Bay Gardens Resorts Cushions Staff From COVID-19. Induced Hotel Closures



Facing the prospect of zero occupancy due to global travel restrictions, the Bay Gardens hotel group is resisting immediate closure of its properties and focusing on ensuring its 300-plus staff members are cushioned from the worst economic effects of the coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic. Sanovnik Destang, executive director of the locally-owned-and-operated group, told his staff that with over 800 room nights canceled or rescheduled, the worldwide travel bans have cost the company hundreds of thousands of dollars in the short term.

Despite the fact that forward bookings have all but dried up, and hotels in St. Lucia and around the world were laying off employees, Destang told staff that other considerations must come into play for Bay Gardens. To ensure the resort group is fair to all he stated that it will not be business as usual and sacrifices will be necessary all around, with adjustments made to staffing levels in the form of redundancies. The 95 percent of staff remaining on the permanent employ list will be on a reduced rotational schedule.

Destang stressed all staff, including the management team, were being asked to make this sacrifice for the month of April, and that Bay Gardens would endeavor to provide working hours (and hence income) that represents a minimum of 50 percent of everyone's base salary up to a maximum of 75 percent of base. He noted that it was not an easy decision to make but with hotels that are practically empty, there is no business reason to have persons who work in operations, in particular, be paid at all.

Staff were told that the company was making its own sacrifices because it was concerned about the impact of this loss of income and that Bay Gardens is willing to make the sacrifice as a company and carry staff through the month of April. This will likely cost the company in excess of EC\$500,000 (US\$185,000) in salaries, national insurance contributions and staff meals, even at the reduced levels of employment and working hours.

While the resort will cover the majority of its employees for the month of April, Destang cautioned the resort group could see extremely low occupancy in May as well if the situation is not brought under control. He urged staff to take care of themselves and their families, and reminded them that in the last 25 years the travel industry "has weathered many a storm and our Bay Gardens brand is strong in the

marketplace and always comes roaring back once the recovery comes".

He added that this is "an unprecedented situation for the entire world and the tourism sector has been hit the hardest" and advised staff to remember that "we are all in this together," and advised that Bay Gardens would cover the costs of counselling sessions for employees to safeguard the mental, emotional and physical impact COVID-19 was having on the nation.

While recovery may take a few months or longer, Destang reported there was already pent up demand for travel in the summer, fall and winter 2021. In the interim, the leadership team would focus on maintenance, deep cleaning and staff training.

In addition to Saint Lucia's prevention initiatives, we have implemented the following enhanced protocols:

- Full adherence & cooperation with the disease prevention guidelines provided by the above referenced agencies.
- We have placed hand sanitizer dispensers in restaurants and common areas.
- Our housekeeping items have increased the frequency and rigor of cleaning and sanitization in all areas of our hotel, utilizing cleaning and disinfectants with chemicals recommended by WHO.

In addition, here are a few practices to help stop the spread:

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- A 60%–95% alcohol alcohol-based hand sanitizer is an alternative to handwashing but will not be effective if hands are visibly soiled
- Avoid touching your face; especially mouth, eyes, and nose
- People who are well should not wear a facemask to protect themselves from respiratory illnesses, including COVID-19. You should only wear a mask if a health care professional recommends it. A facemask should be used by people who have COVID-19 and are showing symptoms. This is to protect others from the risk of getting infected. Family members, who are providing care to individuals with respiratory symptoms, can also use the masks.

Recipe of the Month: Breadfruit Balls



Whether you're working from home or at home with the kids, here are a few fun, home-made treats you could make together.

Ingredients

- 1 Medium Breadfruit
- 1 Egg
- 1/2 Cup Finely Chopped Onions
- 2 Cloves Finely Chopped Garlic

- 2 Stems Celery and Parsley (Finely Chopped)
- 2 Cups Grated Cheese
- 2 Cups Breadcrumbs
- Salt to Taste
- 1. Cut the breadfruit in four and clean it by removing the skin and the center stalk.
- 2. Boil the breadfruit in water with salt until it is soft.
- 3. Drain the excess water and place the breadfruit in a bowl. Mash it with a potato masher. and allow it to cool down.
- 4. Add the rest of the ingredients and mix it thoroughly. Allow it to cool.
- 5. Make balls with the mixture at the sizing of your choice. Roll in breadcrumbs and they can be fried or baked.
- 6. If you are baking the dish, then place in oven for approximately 35 minutes at a temperature of 200*C.
