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
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
Using a unique partition system the Corinthian Ballroom can be utilised as one large room or can be divided into three separate syndicate rooms.

Writers Room & Hervey Suite







The Berkeley Suite is named after Dr. George Berkeley who was made Dean of Derry in 1724.




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






McCorkell Suite


The McCorkell Suite is named after the McCorkell Line Ship building company which operated in the city between 1860 and 1896 and built the famous Minnehaha Ship.






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






Amelia Suite


Named after Amelia Earhart who unexpectedly landed in the outskirts of the City in May 1932 when she became the first woman to fly solo across the Atlantic.





Alexander Suite




