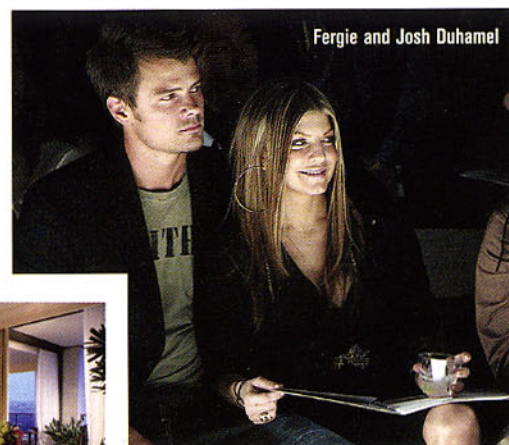


PUMP PUSHER
