Plus, the bathroom is totally redesigned to be more spacious, and now comes with separate toilet and rain shower cubicles. The Executive Deluxe has an added bath tub for that luxe feel.



In each of these rooms, the serenity of the landscape views from the manicured gardens, courtyard, and lake view or pool view, provides the perfect complement and balance to the already tranquil interior. Nature is definitely the inspiration to the whole remodelled feel of the rooms. Additional mod cons available are 50-inch flat screen televisions with an option to connect to other devices via USB port on the multimedia hub, and a docking station by the bedside for those who wish to listen to their own music or wake up to their favourite tunes as it also doubles as an alarm clock.

For all coffee lovers, you can now rejoice too as every guest room is equipped with a personalised Nespresso coffee maker with complimentary coffee capsules that are replenished every single day. A mini refrigerator is also available fully stocked with drinks.

Overall, a stay in any of the rooms in The Saujana Hotel Kuala Lumpur will offer an experience similar to that of a five-star hotel across the country. Having been refurbished to a whole new state, guests can now plan a quiet little escape anytime outside the city, or even an intimate wedding for those wanting a garden reception concept.
