Overview

Nestled amid the picturesque peaks of New Hampshire's famed White Mountains, Mountain View Grand Resort & Spa stands as a timeless retreat, offering a haven of tranquility and natural beauty. With its charming gabled rooftop and sprawling grounds, the resort, listed on the National Register of Historic Places, exudes an aura of understated elegance and serenity, inviting guests to unwind and reconnect with nature. Whether it's couples seeking a romantic getaway, families in search of adventure, or friends and loved ones celebrating a special occasion, Mountain View Grand provides a sense of escape—and limitless possibility.

Here, guests can immerse themselves in a myriad of year-round pursuits, from tennis, golf, and mountain biking in the warmer months to sleigh rides, sledding, and cross-country skiing when snow blankets the landscape. Additionally, the resort offers exceptional dining experiences showcasing locally sourced ingredients, a working farm where guests can interact with a host of animals, a golf course with stunning mountain views, and a restorative spa.

Boasting a history dating to the middle of the 19th century, Mountain View Grand's roots are intertwined with the region's pioneering spirit. Through the years, it has evolved from an intimate family-run inn into a cherished and historic resort, building upon an enduring legacy of hospitality and charm that has enchanted guests for generations.

History

In 1865, during a dark and stormy night, the Mountain View House was born out of necessity when a stagecoach traveling from Boston to Montreal overturned near what is now Mountain View Road. Seeking refuge from the storm, passengers stumbled upon the home of William and Mary Jane Dodge. Impressed by their hospitality and the stunning vistas, they implored the Dodges to extend their stay. Recognizing an opportunity, the Dodges officially opened the Mountain View House in 1866, marking the beginning of a legacy that would endure for generations. Over the years, the inn expanded to accommodate guests' changing needs, attracting notable figures, including several former U.S. presidents. Despite several changes in ownership, the hotel remained a cherished landmark until its closure in 1986.

In 1998, however, a vision emerged to restore its grandeur. Following a \$20 million restoration, Mountain View Grand Resort & Spa celebrated its grand reopening in 2002. In 2022, the resort was purchased by new ownership and underwent another multimilliondollar renovation, redefining the resort experience with transformative updates to the lobby, Club House, and Harvest Tavern. The guestrooms were also enhanced with sumptuous textures and modern amenities to provide a renewed sense of comfort and luxury. Today, the resort is a tribute to timeless elegance, blending modern amenities with historic charm amid the pristine beauty of the White Mountains.





Accommodations

The resort offers 141 guestrooms and suites.

The tastefully appointed rooms with classic furnishings are comfortable and spacious, many with full or partial views of the golf course or White Mountains, including Mount Lafayette, Cannon Mountain, and Kilkenny Range.



PRESIDENTIAL SUITE

SUMMIT SUITE

Ideal for those seeking a spacious retreat, the Summit Suites offer a king bedroom, a separate living room, and a balcony overlooking the Waterfall Terrace and golf course, along with views of the southern valley and Presidential Mountain Range.

SIGNATURE SUITE

A favorite among honeymooners and those celebrating milestone occasions, these stunning suites overlook the beautiful Waterfall Terrace and pond. Perched above the golf course's eighth fairway, they feature a king bed, a separate living room, and views of Mount Lafayette and Cannon Mountain.

Farm



Mountain View Farm, a working farm dedicated to raising fiber-producing animals, offers a sense of rustic charm and produces the resort's exclusive Mountain View Farm Blend yarn, crafted from a unique blend of wool sourced from a variety of sheep, along with fiber from angora goats, llamas, alpacas, and angora rabbits. This exquisite yarn is available at the Provisions gift shop or in the barn's fiber studio during morning hours. Open daily from 8:30am to 4:00pm, Mountain View Farm welcomes resort guests to explore its artisanal offerings firsthand.

Meeting/Event Facilities

With the breathtaking beauty of New Hampshire's White Mountains as a backdrop, Mountain View Grand is an ideal setting for events and celebrations of all kinds.

Offering 20,000 square feet of flexible meeting and event space—both indoor and outdoor—event facilities also include state-of-the-art technology and an experienced staff. The resort features 14 elegant and historical rooms that can be easily transformed to host memorable galas, lavish weddings, corporate meetings, or intimate gatherings. Highlights:

- Featuring a spectacular crystal chandelier suspended from a hand-painted interior dome, the Crystal Ballroom is Mountain View Grand's largest venue at 6,268 square feet and a capacity of up to 500. It offers unparalleled views of the mountains through floor-to-ceiling picture windows.
- Located behind the Crystal Ballroom, the Grand
 View Tent is ideal for receptions—or as a dining
 venue or vendor space. Available spring through fall,
 it is frequently booked with the ballroom.
- Perfect for intimate meetings, the Garden Room, with capacity for up to 60, is set in the main hotel. It provides seasonal access to the Garden Room Deck (available for an additional fee), which overlooks waterfalls and a koi pond. The deck also connects to the Waterfall Terrace.
- Accommodating up to 12 attendees, the Eisenhower Boardroom comes with a built-in 86" TV.
- Adjacent to the Eisenhower Boardroom, the Eisenhower Library offers a secluded and cozy space complete with a fireplace and natural light, ideal for focused work or relaxation.
- Available mid-week and seasonally, the **Dodge Parlor** is an inspiring setting for meetings located on the lobby level. It features beamed ceilings and an abundance of windows framing a view of the golf course and mountains beyond.
- Situated in Harvest Tavern, the Hunt Room is a popular choice for private dining, breakout sessions, and boardroom-style meetings. It can accommodate up to 20 people.

- 1865 Wine Cellar & Chef's Table together can accommodate up to 32 guests for a refined, elegant event. The Chef's Table serves as the resort's most intimate dining experience and can accommodate small gatherings of up to 12.
- With its expansive 3,967-square-foot layout, vaulted ceilings, a grand fireplace, and floor-to-ceiling windows that showcase mountaintop vistas, the stunning **Presidential Ballroom** offers a seamless blend of elegance and functionality. It can host up to 378 guests.
- The Presidential Ballroom can also be divided into the 2,348-square-foot Harding Room, with floor-toceiling windows, and 1,492-square-foot Roosevelt Room, with the grand fireplace.
- Situated in Presidential Hall, the 456-square-foot
 Cleveland Room and 452-square-foot Coolidge
 Room both feature a built-in 75" TV and are ideal for smaller meetings.
- Serving as the entrance to the Presidential Ballroom and Cleveland and Coolidge Rooms, the Presidential Foyer is an ideal location to host a registration table, exhibitor tables, or food and beverage breaks.
- Overlooking the golf course and White Mountains, the picturesque **Club House** is a unique setting for intimate business meetings, birthday or anniversary parties, or lively receptions.

Pets

Mountain View Grand rolls out the red carpet for furry VIPs, creating tailwagging excitement for pooches who check in alongside their humans.

Four-legged friends are greeted with a wag-tastic swag bag filled with treats and toys, while the resort's dedicated dog-loving staff are on standby, ready to shower them with endless cuddles and belly rubs. Distance from Airport

Mountain View Grand offers a range of options for arrival and departure by air, as four major airports are within a three-hour radius.

Manchester-Boston Regional Airport in Manchester, NH; Portland International Jetport in Portland, ME; Logan Airport in Boston, MA; and Burlington International Airport in South Burlington, VT, make it easy to reach the resort. Mount Washington Regional Airport, minutes away in Whitefield, is ideal for private planes and corporate jets. Gorham Airport and Berlin Municipal Airport, both within a 45-minute drive, cater to private air travelers as well.
