We turned to the Tofte Historical Society at the North Shore Commercial Fishing Museum. Here are some excerpts from "An Old Fashioned Christmas in Tofte."

The success of the fall herring run was the greatest determinant for Christmas plans. As money was acquired from commercial fishing, the winter supply of food had to be ordered and put away. Mothers would order wool, yarn, thread and buttons from the Sears Roebuck and Montgomery Ward catalogs to make mittens, gloves, dress socks and scarves for Christmas presents. Children anxiously awaited the arrival of the catalogs to examine them for the very limited choice of Christmas presents – a sled, some new skates, shoes, possibly even a new .22 rifle.

Perhaps the most important planning of all went into the actual Christmas celebrations. On Christmas Eve the



large meal was served. Tables were covered with bread, several kinds of lefsa, home-canned vegetables and a great variety of homemade pickles. Fruitcakes, cookies, candy and fresh fruits were also served. The family that was fortunate enough to have roast goose for dinner was envied.

On Christmas day, young people would compare their presents and rounds of parties started at various homes. Teenagers would gather in the evening to play cards and visit. Most families would invite friends and neighbors and would exchange news and experiences of the season.

What struck us as we read about old fashioned Christmases in Tofte was how neighbors, friends and family all came together. When finances were tight because of a bad herring run or an unforgiving lake, families celebrated with simple traditions such as playing cards or sharing a meal.

Our wish for you this holiday is that you have the opportunity to create lasting family traditions with those you love. We thank you for being our guest over the years, and wish you health, happiness and prosperity in the years to come.
