## **DISCOVER AUCKLAND**


Take in the city sights from our central location. When you arrive at Nesuto Stadium, or into Auckland, we suggest you purchase an AT Hop card – the perfect way to explore the City of Sails. Here are some ideas to make the most of this wonderful city:

• The Sky Tower: Experience Auckland from the tallest building in New Zealand. With 360-degree views of the city, and a large restaurant and bars.

- SEA LIFE Kelly Tarlton's: Auckland's only Aquarium is a great interactive place to enjoy.
- Start your morning at the Auckland War Memorial Museum as you take in the Maori and Pasifika cultural artefacts as well as informative displays about Auckland's history, and geography. The Museum features the Weird and Wonderful Discovery Centre. The Museum is located in the beautiful Auckland Domain and includes access to the Wintergarden - two glasshouses that date back to 1913. The "Fernery" houses a wide collection of NZ ferns, offering a real taste of the New Zealand native forest.
- Devonport retains much of the charm of old Auckland and has a couple of great spots for ice-cream. North Head is a short walk away, featuring the remains of pre WW1 military gun emplacements. This is also one of the best vantage points to take in the Waitemata Harbour and Hauraki Gulf. Walking tracks deliver a 360-degree panorama.
- The Tamaki Link Bus line offers easy access to Auckland's eastern beaches - Okahu Bay, Mission Bay, Kohimarama and St Heliers Bay. Check out Bastion Point and a fantastic lookout above Ladies Bay.
- Choose between some of Auckland's best cafes, restaurants and bars at Karangahape Road or Ponsonby Road.
