EXPLORE

Located in Costa Rica's Guanacaste province, Las Catalinas provides the perfect eco-conscious, outdoorliving escape. The town is free of motorized vehicles, which means you'll hear nothing but crashing waves when you take surf lessons (a must-try on any visit) with Pura Vida Ride. ConnectOcean also offers PADI scuba diving courses and education on aquatic ecosystems, while biodiverse Palo Verde National Park is the perfect spot for a scenic hike.

INDULGE

No trip to Costa Rica would be complete without a restorative dip in a hot spring. At Sensoria (1), step into five different rainforest thermal pools and soak your cares away. For a private wellness experience, pop into Center of Joy for everything from cupping with



aromatherapy to Tibetan sound healing. You can even book a dance meditation class to explore music and movement in a group.


TASTE

For upscale fare, try Ponciana's Mediterranean-inspired menu or seafood-forward dishes like tuna tartare and shrimp risotto at Sentido Norte (2). Craving a relaxed setting? Wander over to the beach for beers at The Brewhouse by Papagayo Brewing Co.

STAY

Santarena Hotel pays homage to the grand mansions of Havana and Cartagena with its whitewashed walls, Juliet balconies and greeneryfilled terraces. There's also a rooftop pool with breathtaking views. If you plan to visit nearby Tamarindo a popular spot with tourists - spend a night at beachy Cala Luna (3) and enjoy free yoga and bicycle access, plus farm-to-table dinners in the hotel garden.
