HOT AIR BALLOON

Take in the absolute best views of Park City and Midway with a hot air balloon ride high above the town. With the balloon fully inflated and the colorful panels of fabric standing at attention, hot air balloon rides are recommended even for those with a fear of heights—as long as they are not in a state of panic—and some have even cited the experience as helpful in overcoming this fear. The ascension to the sky will take place gradually over 1,000 feet up in the air before noticing the height climbed.

ALPINE COASTER

Climb into the toboggan-style cars of the Alpine Coaster and enjoy the beautiful Wasatch mountain scenery as the automated lift system whisks you to the top of the track. Then, hold on tight as you go whizzing down the mountain on nearly 4,000 feet of curves, bends and loops. Riders must be 54" and taller while passengers must be between 42" and 54" in height, 3+ years old and accompanied by a driver 16+ and 54"+

BOBSLED RIDE

Feel the rush as you speed down the Olympic track in a 4-person bobsled. A trained pilot will take you and two other passengers through 15 curves, reaching speeds up to 80 mph, and pulling close to 5 G's of force. Billed as the most intense minute of your life, this ride will give you a very good idea of what Olympic bobsled athletes experience day in and day out. Riders must be 16+ years of age and 100+ lbs. to ride.

HOMESTEAD CRATER

The Crater is a geothermal spring, hidden within a 55-foot tall, beehive-shaped limestone rock located on the Homestead property. The Crater formed when melting snow on the Wasatch Mountains seeped deep within the earth. Two miles below the surface, the earth's interior heated the water..Once inside, you can go swimming, scuba diving, snorkeling, enjoy a therapeutic soak or even take a paddle board yoga class.
