

Accommodation Scholarship

UniLodge Perth Central is excited to offer a limited number of scholarships, in the form of discounted weekly accommodation. UniLodge is committed to assisting young adults with their pursuit of tertiary study and these scholarships have been established to support students for whom accommodation costs present a challenge to their tertiary participation at either The University of Western Australia (UWA), Curtin University (Curtin), Murdoch University (MU) and Edith Cowan University (ECU).

These scholarships will be awarded to students who, without the financial assistance provided by this scholarship, would be at risk of not starting, continuing or completing their study in Semester 2, 2026.

Note: this scholarship will apply to a bedroom within a 5-Bedroom Apartment accommodation only.

Eligibility Requirements

The scholarships are open to **new** residents who:

1. can demonstrate a history of academic achievement; and
2. can demonstrate that accommodation affordability presents a significant barrier to commencing or continuing their university study; and
3. are not already in receipt of another substantial competitive scholarship from a university or other external party

Applicants must be enrolled full time in an approved university program for Semester 2, 2026.

Application Process

The completed application form is to be submitted to the General Manager, UniLodge Perth Central up until **17th July 2026, 5pm**. Applicants **must** complete the application form and provide copies of all requested supporting documentation.

Applications will be assessed against the eligibility criteria as set out by UniLodge.

Selection Process

An applicant will not be selected for a UniLodge Perth Central Accommodation Scholarship unless the selection committee is satisfied that they meet the eligibility criteria for a scholarship as set out in these guidelines.

Assessment of an applicant's financial circumstances will be based on the information provided in the scholarship application form and the supporting documentation that has been provided. The selection committee will make its own judgement about what constitutes the most meritorious cases. The selection committee will make its own judgement about what constitutes an approved university program for Semester 2, 2026. Throughout the selection process, extra documentation may be requested by UniLodge from the applicant to assist in the decision making.

Offer Process

The UniLodge Accommodation Scholarships will be selected by a panel comprising:

1. The General Manager, UniLodge Perth Central (as Chair); and
2. The Regional General Manager, UniLodge Western Australia

Applicants will be officially notified by email of the outcome of their application.

The award of a UniLodge Perth Central Accommodation Scholarship will be conditional on the recipient being enrolled in a full-time study load at their respective university for Semester 2, 2026. Verified documentation of this enrolment can be requested by UniLodge from the applicant.

Applicants, at the time of accepting an offer of a UniLodge Perth Central Accommodation Scholarship, must accept the conditions of the scholarship and agree to provide any information relevant to assessing their ongoing eligibility for a scholarship.

Value and Duration of Scholarships

The value of a UniLodge Perth Central Accommodation Scholarship in Semester 2, 2026 will be payable as an accommodation rent reduction on the following room types and leases:

- Semester 2 lease for a bedroom within a 5-Bedroom Apartment at the approved rate of \$439/week: scholarship recipients receive a rent reduction of \$120/week, bringing the total rent to \$319/week for a 19-week Semester 2 lease.

The scholarship may be accessed from the start of residence at UniLodge Perth Central which is to be **no later than 31st July 2026**. The scholarship will run for 19 weeks from the lease start date, or the lease end date, whichever is earliest, conditional on the recipient's continued residency at UniLodge Perth Central and their abidance by UniLodge Perth Central House Rules and expectations.

Residential Tenancy Agreement

It is advisable that the successful applicant inspects the property and room prior to signing this lease. Even if an application is successful, the applicant will not be entitled to, or move into UniLodge Perth Central unless, and until, a valid Residential Tenancy Agreement is entered into.

Successful applicants must enter into a Residential Tenancy Agreement for a standard studio apartment with UniLodge Perth Central from July 2026 to a maximum of 19 weeks. An earlier start date or later end date can be negotiated with the successful applicant; however, the scholarship period of 19 weeks is non-negotiable.

Successful applicants will be required to lodge a security bond of 4 weeks' gross rent with the Western Australian Bond Administrator, in accordance with the Residential Tenancies Act 1987 (WA). The bond is calculated on the gross weekly rent per week, not the post-scholarship net rent. UniLodge Perth Central does not hold bonds in trust.

Successful applicants will abide by all RTA and residential tenancy agreement requirements as per their lease agreement and the house rules of UniLodge Perth Central. Applicants are encouraged to ensure they are aware of [WALW - Residential Tenancies Act 1987](#) prior to signing their lease.

The applicant acknowledges and agrees that once an agreement has been signed, the room allocation listed on the agreement will remain the same throughout the tenancy.

Upon completion of the lease term, all rent being paid in full, and providing the apartment is returned to UniLodge in the same condition as when the resident took occupation, a security bond refund is to be completed between UniLodge Perth Central and the tenant.

Academic Requirements

UniLodge Perth Central Accommodation Scholarship are required to remain enrolled in a standard full-time study load for the semester.

Recipients whose enrolment status changes from being full time, during the length of the scholarship must notify the UniLodge Perth Central immediately in writing. Verified documentation can be reasonably requested to support this information. This includes any action taken from the university in relation to the recipient's enrolment such as cancellation or termination due to, but not limited to show cause, misconduct or other disciplinary actions.

Termination of a UniLodge Perth Central Accommodation Scholarship

A UniLodge Perth Central Accommodation Scholarship will be terminated:

1. If the recipient has provided false or misleading information in their application or during the scholarship period, which would have affected the assessment of their eligibility; or
2. once the full value of the scholarship has been paid, or
3. if the recipient fails to meet the academic requirements set out in these guidelines; or
4. at the discretion of the General Manager, UniLodge Perth Central where the recipient fails to comply with the terms of the UniLodge Perth Central tenancy agreement or UniLodge Perth Central house rules.

The security bond is held by the Western Australian Bond Administrator and is administered in accordance with the Residential Tenancies Act 1987 (WA). Scholarship termination does not affect the Tenant's statutory bond entitlements.

Other

Applicants are responsible for all costs incurred in the preparation and lodgement of their application. Successful applicants are responsible for any moving costs that may be incurred. An unsuccessful application does not in any way imply a personal judgement has been made about the applicant. Any extra costs incurred during the course, or at the conclusion, of the lease will be the responsibility of the recipient. These may include, but are not limited to, costs for damage caused by the resident, replacement of damaged or missing equipment, after- hours call-out costs, replacement key costs, and cleaning costs at the end of the tenancy. Successful domestic students must be at least 18 years of age at the time of the lease agreement being signed unless otherwise approved by the management of UniLodge Perth Central.
