-style ambience – with the flexibility to accommodate an extra bed, making them ideal for families.

Summary

An icon on Scotts Road, Goodwood Park Hotel is housed in a uniquely designed building that dates back to 1900. The Hotel stands as a distinguished institution in hospitality circles and is also one of the most reputable pioneers of the tourism industry. Much of her original beauty has been faithfully restored and her majestic air artfully accentuated with fluted columns, delicate woodworks, decorative plasterwork and graceful archways. Through the years, she has gained recognition for her exquisite elegance, legendary charm and tradition of excellence, with her Grand Tower gazetted a national monument in 1989. The Hotel has five distinctive restaurants, each providing a unique dining experience, along with a deli, a bar, two outdoor swimming pools and a fitness centre. The Hotel also gained its well-deserved recognition in the MICHELIN Guide Singapore 2025, and attained GSTC certification in July 2025.
