COHO CAFÉ RECIPE

Biscuits & Wild Rice Sausage Gravy

Makes 8 servings

BISCUITS

INGREDIENTS	2 cups All-Purpose Flour	½ cup Shortening
	1 tbsp Baking Powder	³⁄₄ cup Cold 2% Milk
	1/2 tsp salt	•

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 450 degrees F.

In a large mixing bowl, sift together flour, baking powder, and salt. Cut in shortening with a fork or pastry blender until mixture resembles coarse crumbs.

Pour milk into flour mixture while stirring with a fork. Mix in milk until dough is soft, moist, and pulls away from the side of the bowl.

Turn dough out into a lightly floured surface and knead dough briefly, 5 to 7 times. Roll dough out into a ½ inch thick sheet and cut out biscuits with a floured cookie cutter. Press together unused dough and repeat rolling and cutting procedure.

Place biscuits on ungreased baking sheets and bake in preheated oven until golden brown, about 10 minutes.

GRAVY

S –	1 ¼ lb Wild Rice Sausage	4 cups Heavy Cream
DIEN	1/3 cup Onions	1 tbsp Garlic
	½ cup Butter	1/2 tbsp Black Pepper
R E	1 ½ cup All-Purpose Flour	½ tbsp Salt
S Z	4 cups 2% Milk	1 tbsp Thyme

INSTRUCTIONS

Cook the wild rice sausage until browned. In a large saucepan, sauté the onions in the butter until translucent (about 5 minutes). Add the herbs and spices and cook for 2 additional minutes. Add the flour to the butter and cook for about 4 minutes. Slowly add the milk, whisking as you go so no lumps form. Add in the heavy cream and the cooked sausage. Bring to a simmer and cook for 3 minutes to allow it to thicken.
