PEST CONTROL EXERCISE, 13 AND 14 JULY 2026

Please be advised that we will be conducting our monthly pest control exercise with our approved Pest Control contractor. This exercise covers the guestrooms and corridor areas. This will take place on **13 and 14 July 2026, between 9 am and 5 pm daily.**

We would like to assure you that the chemicals used are safe, designed for effective pest control, and have been approved for use by the local authority, the Singapore National Environment Agency, and will not cause any adverse health problems.

GO GREEN INITIATIVES

At York Hotel Singapore, we are committed to protecting the environment without compromising the comfort and experience of our guests.

In our efforts to conserve water, save energy, and preserve resources, we reuse towels and linens, and bedsheets are changed every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday unless otherwise requested.



EXCESSIVE NOISE AND PARTIES

To ensure maximum comfort and safety for all guests, the hotel upholds a zero-tolerance policy toward commotion, excessive noise, and parties.

The permissible group size in the room shall not exceed the maximum occupant capacity of the respective room type as per the hotel's policies.

Any guest found to be creating excessive noise, exceeding the maximum occupancy, or hosting a party will be asked to leave the hotel immediately without a refund.

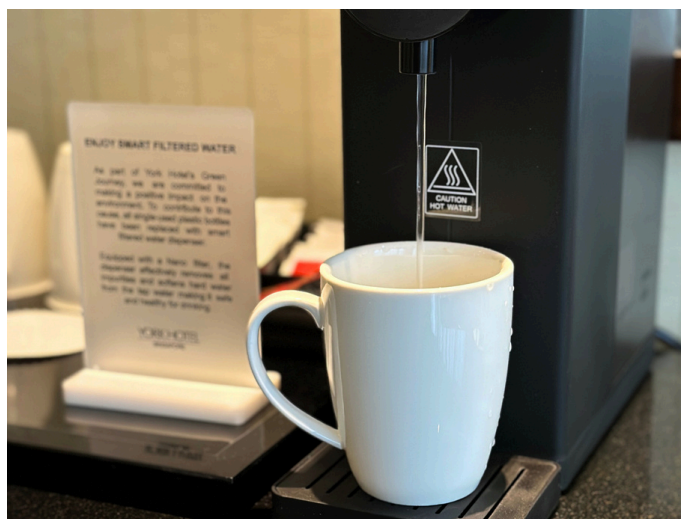
IN-ROOM SMART FILTERED WATER DISPENSER

As part of our Go-Green journey and plastic-free journey, we no longer offer single-use plastic bottles. Guests are encouraged to use the in-room smart filtered water dispenser.

Equipped with a Nano filter, this dispenser not only effectively removes impurities and softens hard water, making it safe and healthy for drinking, the filtered water also helps to improve the taste of beverages.

NO COOKING IN GUEST ROOM

In consideration of the safety of other guests and our employees, the preparation of food in guest rooms using any type of cooking appliances is strictly prohibited.

The hotel reserves the right to charge the guest for the cost of rectifying damage to the hotel's property or structure caused by the use of such appliances.



NON-SMOKING ZONE

As part of Singapore government's efforts to create a smoke-free environment, please be advised that the Orchard Road precinct, including York Hotel is designated as a No-Smoking Zone.

The designated smoking point is located at our open car park facing Mount Elizabeth. Smokers are advised to ensure proper disposal of cigarette butts and refrain from littering.

In accordance with Singapore's regulations, users are advised to smoke within the Designated Smoking Area. The National Environment Agency (NEA) takes a strict stance against smokers who flout the law.

ADVISORY ON VAPING

Vaping is illegal in Singapore under the Tobacco (Control of Advertisements and Sale) Act, with penalties for purchasing, possessing, using, or selling e-vaporisers.

Offenders will face penalties including composition fines or prosecution. Additionally, visitors caught purchasing, possessing, or using e-vaporisers laced with drugs such as etomidate ("K-pods") may be refused entry or banned from re-entry to Singapore.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

For the safety of our guests and employees, the following items are not permitted in the Hotel and guestrooms:

- Animals of any kind, except guide dogs
- Flammable, explosive or otherwise hazardous materials
- Items emitting an unpleasant odour (e.g. Durian)
- Unregistered firearms or other weapons
- Objects of an unusually large size or in unusually large quantities
- Articles related to use in gambling, prostitution, smuggling or other illicit activities
- Illegal drugs or other articles, the possession of which is prohibited by the laws of Singapore
- All motorised and non-motorised Personal Mobility Devices (PMDs), such as e-scooters, electric luggage, electric boards, and hoverboards, including their accessories, such as charging devices and batteries

The Hotel reserves the right to refuse entry to any guest found to have prohibited items. Guests shall be solely liable and responsible for all financial losses or otherwise, and damage that may be caused by such items.
