Guests staying in our hotels become active participants in our sustainability journey, playing a pivotal role in energy and water conservation to reduce environmental impacts.

Garnering this BCA Green Mark Platinum accolade to date was made possible through the adoption of green technologies and practices in our hotel infrastructure, covering energy and water efficiencies through retrofitting and upgrading the chiller plant, cooling tower, heat and water pumps, CO2 and CO sensors, and digital water meters. The advocacy of 3R principles to minimise waste and the installation of the Eco-Wiz Food Waste System with an ecoDigester of 1,000 kg capacity in our hotel kitchen operations to combat food waste also aided in securing this accolade. In 2019, through its green initiatives, Paradox Singapore Merchant Court's energy and water consumption intensities were reduced by 30.6% and 13% respectively from the base year of 2013, resulting in savings of S\$2.2 million.

This S\$97.7 million green loan from UOB will be instrumental to Paradox Singapore Merchant Court's continued efforts to diversify and propel initiatives for future green projects and lend itself towards championing Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) goals. Going forward, the Hotel aspires to invest in technology, products, and systems that provide measurable improvements in energy consumption, such as improved lighting technologies, energy-saving air-conditioning equipment, electrical vehicle charging systems, and solar-related equipment.
