### Energy & Water Conservation Initiatives

Optimizing resource efficiency through 100% LED lighting integration and walk-in showers that actively encourage water conservation. To ensure sustainable waste management, all kitchen and residential wastewater underwent rigorous pre-treatment and separation protocols prior to municipal discharge, while spent culinary oils were systematically collected for certified ecofriendly disposal.



### Eco-Conscious Chemical Management

Minimizing environmental impact by prioritizing certified eco-friendly cleaning solutions and bulk purchasing concentrated formulations to eliminate packaging waste. Additionally, strategic energy conservation protocols were enacted during the low season, temporarily powering down unused guest floors to maximize building efficiency.

## Promoting Green Mobility & Circularity

Fostering a sustainable community lifestyle by providing secure bicycle parking facilities to encourage eco-friendly commuting for both team members and guests. Concurrently, operational resource waste was mitigated through comprehensive paper and cardboard recycling streams, alongside transitioning to on-request newspaper services.





### Smart Energy Infrastructure

Utilizing cutting-edge technology to reduce carbon intensity through digitally programmable eco-heating systems that adapt on an "as-required" basis, complemented by automated lighting controls in vacant guest rooms. To ensure continuous optimization, all utility consumption streams were monitored daily to identify and resolve inefficiencies instantly.

## Resource Preservation & Digitalization

Enhancing resource conservation through high-performance thermal insulation across the entire building envelope. Inside our offices, sustainable habits were reinforced by repurposing single-sided paper drafts, standardizing black-and-white printing, and actively transitioning operational workflows to secure digital recording and reporting platforms.



## Guest Engagement & Zero-Waste Goals

Empowering our guests on their sustainability journey through dedicated environmental awareness programming broadcasted via in-room television networks. To fundamentally eliminate printing and cartridge waste, physical informational collateral in guest rooms was kept to an absolute minimum, ensuring a digitally streamlined compliance framework from day one.





To promote sustainability and cater to evolving culinary preferences, we have expanded our plant-based options by adding vegan dishes to our menus. We have also created vegan alternatives for many items on the menu.

This initiative reflects the hotel's commitment to sustainability and its goal of providing diverse, high-quality dining experiences for all guests.



In order to use fresh and seasonally caught seafood from the Adriatic Sea, the menus were revised when necessary and changes were made to the seafood.

Our aim with this approach is to enable us to offer our guests fresh and seasonally caught seafood, while simultaneously reducing energy consumption and carbon emissions from both our frozen product supplier and ourselves.

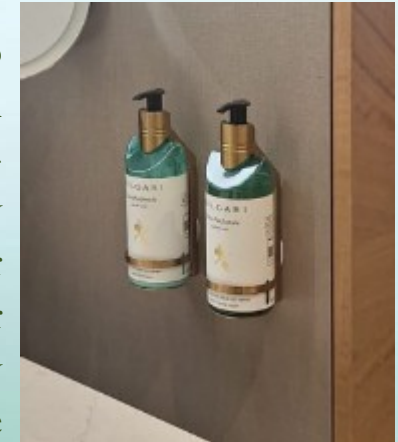

Towards the end of 2025, we took a definitive step to eliminate single-use packaging by transitioning from individual aluminum tubes to high-end, refillable wall-mounted dispensers. While this milestone significantly reduced our material footprint, we maintained our uncompromising standard of luxury. By continuing our partnership with premium hospitality brands, we successfully offer our guests an elevated, eco-conscious experience without sacrificing exclusivity.

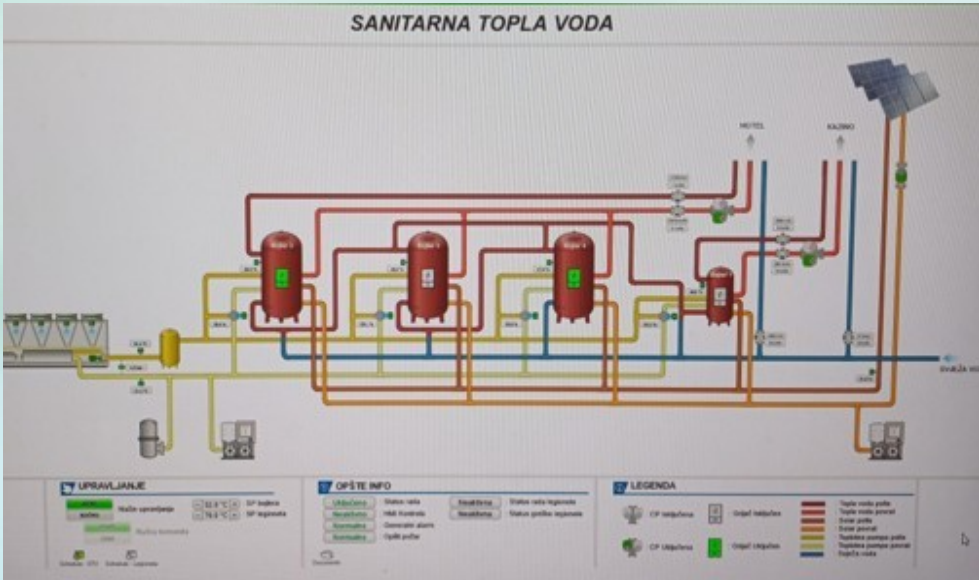

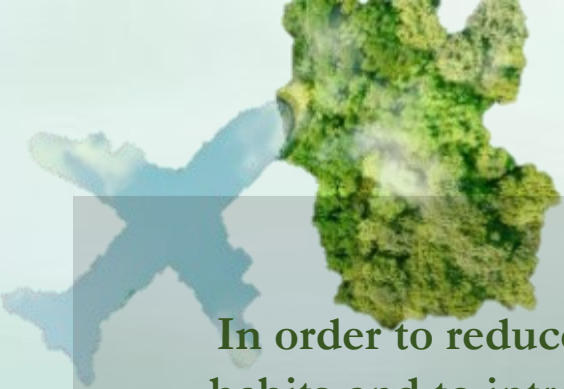

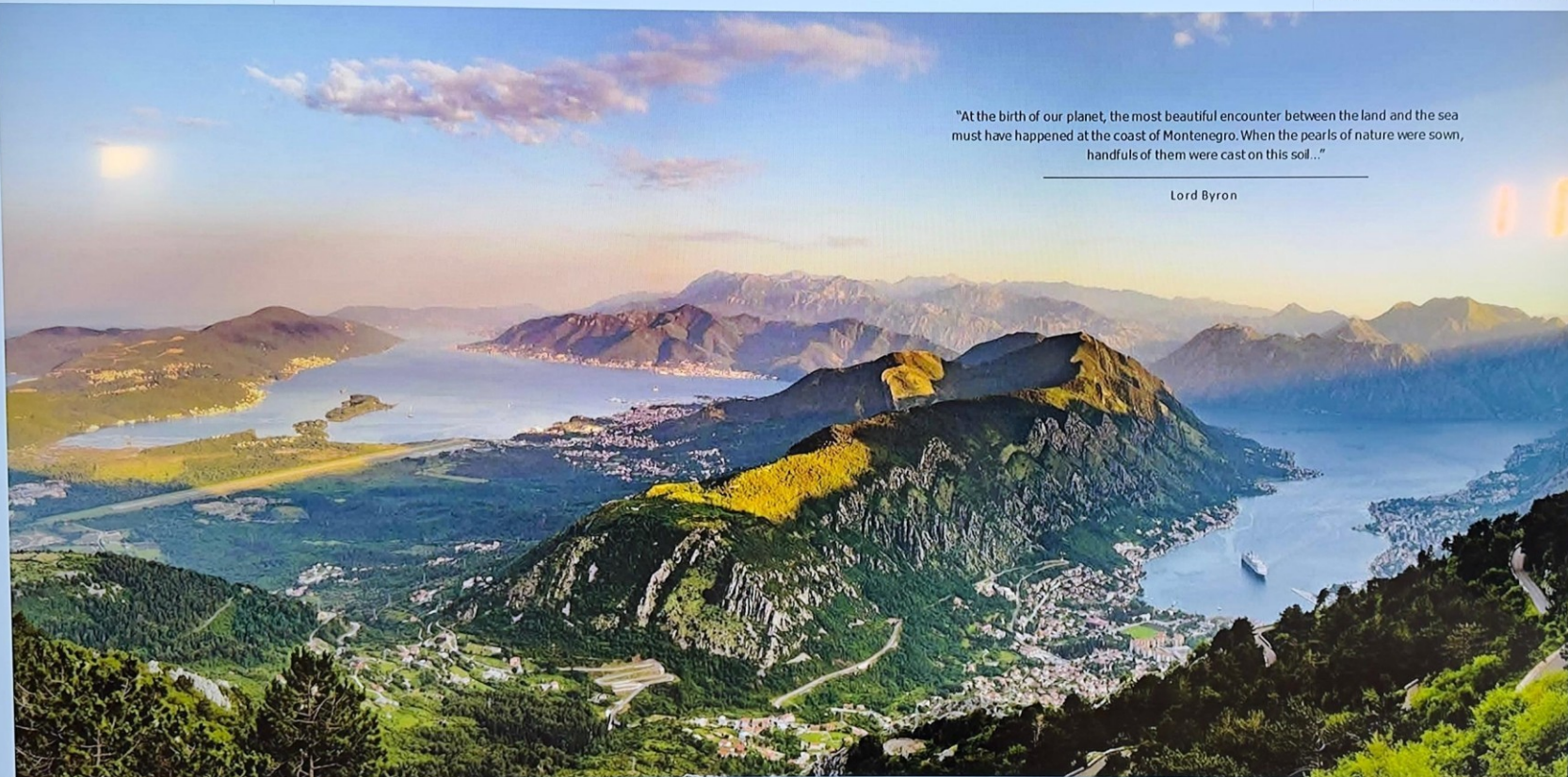


## HYDROLOGICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Hydrographic feature is the existence of two, approximately equal catchment areas, from which surface and ground water bodies flow towards the Danube River Basin (Black Sea catchment area) and the Adriatic Sea Basin.

The total area of the Danube River Basin is about 6727 km<sup>2</sup> (48.7% of the total area), and the main water bodies are rivers Lim, Tara, Piva, Ceholna, and Ibar. Rivers Moraca, Zeta, Cijevna, Rijeka Crnojevića and Orahovstica, and some smaller watercourses flow towards the Skadar Lake and from there to the Adriatic Sea via river Bojana.

## DURMITOR NATIONAL PARK "UNESCO World Heritage Site."

In 1952, Durmitor National Park was granted the status of a national park. The area of the park is 34,500 ha. It includes the massif of the Durmitor Mountain, the canyons of the rivers Tara, Sušica, Komarnica and Draga. The highest peak on Durmitor is Bobotov kuk 2,525 m above sea level, while around them 48 peaks reach a height of over 2,000 m above sea level. Durmitor is adorned with 18 glacial lakes that are known as mountain eyes. The largest and most famous is the Black Lake. The Black Lake consists of the Great and Small Lakes, which are connected by a narrow isthmus. An interesting fact is that the water from it flows into the rivers Tara and Piva, which is an exceptional rarity in nature.

In addition to the exceptional beauty of the landscape and fascinating geological heritage, Durmitor National Park is home to impressive biodiversity. The richness of flora and fauna, the complexity of the ecosystem and the representation of over 1,300 species of vascular plants, have enabled Durmitor to have an international protection status as a UNESCO World Heritage natural site since 1980.

### *Androsace komovensis*

*Androsace komovensis* is an endemic, extremely rare plant in Montenegro. Rock jasmine from Komovi belongs to the Primrose family. The name and etymology of the genus come from the Greek words *andros* - man (that is why it is called *muzika*), and *sakos* - shield, due to the shape of the leaves. It was found in a narrow locality, on the southern slopes of the Kom where it grows in rock crevices and on slopes facing south. The population which was found contains a very small number of individuals (only ten), but it is believed that the actual size of the population may be much larger because parts of the Kom mt. are inaccessible and insufficiently researched.

### *Pinguicula bakanica*

It is a perennial insectivorous plant, a Balkan endemic, rare and protected. It has long sticky leaves and the flower is blue-purple, we will find it as flower from May to August. The plant, with its sticky leaves, stuns and traps insects, which it later decomposes and compensates for the poor mineral intake. They are unique because they conquer niches and habitats where other plants cannot grow. Its habitats are shaky.





## MARINE INVERTEBRATES

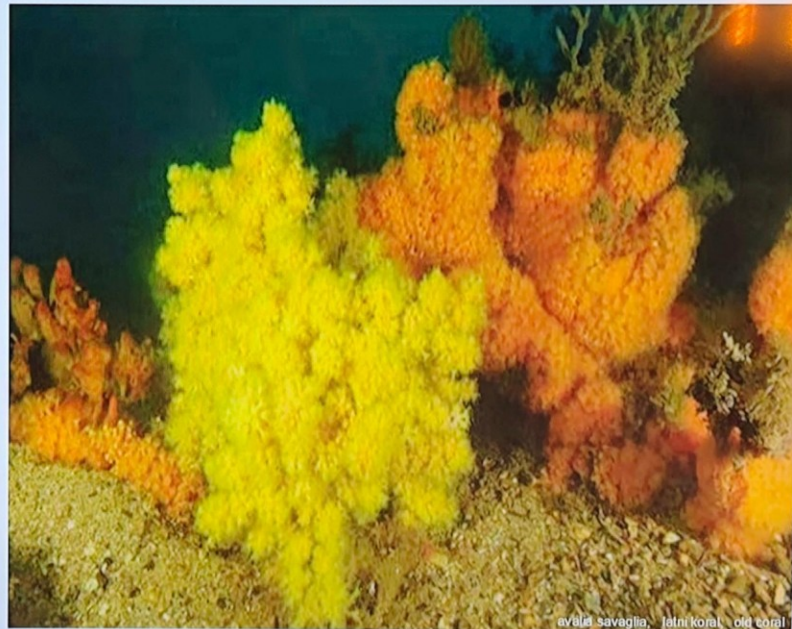
Benthic biocenoses on the open sea of the Montenegrin coast is a home for 729 species of invertebrates. Out of the total number of recorded species, the group of sponges accounts to 64 species, 49 species belong to cnidarians, 354 species to molluscs, 27 species to annelids, 95 species to arthropods, 49 species to bryozoans, 63 species to echinoderms and 29 species to tunicates. Among the species that inhabit the benthic communities of the seabed of the Montenegrin coast, 30 are protected by national and international legislation, while 19 are considered introduced species.

## COEALLIGENOUS COMMUNITIES

Localities where coralligenous communities have been developed are a special features of the Bay of Boka Kotorska. In the vrt and opol stand out as such, where dense colonies of gold coral *Savaglia savaglia* begin to grow at a depth of 12 m. Apart from the fact that the populations of this coral are the most numerous in the Mediterranean, they are also the shallowest, because such habitats are existing at much greater depths. The specificity of these localities is the presence of groundwater sources, the so-called vrulja, which create an ambience similar to the one that prevails at depths of several tens or even hundreds of meters. In addition to golden corals, these habitats are true treasury of sea sponges, coral, bryozoans and other marine invertebrates.

Thanks to the rich flora and fauna of the Adriatic, Budva has become one of the favorite destinations of diving-lovers too. Budva's vast sea caves and sunken wrecks along its coastline create a magical setting for divers. With summer temperatures of up to 28°C and visibility of more than 20 meters along the Adriatic coast, it is the perfect place to take a diving tour or diving course. The shores of Budva are also a shellfish paradise. In addition to all types of Mediterranean fish, you are likely to see shoals of mullet and octopus. Eel and stingray can also be found in Budva waters.

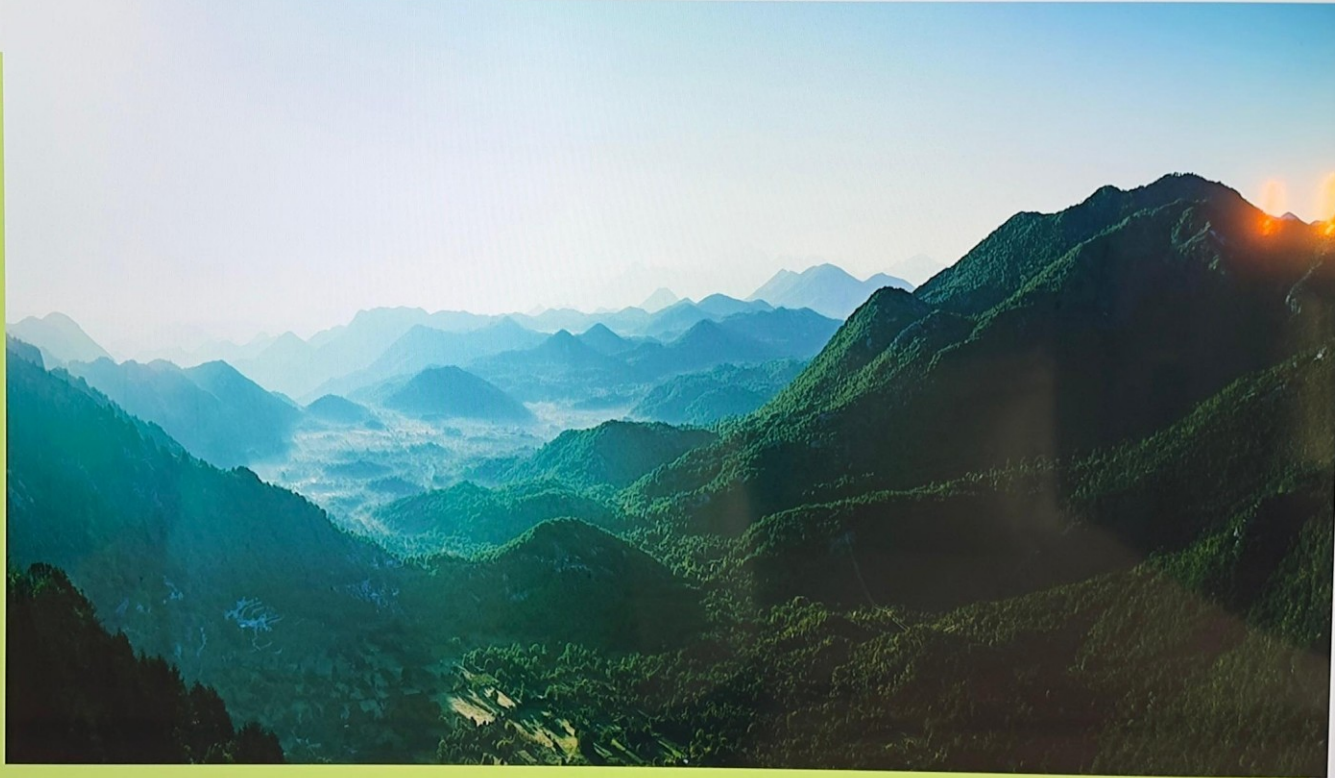




## FORESTS

Having the forest cover percentage of 59.5% (0.9 ha of forest per capita), Montenegro is one of the most densely afforested countries in Europe, following Finland, Sweden and Slovenia.

It has a large number of forest plant communities, with an even larger number of associations and species. Montenegro is characterized by a domination of broadleaf trees with 76.2% of area covered by its forests, while the percentage of coniferous volume is 40.2%. Dominant species are beech, oaks, spruce, fir and species of pine.

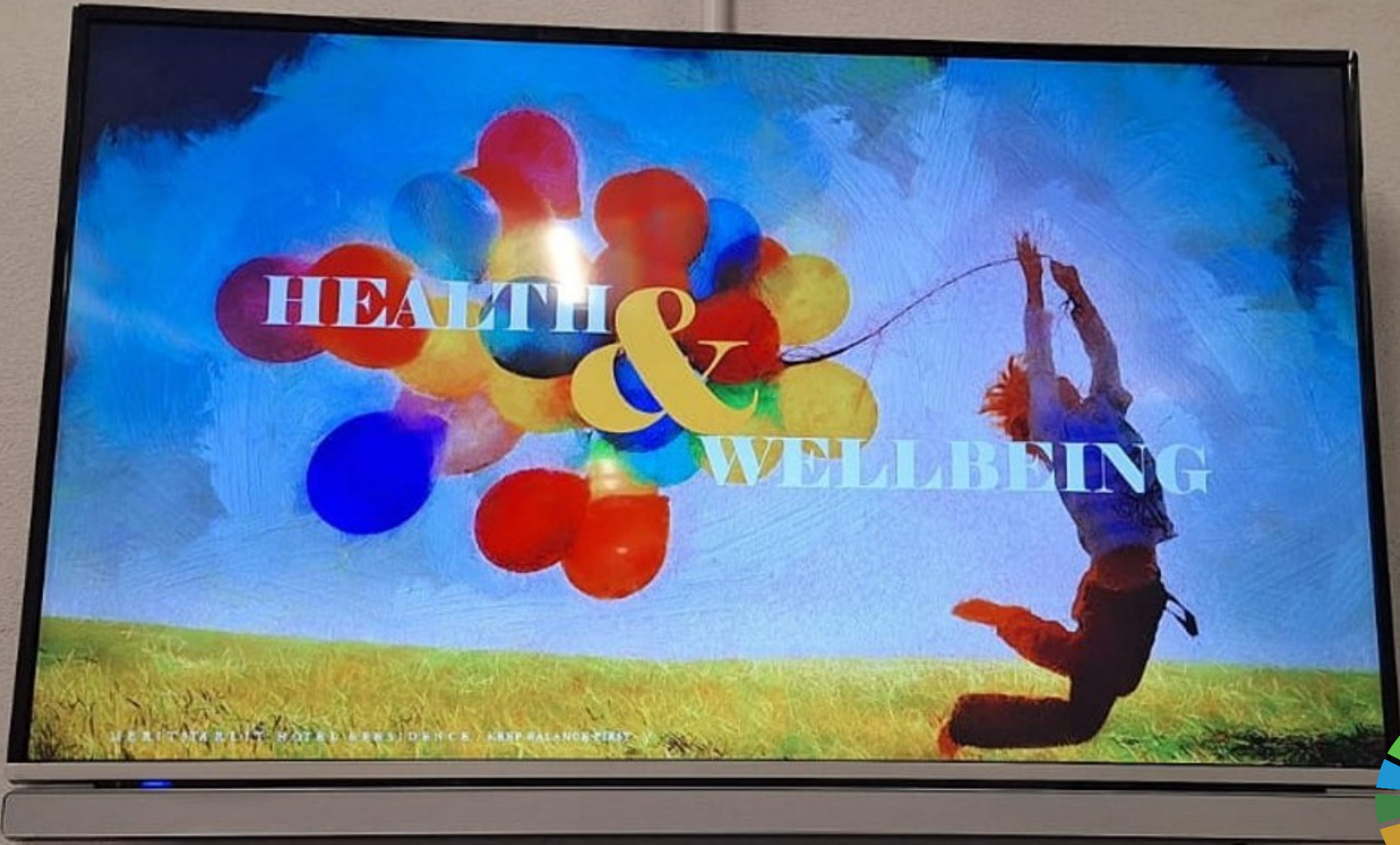
