

The Londoner wins three awards at the prestigious AHEAD Global 2022 Awards, including the headline award 'Ultimate Accolade'

January 2023 - Following the success at AHEAD Europe, The Londoner is delighted to announce that they have won three awards at the 2022 AHEAD Global Awards, including 'Hotel Newbuild', 'Event Spaces', and have been named the winner of the 'Ultimate Accolade' - the most coveted award of the series.

Organised by industry leading publication, Sleeper Magazine, the AHEAD Awards recognise excellence in hospitality. The awards are voted for by a panel of industry experts; architects, interior designers, hoteliers and industry commentators, who follow a careful judging process to ensure a rigorous and balanced decision. The winner's from AHEAD's four regional awards programmes - Americas, Asia, the Middle East and Africa (MEA), and

Europe - went head-to-head as part of AHEAD Global. After receiving over 630 global entries spanning 60 countries, AHEAD's judging panel narrowed down their winners in 18 categories.

Building on The Londoner's success at the 2022 AHEAD Europe Awards, winning awards for 'Hotel of the Year', 'Event Spaces' and 'Hotel Newbuild', it was the big winner of the Global ceremony. Scooping three awards including the coveted 'Ultimate Accolade', The Londoner was lauded by the judges as "a tour de force" with "every element of the design clicking together to create a world class property".

ULTIMATE ACCOLADE: The panel praised The Londoner as "a tour de force" and were in agreement that it was a worthy winner deserving of the Ultimate Accolade. "Every element of the design clicks together to create a world class property" commented one judge, with another noting "I raise a glass to the skilful way that this iceberg project has been delivered".

HOTEL NEWBUILD: Dubbed the world's first 'super-boutique', The Londoner is a 16-storey hotel standing 30 metres tall and 32 metres below street level in the heart of the capital. A collaboration between Woods Bagot and Edwardian Hotels' Rob Steul; the project was sensitively integrated into the historic urban fabric of Leicester Square, all whilst achieving a BREEAM excellent rating. Judges agreed it was "a skilfully executed iceberg project and genuine legacy building" and "an impressive architectural and engineering feat".

EVENT SPACES: Inspired by the theatres of the West End, The Londoner's event space offering is deeply dramatic, with a design characterised by mirrored ceilings, plush velvet drapery and artworks hanging from a pulley system to imitate set changes. Set across six subterranean levels, the design's use of technology and innovation was praised by the judges as "comprehensive and cutting edge" with "a combination of drama, stylistic flourishes and functionality making this an unparalleled series of function spaces".

lype Abraham, Commercial Development Director of The Londoner, said, "It was the lifelong dream of our chairman, Jasminder Singh, to create a purpose-built hotel in the heart of London as a way of giving back to the city for the success he has achieved over the last 40 years. Mr Singh is delighted that the AHEAD Awards judges have recognised the hotel with these fantastic accolades, and thanks the entire hotel build and Edwardian teams for making this dream a reality".

The Londoner opened its doors to guests in September 2021, and in doing so marked a rebirth for Leicester Square. The scale of the project was quite staggering, amazing both Londoners and the hospitality industry alike - with 350 rooms, 16 stories, six concept eateries, a unique members club-style private area, a wealth of meeting and event space, cinema and an entire floor dedicated to wellness; The Londoner became the world's first 'super boutique' hotel. Designed in collaboration with world-renowned architectural designers Yabu Pushelberg, the opening of The Londoner marked a pivotal moment in the return and scale of global hospitality.
