Two-week campaign will raise no lesser than RM33,390

Port Dickson, July 2, 2018 -- The iconic Lexis Hotel Group – Lexis Port Dickson, Grand Lexis and Lexis Hibiscus in Port Dickson, today announced its support for the nation's Tabung Harapan by donating RM3 per room from June 25 to July 8, 2018, which is expected to raise no lesser than RM33,390 in total.
