ground peanuts.

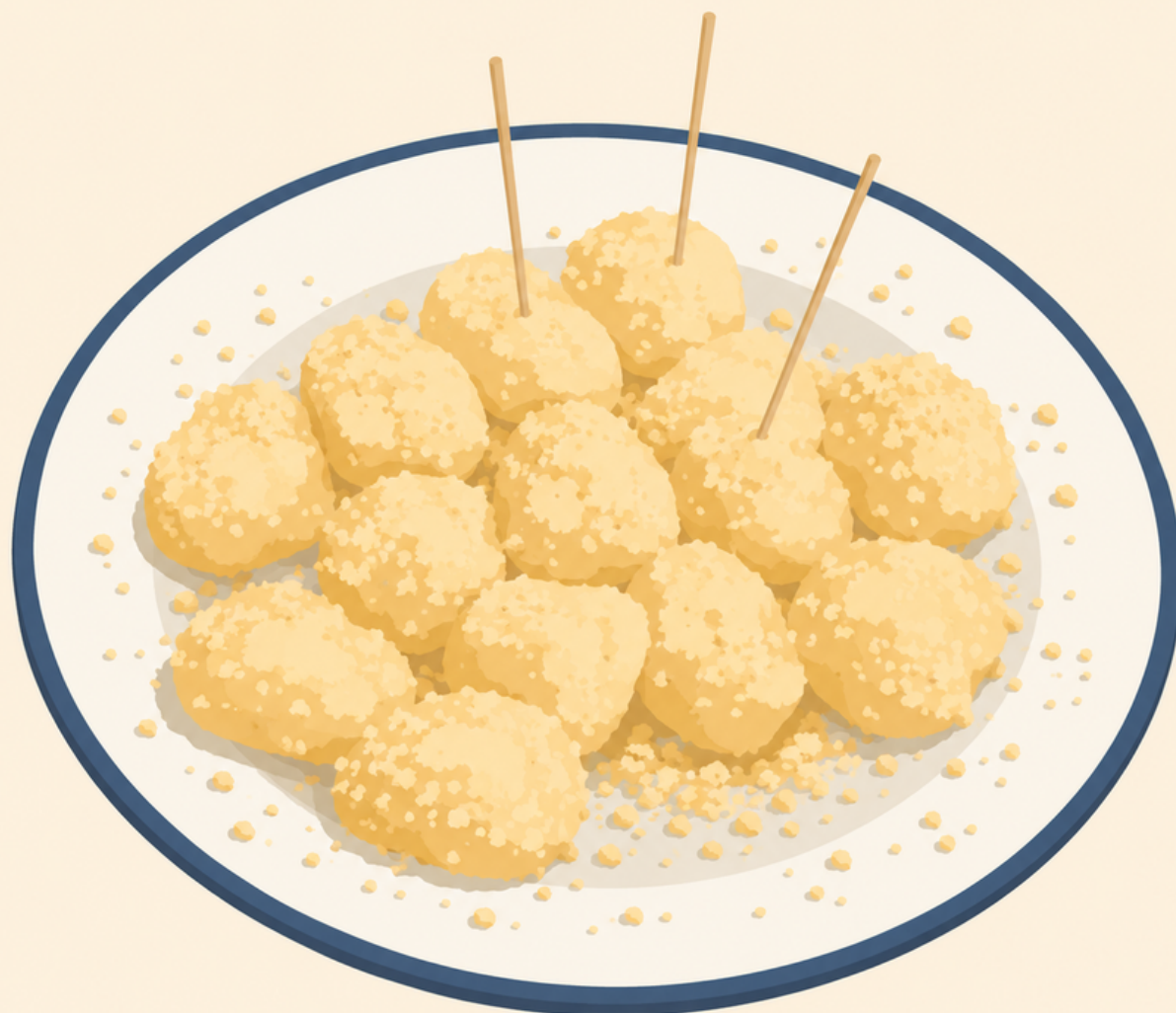
Made fresh in flower-shaped moulds, its warm, fragrant

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Freshly stretched, cut and tossed, this chewy glutinous rice snack is coated in crushed peanuts and sugar.

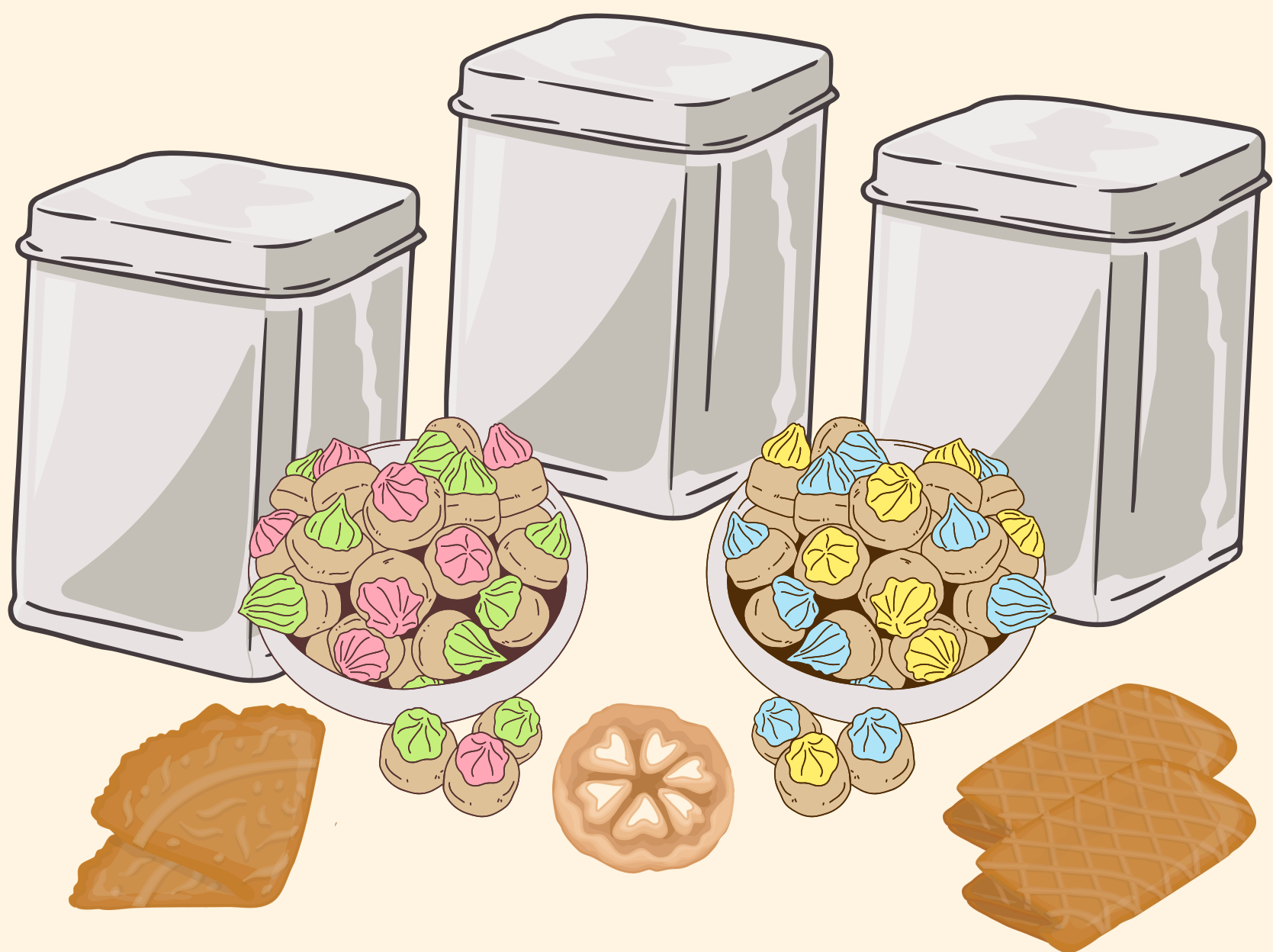
Best enjoyed warm, it's a treat that's as fun to watch being made as it is to eat.
