Bay Gardens Resorts Win Sustainability Awards in St. Lucia



Green Globe recently recertified three Bay Gardens Resorts - Bay Gardens Inn, Bay Gardens Hotel and Bay Gardens Beach Resort & Spa in the Caribbean. The resorts retain their Gold status in 2021.

Laudra Maurille-Willie, Human Resource Manager at Bay Gardens Resorts said, "Our Bay Gardens Resorts family remains steadfast in our dedication to embracing and implementing best practices which protect and preserve the environment. We continue to work collaboratively to accelerate initiatives which promote the sustainable development of small island developing states. We envision becoming a leader in sustainably providing innovative, authentic Caribbean hospitality by developing our team members' skills as well as enhancing the communities around us."

In 2019, Bay Gardens Resorts won two sustainability awards in acknowledgement of their ongoing best practices and overall green efforts. At the annual 2019 St. Lucia Business Awards held by the St. Lucia Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture, Bay Gardens Resorts won the Environmental Stewardship Award for their green initiatives. This included their reduction of single use plastics, decreasing energy usage and boosting the use of locally sourced produce in kitchens. This is the resorts' ninth business award and its first Environmental Stewardship award win.

Bay Gardens Resorts was also announced as Runner-up in the Environmental Sustainability category at the 2019 Caribbean Hotel and Tourism Association's Caribbean Hospitality Industry Exchange Forum (CHIEF) Awards in Miami. Both these wins were a resounding success for management and staff at all three resorts.

In the same year, Bay Gardens Resorts was the first resort group to be certified Gold status by Green Globe in St. Lucia. Bay Gardens Inn, Bay Gardens Hotel and Bay Gardens Beach Resort & Spa are recognized for their sustainability initiatives, many of which set new standards in the Caribbean for green tourism.

REDUCING SINGLE-USE WASTE

As part of the resorts' waste management strategy, initiatives have included the successful phase out of single use plastics in favour of biodegradable vessels and utensils made from wood, paper, compostable

plastic or sugar cane bagasse. This eco-friendly approach was expanded to include Polystyrene (Styrofoam) products that are no longer in use at any of the properties. Furthermore, environmentally friendly soap dispensers have replaced single-use plastic bottles at all properties.

ENERGY CONSERVATION

Other ecological innovations include GEM Link occupancy sensors in guest rooms, which reduce energy for each occupied room by 20%. Converting air conditioners to energy-efficient inverter units also conserves energy as does lighting that is being upgraded to LEDs across all properties.

ST. LUCIA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

To stimulate regional economic development and minimize environmental impacts at the island resorts, a farm-to-table menu has been started to reduce total food miles.

COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Bay Gardens Resorts reopened its doors in June 2020 after a temporary lockdown period. All three resorts have implemented a range of stringent health and sanitization measures reassuring guests that specific steps have been taken to mitigate the spread of disease. Protocols include the increased frequency of cleaning and sanitization procedures in public spaces, washrooms, beach and pool facilities, and the interior and exterior of hotel shuttles. Restaurant tables and chairs, doors and all doorknobs are also cleaned and disinfected regularly.

Guest rooms are thoroughly sterilized and nonessential items such as pens, directories, note pads, coffee and tea provided on request only. In addition, contactless sanitizers and handwashing stations are positioned in high-traffic areas.

Checking of temperatures and symptoms of guests and team members are carried out at individual properties, each of which is in close proximity to a medical center and a respiratory clinic. Social distancing is in place for shuttles, restaurants, the front desk, the pool and the beach.

Martinique Travel

Bay Gardens Resorts is happy to announce the resumption in ferry service between Saint Lucia and Martinique. After over a year without operation due to the COVID-19 pandemic, from July 08, 2021 L'express Des Isles will resume operation. Fully vaccinated travellers from Martinique will not be required to vacation in place on arrival to Saint Lucia. International Test Cricket returns to Saint Lucia

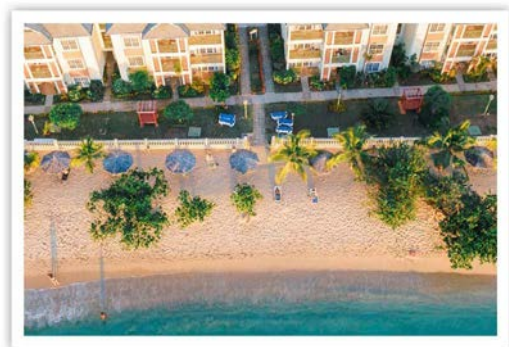


The Daren Sammy National Cricket Stadium saw the return of international test cricket on Thursday June 10, 2021. The highly anticipated test match series between West Indies and South Africa restored a sense of normalcy to cricket enthusiasts as games had not been played on the island since the beginning of the pandemic. Although a non-spectator series, the island was bubbling with excitement to host the teams. South Africa won the 1st Test by an innings and 63 runs.

The 2nd Test commenced on Friday, June 18, 2021; The South Africa team were again victorious in the 2nd Test by 158 runs. A small number of fans were allowed into the stadium for this series. Visitors needed to present their fully vaccinated cards and a form of picture ID to attend. Cricket West Indies said, these first fans to attend an international cricket game in the Caribbean since the start of the coronavirus pandemic. A maximum of 400 spectators per day were allowed.

Cricket action returned to Saint Lucia on July 09, 2021, for the T20 West Indies vs Australia series. Games were played on July 09, 10, 12, 14 and 16, 2021, with team West Indies winning 4 out of 5 games.

Expanded Access to Saint Lucia for Vaccinated Travelers



From May 31st 2021, fully vaccinated travellers arriving with a negative PCR test and proof of vaccination have been able to once again enjoy Saint Lucia's sites, attractions, restaurants, shopping night life, and more without the need for a 14 day "Vacation in Place" Experience. Proof of vaccination along with a negative PCR test will need to be shown on arrival to enjoy all of what Saint Lucia has to offer.

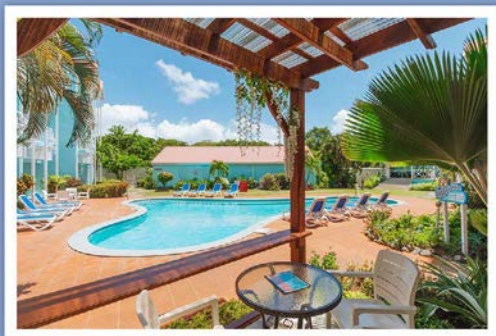
Fully vaccinated travellers are those who are at least two weeks past their final dose of a WHO approved vaccination. Guests will be given a special wrist band to show that they are fully vaccinated. Proof of vaccination will need to be kept on hand at all times when leaving the resort to enjoy the island's many activities, shopping experiences, restaurants, bars and more. For vaccinated adults travelling with kids who are not eligible to get a COVID-19 vaccine, on arrival to Saint Lucia children will be able to take PCR test. On receipt of a negative result, they will be able to explore Saint Lucia with the vaccinated adult/s they have travelled with.

Bay Gardens Resorts is also welcoming visitors who arrive and are not fully vaccinated. Guests can still enjoy our on-property amenities such as our restaurants, spa, Splash Island Water Park as well as some certified attractions and restaurants!

Our Bay Gardens Resorts properties are ideally situated in the heart of Rodney Bay, Saint Lucia's entertainment capital within walking distance from bars, restaurants, St. Lucia's best beach (Reduit Beach), shopping and more. ALL of this is now going to be accessible while following on island health, safety protocols, and mask mandate. Our on property health and safety Paradise Protocols remain in place to keep all guests and staff safe. Here's some good travel news for our guests!

From July 19, 2021, fully vaccinated travellers coming back into the UK from popular travel destinations such as Saint Lucia will no longer have to self-isolate on arrival to the UK!

Children under 18 travelling with vaccinated parents or guardians will also be exempt from having to isolate. Similar "skip the quarantine" rules were announced earlier this month and in June by the Governments of Canada, Trinidad and France (including Martinique and Guadeloupe).

Saint Lucia welcomes all travellers regardless of vaccination status, but fully vaccinated travellers get to enjoy expanded access to everything the island has to offer immediately upon arrival!

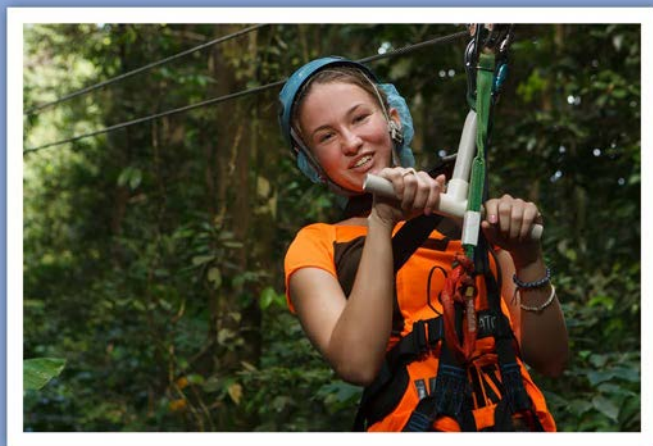

The RePLAST OECS Pilot Plastic Recycling Project

On Friday, July 16th, The Bay Gardens Beach Resort, in collaboration with UNITE Caribbean, hosted a presentation on the RePLAST OECS Pilot Plastic Recycling Project to its members of staff. The Bay Gardens Resorts has been recognized as a Green Globe Certified Gold Standard Member and this distinction augers well for the efforts of the hotel chain in mitigating the adverse effects of plastic waste pollution.



The Republic of France has sought to implement the pilot phase of the project in St. Lucia to engineer the collection, sorting and management of hazardous plastic materials on the island. Ideally, the presenter spoke briefly about the importance of the venture and did well to articulate the overall objectives of the ecofriendly initiative to the attendees. More importantly, she highlighted the categories of plastic waste which would qualify for the initiative, specifically Polyethylene Terephthalate (PET) and High-Density Polyethylene (HDPE) beverage bottles. The collection drive will be coordinated within strategic locations across the country that are easily accessible to citizens who wish to participate. Upon collection, the plastic will then be exported to a recycling plant in the Caribbean promoting a circular economic model.
