Peloidotherapy, or mud treatment, is an ancient form of treatment for various physical conditions of rheumatic, detoxifying or immunizing origin.

The therapeutic effect of the mud has been known for thousands of years, being one of the oldest treatments used in ancient Egypt.

The Techirghiol mud has been thoroughly studied at the beginning of the 20 Century and in 1924 it received the gold medal at the World's Fair in Paris.

The mud is a substance of a complex chemical composition, a result of an extremely long biological process determined by the fauna of invertebrates in which the active minerals from **Techirghiol Lake** originate.

The treatment area and the outdoor pool at Ana Hotels Eforie use the sapropelic Techirghiol mud, a black, glossy, oily, greasy mud, rich in colloidal iron sulphide and of physical properties that make it unique.

The sapropelic mud has a significant influence on the body by treating inflammatory or degenerative rheumatologic affections, post-traumatic sequelae, central or peripheral nervous system diseases (of up to even multiple Sclerosis and Parkinson's), gynecological problems and many others.

Its core therapeutic effects are conferred by the mud temperature (for local applications), its pressure (in the case of mud baths) and from the substances it contains, some of which can be skin absorbed (Sulphur, CO2, extrogenic substances).

Lake Techirghiol mud has beneficial effects on a wide range of diseases and malfunctions:

- Rheumatic degenerative (spondylo discarthrosis, osteoarthritis of the hip, knee, etc.)
- Periarthritis of the shoulder, hip, tendinitis, fibromyalgia
- Chronic inflammatory rheumatic diseases outside inflammatory flare (ankylosing spondylitis, other spondyloarthropathies, rheumatoid arthritis, psoriatic arthritis)
- Orthopedic, post-traumatic sequelae
- Psoriasis, seborrheic syndrome, dermatitis, chronic eczema, allergic-dermatitis
- Inflammatory chronic gynecological (adnexitis, cervicitis, endometritis, menstrual cycle disorders, secondary infertility)
- Postoperative adherence process
- Diseases of the central and peripheral nervous system (multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's disease, neuralgia, neuritis)
- Endocrine (hypothyroidism, pituitary dwarfism, rickets, obesity)
- Cardiovascular (mild and moderate hypertension, peripheral circulatory disorders)
- Respiratory (asthma, tracheobronchitis, chronic laryngitis)
- Metabolic and nutritional (compensated type II diabetes, gout)

Mud treatments also have a cosmetic effect by moisturizing and detoxifying the skin, exfoliating with salt crystals and activating the circulation. The skin becomes velvety, regenerated, shiny. Mud treatments produce notable and clinically proven effects; they must be carried out under medical supervision and in respect of specific contraindications.

The SPA treatments with sapropelic mud produces persistent favourable effects by modifying the adaptive response capacity to various stimulating factors.
