sowing tulle

Porta Hotel del Lago, in alliance with Amigos del Lago, carried out a tulle planting day at San Antonio Palopó Beach on May 17, 2021. Tulle is a natural filter against pollutants, it controls the growth of cyanobacteria, is a natural competitor for phosphorus and nitrogen and is the habitat of fish, crustaceans and mollusks.

30 tulle macoyas were planted on 60 meters along San Antonio Palopó beach.



reforestation

Porta Hotel del Lago, along with Valle University UVG, Semetabaj Archaeological Site and the Commission of Elders, organized a reforestation day on May 18.

67 trees were planted on the Jucanya South public beach.
